**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
March 2022. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 5.9 million, compared to 2.0 million in the same month of 2021**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.9 million in March, compared to 2.0 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 186.5%. Overnight stays by residents increased by 44.3%, and those by non-resident by 436.6%.

The average stay stood at 4.7 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first three months of 2022, overnight stays increased 232.0%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

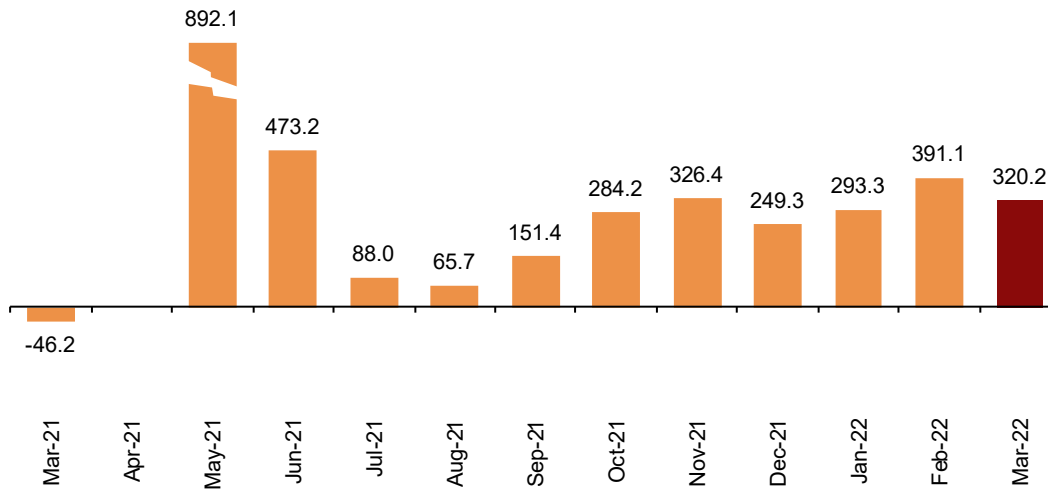
**Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 320.2% in March. Resident overnight stays grew by 62.2%, and those of non-residents by 705.5%.

The average stay grew 10.1% as compared with March 2021, standing at 5.8 overnight stays per traveller.

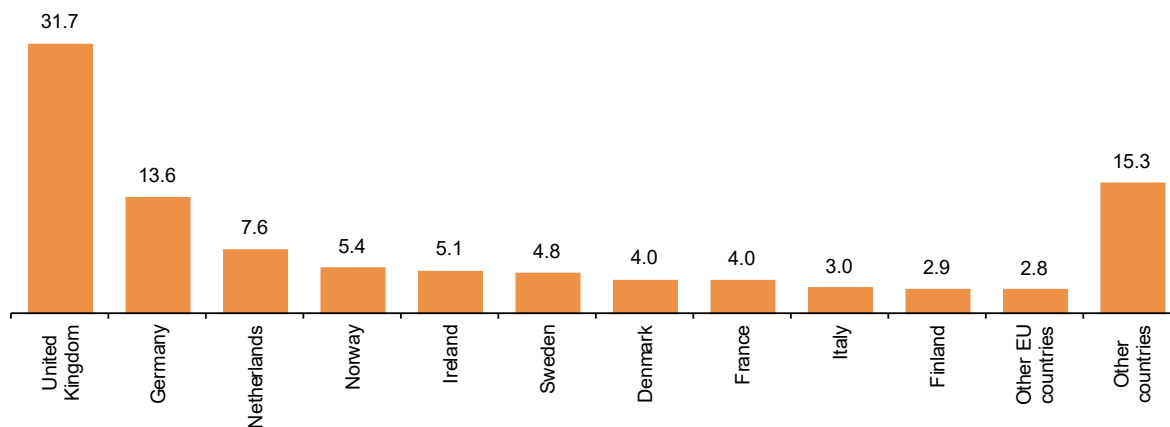
In March, 30.5% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 205.0% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 34.9%, with an increase of 201.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 76.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 902,699 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 388,010 overnight stays.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.0 million overnight stays, and an increase of 594.8% as compared with March of 2021. This Autonomous Community reached the highest occupancy rate, with 50.7% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the Island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 676,238 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 79.6% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in March were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tias.

