Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys
January 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 9.1% in January, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.9 million in January, 9.1% less than in the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of non-residents decreased 11.1%, whereas those of residents increased 1.0%.

Given that the interannual drop in the number of travellers (-9.8%) was greater than that of overnight stays, **the average stay grew 0.7%** as compared with January 2008, standing at 8.2 nights per traveller.

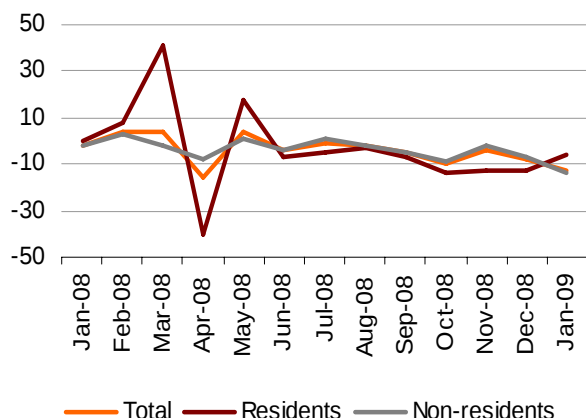

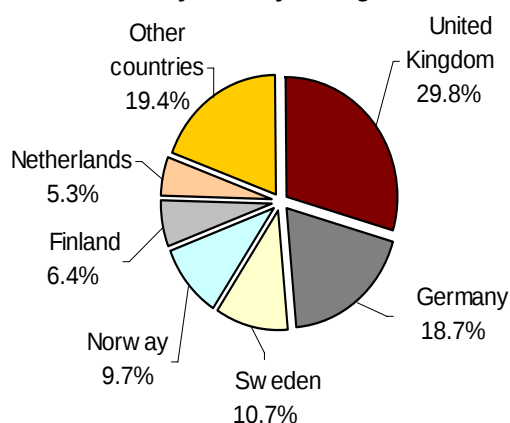
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 12.6% in January in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.7 million in January, representing a 12.6% decrease as compared with the same month last year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -5.9%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -13.5%.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 2.6%, exceeding 347,200 bedplaces. **This month, 34.9% of the total available bedplaces were occupied**, 10.1% less than in January 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate stood at 36.3%**, with an interannual decrease of 7.8%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 55.3% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 7.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 87.5% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 986,258 overnight stays, 12.9% less than in January of last year. The following market was Germany, with 619,226 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -13.8%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with almost three million overnight stays, 12.7% less than in January 2008. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 247,670 overnight stays, 21.6% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate, with 70.4% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad Foral de Navarra (52.4%) and Illes Balears (50.8%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 1.2 millions overnight stays. This island also recorded the highest occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (77.5%), as well as the highest weekend occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (78.2%).

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

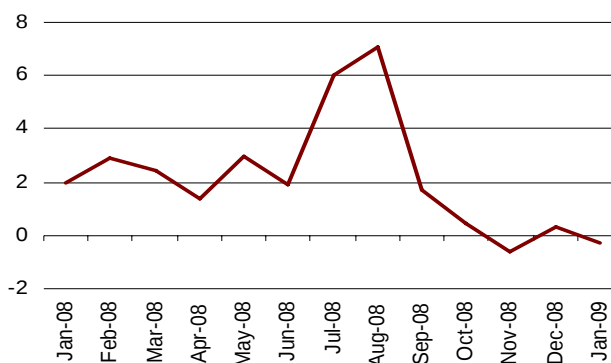
Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 0.3% in January

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.3% decrease in January, a rate 0.6 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

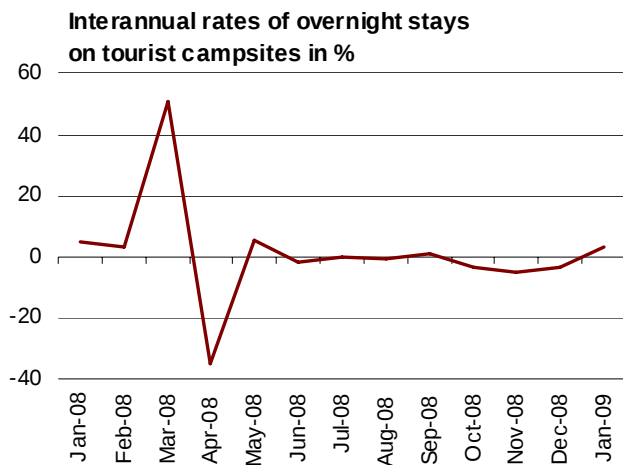
The rate for *travel agencies and tour-operators*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (66.4%), registered a 0.2% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 70.1%, decreased their prices 0.7% as compared with January 2008.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 3.1%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded 829,250 in January, representing an interannual increase of 3.1%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 4.9% in the interannual rate, while those by non-residents increased 2.7%.

Tourist campsites offered 264,248 bedplaces, 2.4% more than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 35.7% were occupied, for a 3.6% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 36.7%, that is, 3.8% less than in January 2008.

79.2% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The**

United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 39.1% of overnight stays by non-residents (2.7% more than in January 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.

