Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005 September 2007. Provisional data


The Services Sector turnover grows 3.2% in September, as compared with the same month in 2006

The interannual rate of employed persons increases 2.3%

The market Services Sector turnover increased 3.2% in September, as compared with the same month of 2006.

All sectors contributed to this growth. Information Technologies was the sector that experienced the largest growth, with an interannual rate of 7.4%. It was followed by Services Rendered to Companies (6.1%), Tourism (3.4%), Transport (2.8%), and Trade (2.5%).

The most dynamic activities in the Information Technologies area were Audiovisual Activities (10.3%) and Information Technologies Services (7.3%). Of the remaining activities, the interannual growth experienced by the turnover of the Investigation and Security Services (9.2%) is worth noting.



La Rioja and Galicia register the highest interannual turnover growth rates

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community that registered the highest interannual turnover growth during the month of September, with a rate of 7.7%. It was followed by Galicia, with an increase of 7.6%.

Conversely, the lowest turnover growth was registered in Cantabria (1.0%) and in Comunitat Valenciana (1.1%)

The interannual employment rate increases 2.3%

The interannual employment rate for the Services Sector increased 2.3% in September.

For yet another month, Services Rendered to Companies was the sector that registered the largest increase in employed personnel, with a rate of 3.0%. Within this sector, the growth in Investigation and Security Activities (7.6%) and Advertising (4.9%) was especially noteworthy.

In the other sectors, employed personnel reached rates of 2.7% in Information Technologies, 2.5% in Transport, 2.2% in Trade and 1.3% in Tourism.

Illes Balears and Extremadura register the highest increases in employed personnel

Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community that registered the highest increase in employed personnel in the Services Sector during the month of September, with an interannual rate of 3.8%. It was followed by Extremadura, with an increase of 3.7%

In contrast, the lowest growth rates in employment were observed in Cantabria (0.6%) and Castilla-La Mancha and Comunitat Valenciana, both with 1.5%.