## Campgrounds

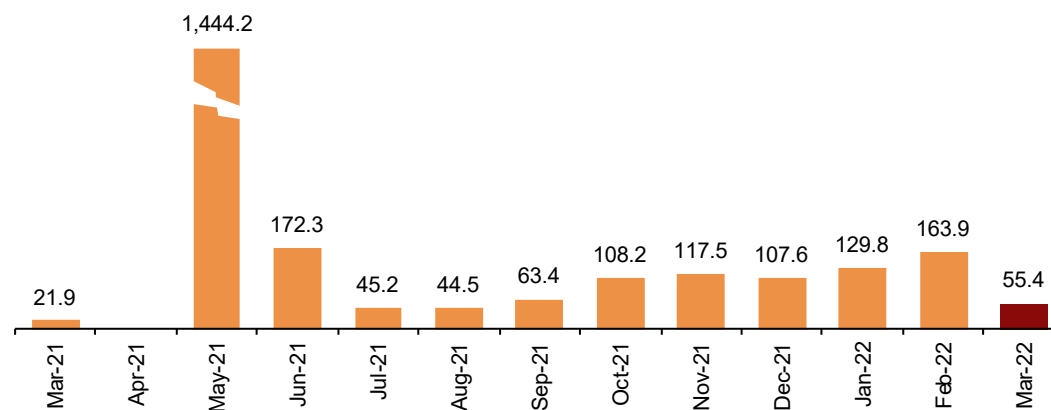
Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 55.4% in March as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 10.0% while those by non-residents increased by 153.8%.

During March, 35.9% of the pitches offered were occupied, 10.8% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 39.2%, with an annual increase of 16.1%.

Non-residents accounted for 65.2% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 33.2% of overnight stays by non-residents, 211.8% more than in March of 2021.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 602,440 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 55.4%. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 56.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 314,511 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 73.2% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Cabanes.

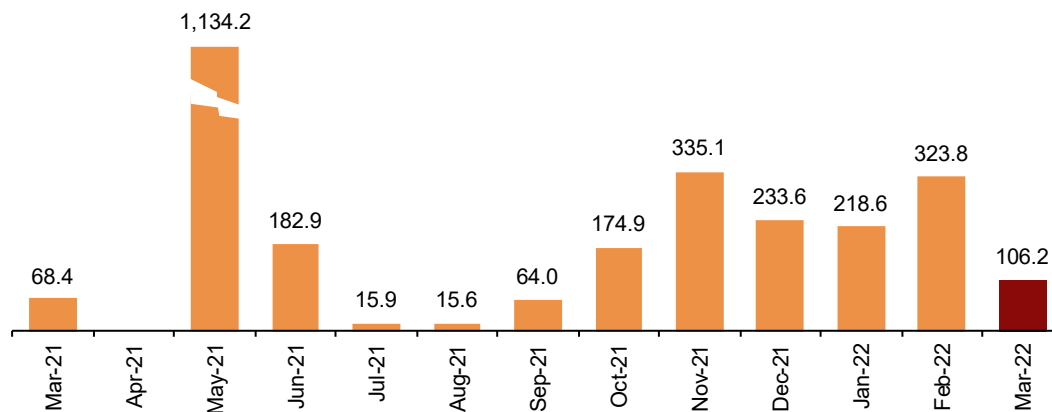

### Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 106.2% in March. Resident overnight stays grew by 80.3%, and those of non-residents by 284.8%.

