The personal information directly obtained by the statistical services and through administrative sources will be subject to protection and will remain protected by the **statistical confidentiality** (art. 13.1 of the Law on Public Statistical Service of May 9, 1989, (LPSS)). All personal statistics must keep the statistical confidentiality (art. 17.1 of the LPSS).

Obligation to provide information

The Laws 4/1990 and 13/1996 establish the **obligation to provide the information** that is requested for the elaboration of this Statistical study.

The statistical services may request information from all individuals and legal entities, national citizens and foreigners, who are residents of Spain (article 10.1 of the LPSS).

All individuals and legal entities that provide information, whether their collaboration is obligatory or voluntary, for the required questions of the corresponding statistical services' form **must answer truthfully, accurately, completely and within the given timeframe** (art. 10.2 of the LPSS).

If one does not fulfil the obligations regarding the statistics for the purposes established by this Law, he/she will be sanctioned according to the norms stated in the present Title (art. 48.1 of the LPSS).

The most serious infractions will be fined between 3,005.07 and 30,050.61 Euros. Serious infractions will be fined between 300.52 and 3,005.06 Euros. Minor infractions will be fined between 60.10 and 300.51 Euros (art. 51.1, 51.2 and 51.3 of the LPSS).

2. Guest arrivals

A guest is defined as any person that arrives and stays in the establishment. Only the people that arrive each day will be noted, even if they stay for more than one night. In the event that there are caravans that are occupying plots for long-term stays, the number of guests and the nights that they stayed in the caravans should be included.
