#### Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005 April 2007. Provisional data


# The Services sector turnover grew by 7.7% during April, as compared with the same month in 2006

#### The interannual rate of employed persons increases 2.7%

The Services sector turnover grew by 7.7% during April, as compared with the same month in 2006.

All sectors contributed to this growth. Services Rendered to Companies is the sector which experienced the highest growth, with an interannual rate of 11.1%. It is followed by the Information and Communication Technologies (10%), Trade (7.6%), Transport (6.4%) and Tourism Activities (4.4%) sectors.

In the field of Services Rendered to Companies, the most dynamic activities were Investigation and security activities and Miscellaneous business activities both with an interannual growth rate of 13.6%. Among the remaining activities, it is worth noting the turnover growth rate that was registered in Computer and related activities (20,8%).



#### Galicia and La Rioja registered the highest interannual turnover growth rates

Galicia was the Autonomous Community that registered the highest turnover growth rate in April, with a 11.8% rate. It was followed by La Rioja, with a 10.4% rate.

On the contrary, the lowest turnover growth rates were registered in Aragón (2.9%) and Castilla-La Mancha (5.2%).



#### The interannual employment rate increased 2.7%

The interannual employment rate for the Services Sector increased 2.7%. All sectors contributed to this growth. For another month, Services Rendered to Companies was the sector contributing the most to employment creation, with an interannual growth rate of 4.6%.

Occupied personnel growth rates stood at 3% for the Transport sector, 2.8% for Information and Communications Technologies, 2.2% for Trade and 0.9% for Tourism Activities.

Regarding the Services Rendered to Companies sector, it is worth noting the interannual growth rate in Labour Recruitment and Provision of Personnel, 7.4%, followed by Investigation and Security, and Advertising activities, with 6.8% and 5.4% rates, respectively.

## The greatest increases in employed personnel were measured in Castilla y León, Comunitat Valenciana and Galicia.

Castilla y León was the Autonomous Community which registered the greatest growth in occupied personnel in the Services Sector during April, with an interannual rate of 4%. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana and Galicia, both with a 3.6% growth rate.

On the other hand, the lowest growth rates were registered in Aragón (1%) and Canarias (1,3%).