#### Annual variation rate for overnight stay<sup>3</sup>

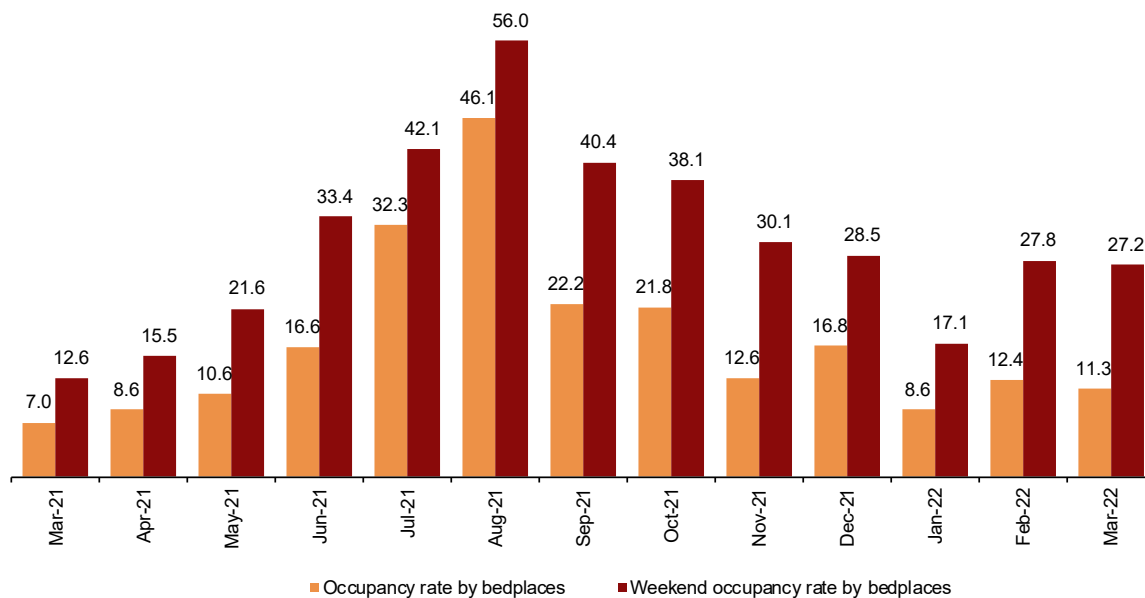

In rural tourism accommodation, 11.3% of the bed-places were occupied, 62.4% more than March 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.2%, with an annual increase of 115.6%.

Percentage



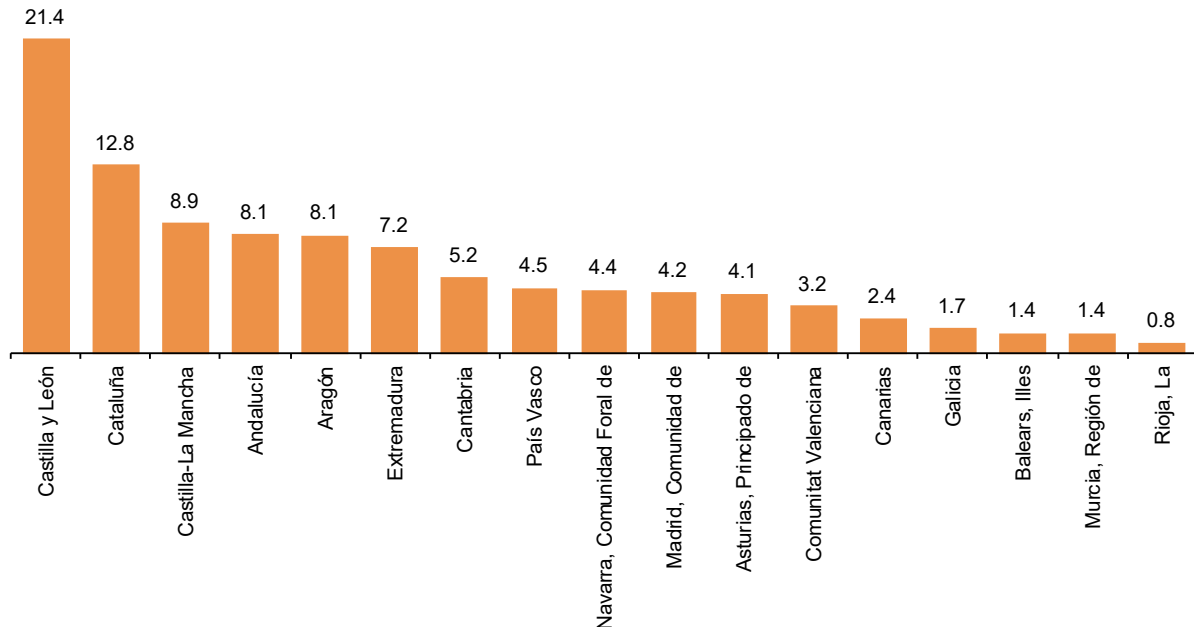
By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 87,957 overnight stays, 201.9% more than in March 2021. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 34.7% of bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 36,064 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal National Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 44.3% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage

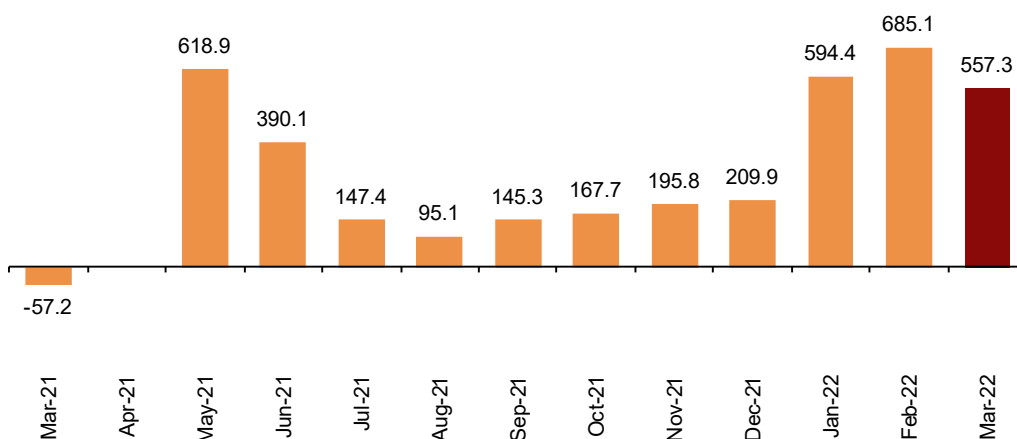


## Hostels

In March, there were 351,627 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 557.3%. Resident overnight stays increased by 328.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 1,373.4%.

