**Year on year Industry Turnover figures increase by 11.6% in  
January**

**New Orders Received increased by 7.9% with respect to the same  
month in 2006**

The Industry Turnover Index (%) increases by 11.6% in January 2007 with respect to same month in 2006.

According to **economic destination of the goods**, variation rates in January 2006 are 9.2% for Consumer Goods (11.8% for Durable Consumer Goods and 8.6% for Non-durable Consumer Goods), 21.8% for Capital goods, 14.8% for Intermediate Goods and -13.8% for Energy.

### New Orders Received increased by 7.9% in January 2007

The Industry New Orders Received index registered a 7.9% increase during January 2007, with respect to same month in 2006.

According to **economic destination of the goods**, variation rates with respect to January 2006 have been 8.2% for Consumer Goods (8.2% for Durable Consumer Goods and 8.2% for Non-durable Consumer Goods), 10.6% for Capital goods, 11.9% for Intermediate Goods and -14.1% for Energy.