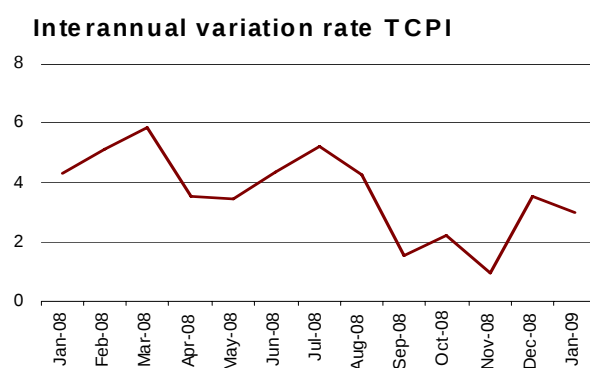
Comunitat Valenciana was the **preferred destination for camping**, with 389,906 overnight stays, 4.8% more in the interannual rate. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 171,967 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 8.0%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia. The destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate on campsites** in January, with 66.0% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (56.0%) and Región de Murcia (54.3%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 235,978 overnight stays and 67.8% of the available lots occupied. The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.0% in the interannual rate



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 3.0% in January. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (53.6%), presented an increase of 2.6%.

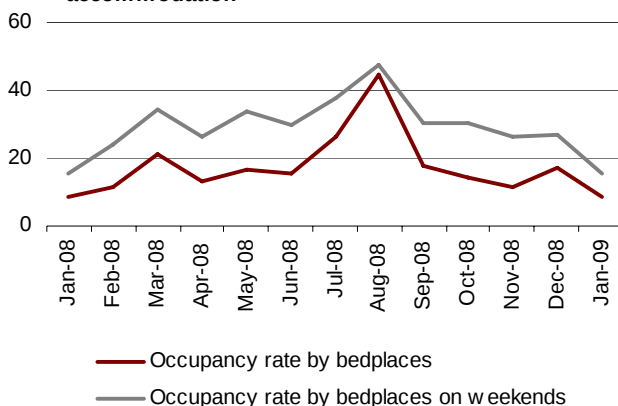
Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 60.9% this month, recorded an interannual increase of 1.8%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 13.7% in January as compared with the same month the previous year

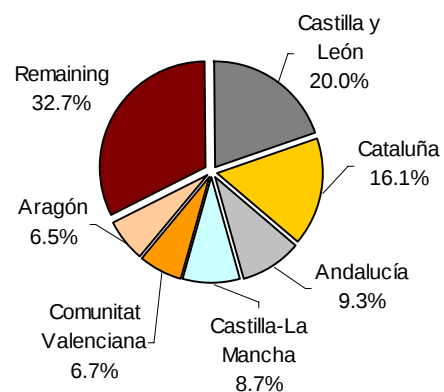
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 296,100 in January, with an interannual increase of 10.0%. Overnight stays by residents increased 13.7%, whereas non-resident stays decreased 7.2%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 111,955 bedplaces, 11.6% more than in January 2008. Of these bedplaces, 8.5% were occupied, representing a 1.6% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 15.6%, that is, 0.3% more in the interannual rate.

Distribution on rural tourist accommodation of overnight stays of Spanish travellers in %



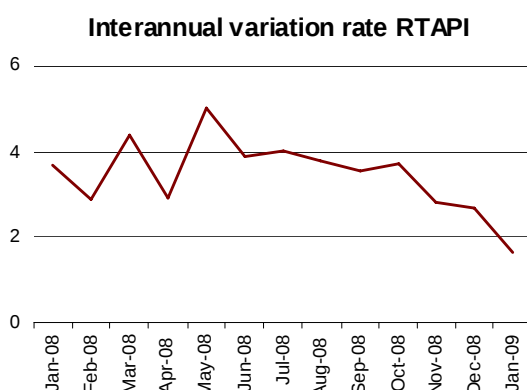
Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 54,169 overnight stays, 8.0% more than in January 2008. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 41,032 overnight stays, 5.2% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 22.6% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by Illes Balears (11.7%) and Cataluña (11.5%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination, with 23,359 overnight stays in January. The island of Gran Canaria reached the highest occupancy rate (25.6%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 1.7%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual growth of 1.7% in January.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (56.0%), rose 1.6%. By rent modality, complete use, whose weighting was 70.5%, recorded an interannual increase of 2.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered an 11.2% interannual decrease in January**. This decrease was produced among both residents (with an interannual rate of – 10.7%), and non-residents (–11.4%).

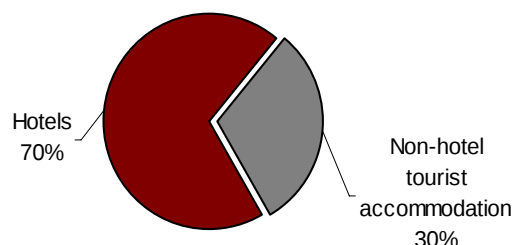
The average stay increased 1.9% and stood at 3.7 nights per traveller.

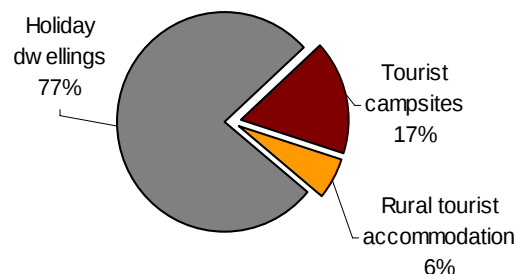

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of January, 70% corresponded to hotels, and 30% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (24.7%) and the Netherlands (4.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.8 million overnight stays, 8.7% less than in January 2008. It was followed by Andalucía, with 2.1 million overnight stays (14.6% less) and Comunitat Valenciana, with 1.7 million overnight stays (10.7% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