## Annual variation rates for overnight stays <sup>4</sup>

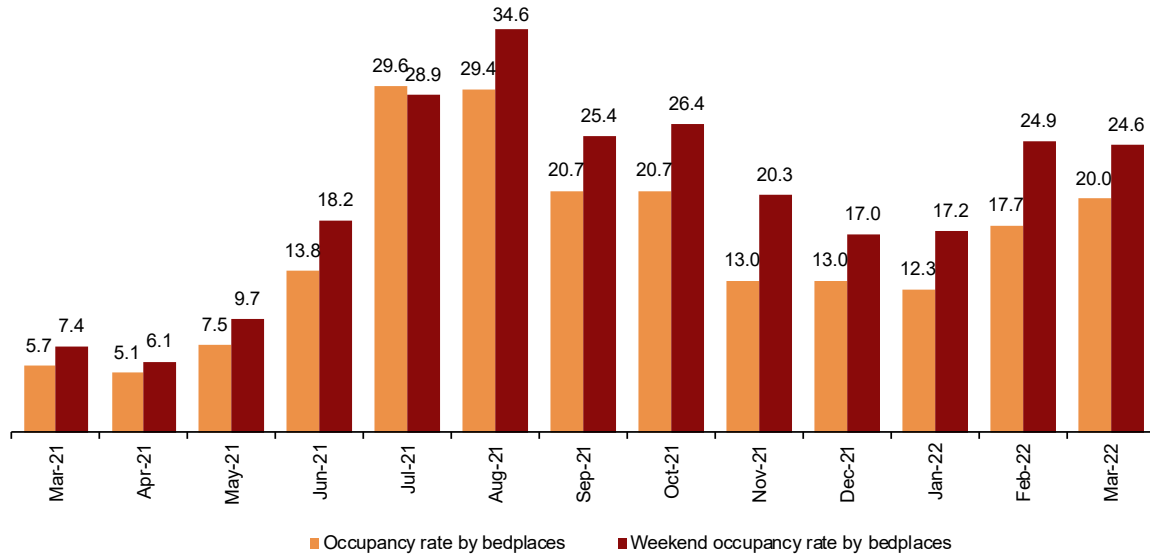

Percentage

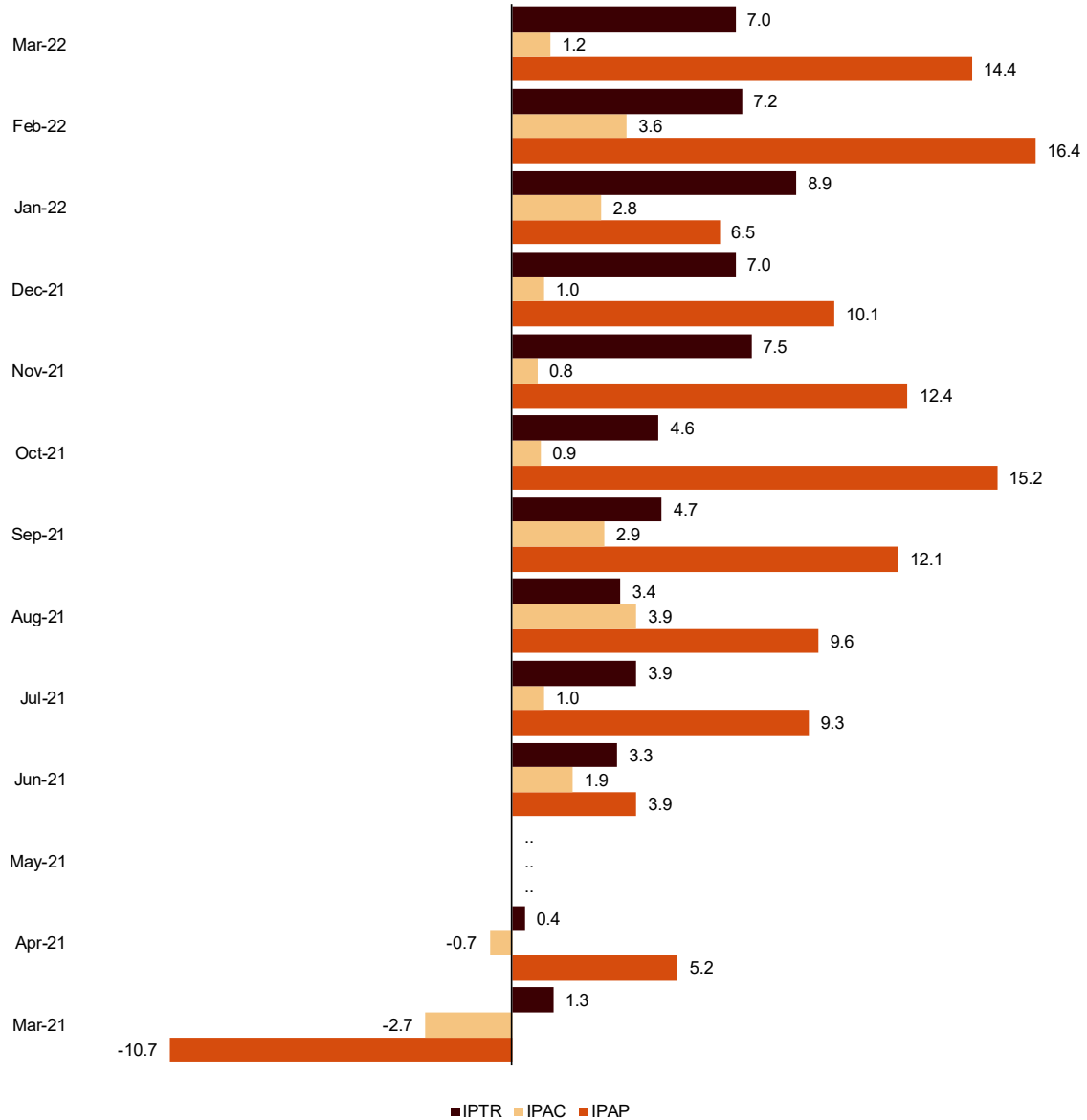


Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 72,259 overnight stays. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 58.6% of the bed-places offered.

**Price indices<sup>5</sup>**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 14.4% in March compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 1.2%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.0%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In March, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>6</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 316.2% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 130.0%, and those of non-residents by 732.9%.

