Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys
March 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 26.3% in March, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.3 million in March, 26.3% less than in the same month of the previous year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at –47.7%), and non-residents (–15.4%).

The average stay increased 4.3% as compared with March 2008, standing at 6.3 nights per traveller.

Granted that **Easter week** took place in April this year, and in March in 2008, it is appropriate to wait until the results from the month of April are available to analyse the two months together.

During the first quarter of 2009, overnight stays decreased 17.6% as compared with the same period the previous year.

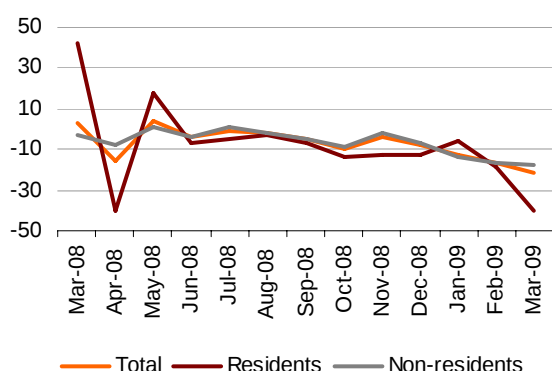

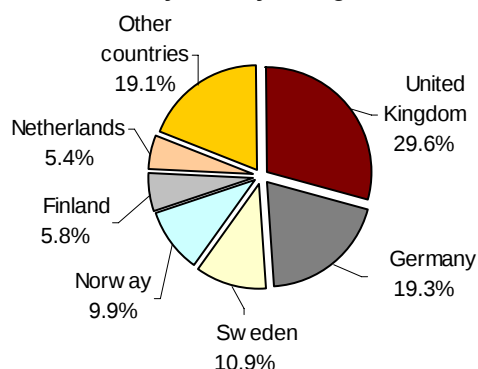
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 21.4% in March in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.8 million in March, representing a 21.4% decrease as compared with the same month last year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at –40.6%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of –17.3%.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 3.0%, reaching 365,064 bedplaces. **This month, 34.2% of the total available bedplaces were occupied**, 18.7% less than in March 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 36.4%**, with an interannual decrease of 18.1%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 54.9% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 13.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.6% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 995,551 overnight stays, 23.0% less than in March of last year. The following market was Germany, with 649,091 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -17.7%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with nearly 2.9 million overnight stays, 19.1% less than in March 2008. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 307,761 overnight stays, 26.1% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate, with 69.1% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad Foral de Navarra (62.4%) and Comunidad de Madrid (54.2%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 1.2 million overnight stays. This island also recorded the highest occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (77.8%), as well as the highest weekend occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (79.1%).

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

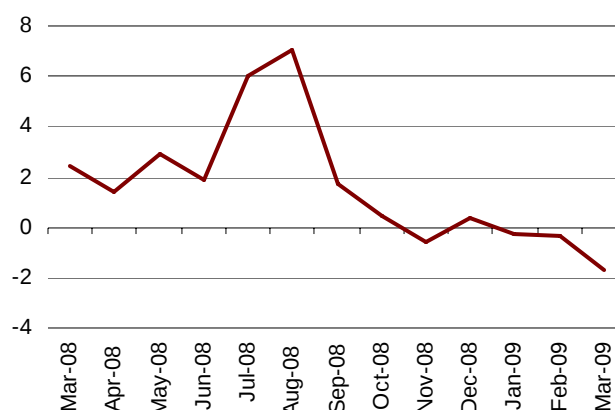
Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 1.7% in March

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 1.7% decrease in March, a rate 1.4 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

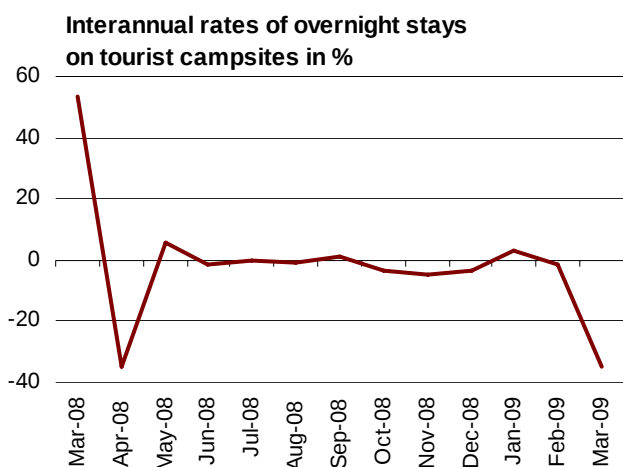
The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (62.8%), registered a 0.8% interannual rate decrease.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 68.8%, lowered their prices 1.7% as compared with March 2008.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 34.8%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded one million in March, representing an interannual decrease of 34.8%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 57.9% in the interannual rate, and non-resident stays decreased 3.8%.

Tourist campsites offered 335,193 bedplaces, 11.3% less than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 34.4% were occupied, for a 7.9% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 37.4%, that is, 6.4% less than in March 2008.

62.9% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 35.9% of overnight stays by non-residents (8.5% less than in March 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.

