Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey
April 2007. Provisional data

Overnight stays in group non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased 2% in April, as compared to the same month in 2006.

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 7,5 million in April, 2% less than in the same month of the previous year. While the interannual rate of overnight stays corresponding to residents increased 1.1%, the one corresponding to non-residents decreased 4,3%.

The average stay increased 3.4%, and reached 5.1 overnight stays per traveller.

During **the first four months of the year**, overnight stays have increased 2.3% as compared to the same period of the previous year. Increases have been registered both for residents and non-residents regarding overnight stays (3.5% and 1.9%, respectively).

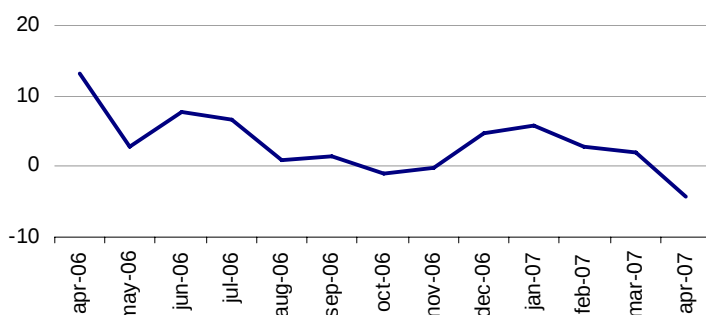
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 3,5% in April

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 4.6 million in April, representing a 3.5% drop as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays decreased 1% and non-resident overnight stays decreased 4.4%.

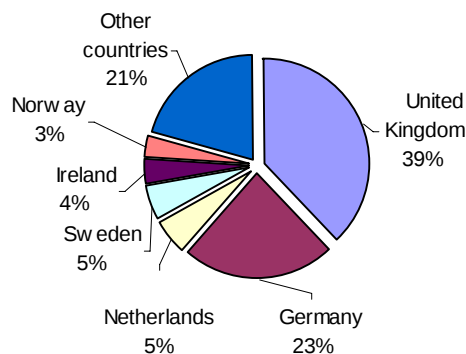
During **the first four months of the year**, the interannual rate of overnight stays rose 1.6%, with increases of 1.8% for residents and 1.6% for non-residents.

The number of bed places in holiday dwellings increased 2%, exceeding 428,000 bed places. 35.9% of the total number of bed places available were occupied in April, 5.4% less than in the same month of 2006. On another hand, 50.9% of the total number of available holiday dwellings were occupied, representing a 5.1% drop as compared to April 2006.

Overnight stays of non residents amounted to 74.2% of the total in holiday dwellings. **The United Kingdom is the main country of origin** (with 38% of the total) with over 1.3 million overnight stays in April, 2.3% less than in the previous year.

The next country of origin is Germany, which exceeded 805,000 overnight stays, 11.6% less than in April 2006.

Regarding holiday dwellings, **Canarias was the preferred destination**, with 2.8 million overnight stays, 6% less than in April 2006. The second destination was Comunitat Valenciana, with over 480,500 overnight stays (9.5% less).

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. For their part, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were destinations with most overnight stays on behalf of resident travellers.

The **greatest level of occupation** in holiday dwellings was measured at **Comunidad de Madrid**, with 76,1% of available apartments occupied, followed by Navarra (67.4%) and Canarias (60.1%).

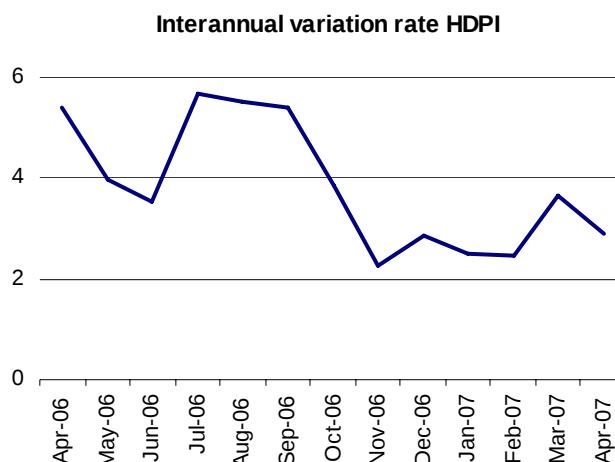
By **tourist areas**, the Island of Gran Canaria was the destination preferred in this accommodation modality, with over one million overnight stays in April and a 62.6% occupancy level.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona were the tourist sites in which the greatest number of overnight stays were recorded.

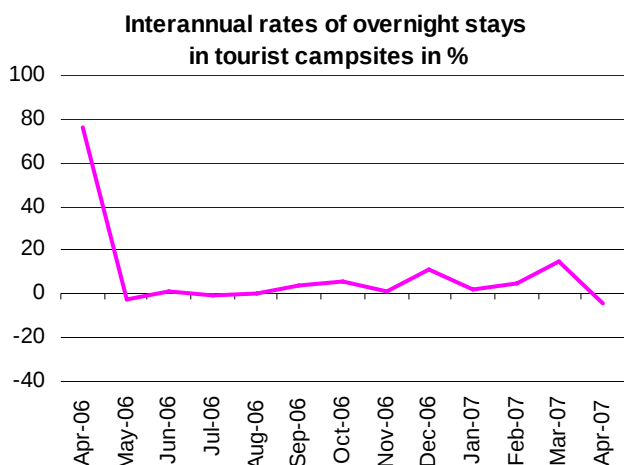
Prices in holiday dwellings increased 2.9% in April

The Holiday Dwellings Price Index registered 2.9% increase in April, a rate 0.7 points below that for the previous month. The interannual *tour-operator* fee rate, which has the greatest weight in this month's weight structure (59.4%), increased by 3.2%.

