**Services Sector Activity Indicators (SSAI). Base 2005**  
September 2012. *Provisional data*

**The annual rate of turnover for the market Services Sector stands at –11.8% in September, as compared with 0.8% in August**

**The annual variation of employment for the market Services Sector is –3.3%**

#### **Evolution of turnover for the Services Sector**

Turnover in the market Services Sector experienced an interannual variation of **–11.8%** in September, more than twelve-and-a-half points below that registered in August.

Trade registered an annual rate of **–12.4%** and an effect of **–8.058**. In turn, Other Services experienced a variation of **–10.5%**, with an effect of **–3.714** on the general index.

All sectors presented a negative effect on the general index. The greatest influence were:

- **Wholesale trade and intermediaries**, with an annual variation of **–11.5%** and an effect of **–4.263**, mainly caused by the decreases in all activities of this sector. Among them, worth noting *Wholesale of household goods* and *Wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco*.
- **Sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles**, with an annual rate of **–32.3%** and an effect of **–1.938** on the general index, due to the negative evolution in the two activities comprising this sector. Among them highlighted *Sale of motor vehicles, motorcycles and spare parts*.
- **Retail trade**, with an annual variation of **–8.5%** and an effect of **–1.857**.
- **Professional, scientific and technical activities**, with a variation of **–15.4%** and an effect of **–0.946**, with the decrease of all activities.
- **Transport and storage**, with an annual variation of **–9.4%** and an effect of **–0.934** on the general index, with decreases in almost all activities. Among them highlighting *Warehousing and support activities for transportation* and *Freight transport by road and removal services*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the general index of Services Sector turnover in the month of September.



The variation of the Services Sector Turnover General between September and August was -3.8%. This rate was the highest registered in the last years.

**Year-to-date average rates**


The average rate of the Services Sector Turnover General Index registered a variation of -4.9% in the first nine months of 2012, as compared with the same period the previous year. This rate was -5.1% in Trade and -4.6% for Other Services.

<sup>1</sup> To contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this section has been added to the evolution of the Services Sector Turnover in the last years. The monthly rates of this type of series may have some degree of seasonal behaviour, therefore it is recommended that it be evaluated in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

By sectors, the average rate of the Services Sector Turnover experienced a negative variation rate in all sectors.

##### General index and by sector




#### Variation rates of the Services Sector Turnover adjusted for the calendar effect

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, **the annual variation of the General Index of Services Sector Turnover stood at -9.2% in September, representing ten points less than that registered in the previous month.**

## Evolution of employed personnel

Employment in the Services Sector experienced an annual variation of **-3.3%** in September, four tenths below that registered in August.

Trade registered a variation of **-2.6%** and an effect of **-1.085**. Other Services registered a variation of **-3.8%** and an effect of **-2.234**.

All sectors presented a negative effect on the general index of employed personnel. Those with the greatest influence were:

- **Administrative and support service activities**, with an annual rate of **-5.2%** and an effect of **-0.734**, motivated by the negative evolution in all activities comprising this sector. Highlighting, among them *Employment activities* and *Cleaning activities*.
- **Wholesale trade and intermediaries**, with an annual rate of **-3.9%** and an effect of **-0.564**, caused by the decrease in almost all activities of this sector. Among them, worth noting *Wholesale of fuels, metals and others* and *Wholesale of household goods*.
- **Accommodation**, with a variation of **-3.1%** and an effect of **-0.485**, caused by the decrease in the two activities comprising this sector.
- **Professional, scientific and technical activities**, with an annual decrease of **-3.8%** and an effect of **-0.422**, motivated by the negative evolution in all activities comprising this sector.
- **Transport and storage**, with an annual variation of **-3.5%** and an effect of **-0.418**, due to the general decrease in the activities comprising the sector. Highlighted the negative evolution of the employment in *Freight transport by road and removal services*.

In the first nine months of 2012, the average rate of the General Index of employed personnel stood at **-2.7%**. This rate was **-2.0%** in Trade and it was **-3.2%** in Other Services.

#### General index and by sector




## Autonomous Communities. Turnover variation rates

All Autonomous Communities presented a negative evolution of Turnover in the Service Sector in September.

The greatest decreases were registered in La Rioja (−15.3%), Region de Murcia (−14.4%) and Cataluña and Extremadura (both with −14.1%). In turn, The smallest decreases were registered in Illes Balears(−9.3%), Comunidad de Madrid (−10.0%) and Cantabria (−10.3%).

#### General index by Autonomous Community




## Autonomous Communities. Variation rates of employed personnel

All Autonomous Communities registered negative annual rates in employment in September.

The greatest decreases were in Canarias and Comunitat Valenciana (both with -4.4%) and Extremadura (-4.0%). In turn, the smallest decreases were registered in País Vasco (-1.8%), Aragón (-2.1%) and Region de Murcia (-2.2%).