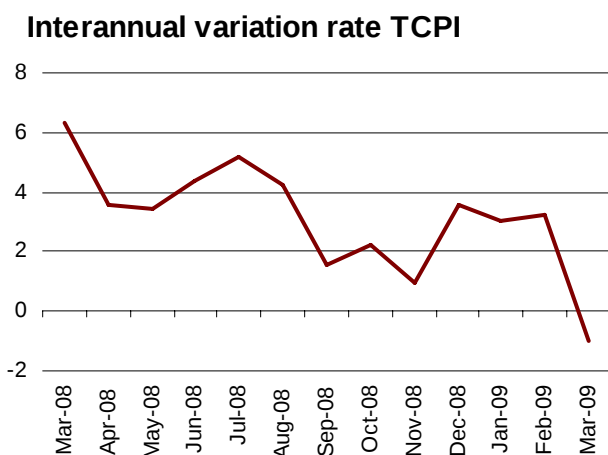
Comunitat Valenciana was the **preferred destination for camping**, with 397,565 overnight stays, 22.1% less in the interannual rate. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 189,475 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 55.0%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia. The destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate on campsites** in March, with 64.0% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (55.9%) and Región de Murcia (50.7%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 217,859 overnight stays and 64.4% of the available lots occupied. The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva.

Prices of tourist campsites decrease 1.0% in the interannual rate



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 1.0% in March. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (61.9%), presented a decrease of 2.6%.

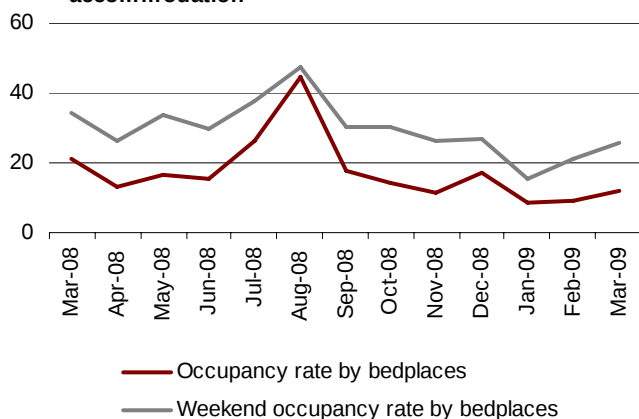
Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 57.0% this month, recorded an interannual decrease of 1.0%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 42.9% in March as compared with the same month the previous year

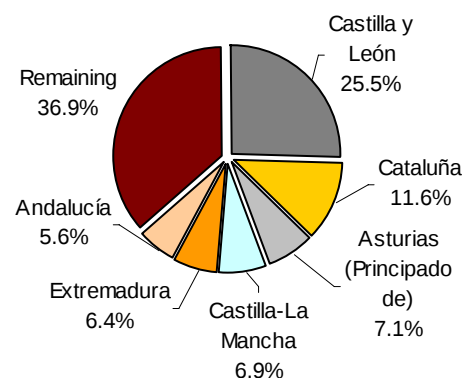
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 450,167 in March, with an interannual decrease of 39.9%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 42.9%, and non-resident stays decreased 17.6%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 122,439 bedplaces, 8.6% more than in March 2008. Of these bedplaces, 11.8% were occupied, representing a 44.5% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 25.6%, that is, 25.8% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 99,562 overnight stays, 32.6% less than in March 2008. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 46,858 overnight stays, 47.4% less.

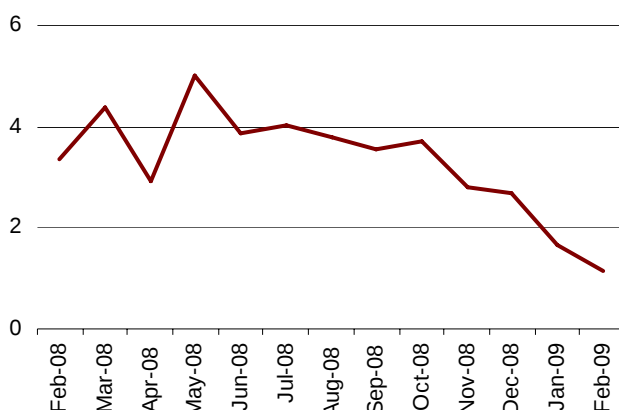
Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 26.5% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by Canarias (23.9%) and País Vasco (19.2%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination, with 22,818 overnight stays in March. The island of Gran Canaria reached the highest occupancy rate (29.4%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 0.3%

Interannual variation rate RTAPI



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual growth of 0.3% in March.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (56.5%), rose 0.4%. By rent modality, complete use, whose weighting was 68.6%, recorded an interannual increase of 1.1%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 20.9% interannual decrease in March**. This decrease was produced among both residents (with an interannual rate of – 27.8%), and non-residents (–15.2%).

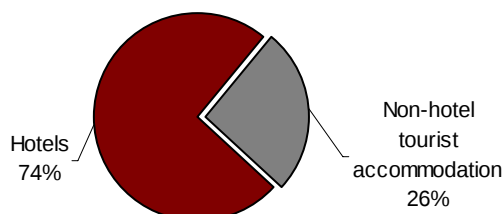
The average stay did not change as compared with March 2008, and stood at 3.4 nights per traveller.

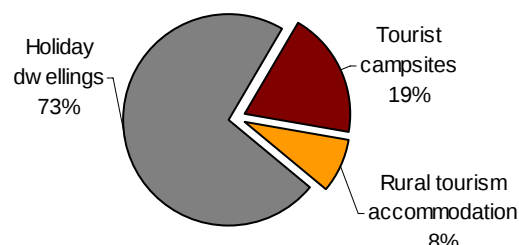

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of March, 74% corresponded to hotels, and 26% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 27.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (23.9%) and the Netherlands (4.8%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.7 million overnight stays, 15.0% less than in March 2008. It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.2 million overnight stays (24.8% less) and Comunitat Valenciana, with 2.3 million overnight stays (20.3% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