The average stay grew by 27.6%, to 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.

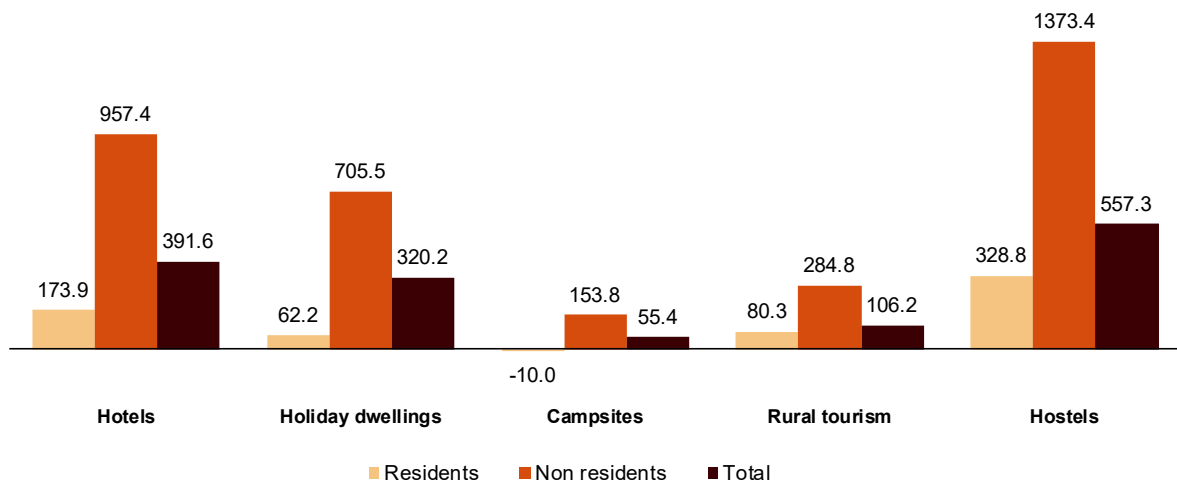

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 74.7% corresponded to hotels, and 25.3% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.7%) and France (6.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 7.4 million overnight stays (770.8% more than in March 2021). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.7 million overnight stays (and an increase of 387.4%) and Cataluña, with over 3.0 million, (and an annual increase of 220.8%).

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for March 2021 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
