Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2015

April 2021. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the Total Industrial Turnover Index¹ stands at 0.8%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment

The annual rate stands at 68.1% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at 69.4% in the original series

Monthly trend of the Industrial Turnover

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Total Industrial Turnover Index between the months of April and March, stood at 0.8%. This rate was 1.6 points lower than the previous month.

Industrial Turnover Index, Total. Seasonally and calendar adjusted Monthly rate. Percentage



¹ As indicated in the methodology of this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the price variation effects.

By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), four of the five sectors showed positive monthly rates. It is worth highlighting the increase in *Capital goods* (3.7%), followed by *Intermediate goods* (1.8%). The only sector that decreased was *Energy*² (-9.1%).

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

Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The Total Industrial Turnover Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of 68.1% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 48.8 points higher than the one registered in March.

The ITI original series registered an annual variation of 69.4%. This rate was 47.1 points higher than the one in March.

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered positive annual rates in five of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the increase in *Durable consumer goods* (223.5%).

Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

In April all markets showed positive annual rates. It is worth noting the increase registered (88.7%).

Industrial Turnover Index, Total and by market


April 2021. Annual rate. Percentage



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover increased as compared to April 2020 in all the autonomous communities. The largest increases were recorded in Galicia (110.5%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (101.3%) and Comunitat Valenciana (97.6%). And the lowest in Extremadura (24.5%), Canarias (28.9%) y La Rioja (31.1%).

Revisions and data update

On the press release day, INE has updated ITI data series corresponding to the last 13 months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI) are short-term indicators aiming at measuring the monthly evolution of the industrial sector, excluding the construction.

The required information is collected since January 2002, together with the Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI) through a survey addressed to more than 12.000 industrial establishments throughout the country.

Survey Type: ongoing monthly.

Base year: 2015.

Population scope: units of economic activity whose main activity is included in Sections B: Extractive industries (with the exception, due to their not being relevant to Spanish industry, of division 09) or C: Manufacturing industry of CNAE-2009.

Geographical scope: the whole country, excluding Ceuta and Melilla.

Sample size: Approx. 12,000 establishments.

Data collection: monthly, value of total business turnover broken down by market.

Collection method: fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