By modalities, 2/4 bed place apartments, whose weight is 67.9%, increased their prices by 2.5%, as compared to April 2006.



Overnight stays in tourist campsites decreased 4.3%



Overnight stays in tourist campsites exceeded 2 million in April, representing a 4.3% interannual rate decrease. Overnight stays by non resident travellers decreased 4%, while those by residents decreased 4.4%.

Tourist campsites offer over 550,000 bed places, 4.1% more than in the same month of 2006. 31.7% of available lots were occupied (representing a 5.3% drop) and the level of occupation by lots during the weekend reached 36.3% (i.e. 0.6% drop).

Non-residents were accountable for 32.4% of overnight stays in holiday dwellings. **The United Kingdom is the main country of origin**, accounting for 30.6% of overnight stays by non-residents (10.3% more than in 2006). The next country of origin is Germany.

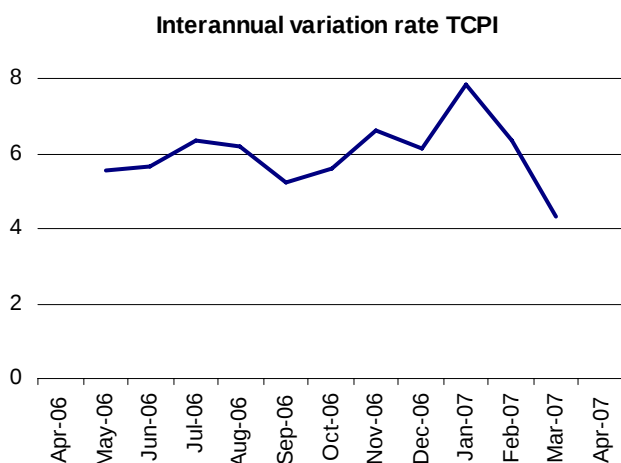
The **Cataluña** is the **preferred camping destination**, with over 776,000 overnight stays, 2.1% less than in April 2006. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with over 441,000 overnight stays, representing a 2.2% increase, as compared to the previous year.

Among non-residents, Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía were the destinations preferred. Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the destinations with more overnight stays by resident travellers.

In April, **the greatest campsite occupancy level** was registered at **La Rioja** (with 58% of available lots), followed by Comunitat Valenciana (52.1%) and Comunidad de Madrid (45.3%).

On a **tourist area** basis, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 295,000 overnight stays and an occupancy level of 24.1% in April. Benidorm, Vilanova i La Geltrú and Blanes were the **tourist destinations** with more overnight stays.

Prices in tourist campsites increased 3.2%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index interannual growth rate stood at 3.2% in April. The *normal* rate, which has a greater weight in the weight structure for this month (62.9%) increased 2.6%.

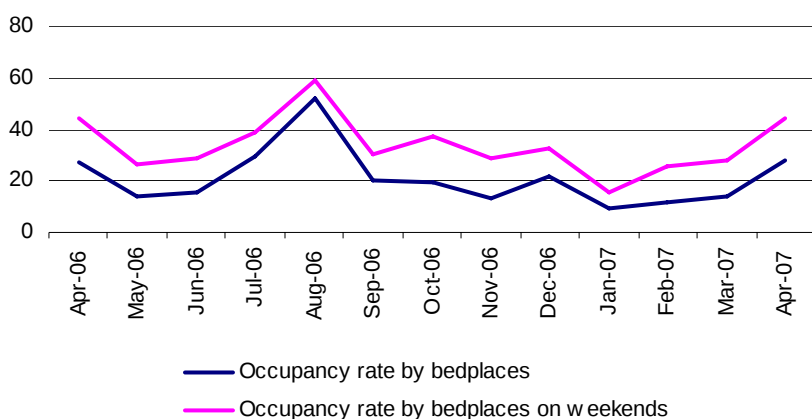
Regarding categories, second class, with a 61.3% weight in April, increased 3.7%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation increased 16.1% in April, as compared to the same month in the previous year

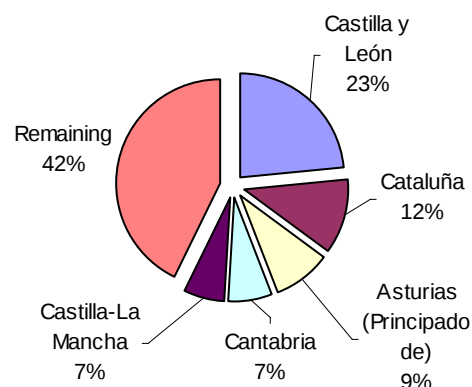
Overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation almost reached 897,000 in April, which translates into a 13.3% increase with regards to the same month in the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increase by 16.1% while non-resident stays decreased by 3.1%.

Rural tourism accommodation establishments offered over 105,000 bed places in April, 8.8% more than in the same month of 2006. 28% of these bed places were occupied, representing a 4% increase. The level of occupation during weekends stood at 44.6%, 0.1% less than in the previous year.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in Rural tourism accommodation, with over 191,000 overnight stays, 18.6% more than in April 2006. Cataluña was the second destination of choice with 98,000 overnight stays (28.7% more).

Among non-residents, **Illes Balears** was the preferred destination, while the destinations with more overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Asturias.

The highest occupancy level in rural tourist accommodation in April was registered at Illes Balears (with 44.4% of available bed places), followed by País Vasco (38.7%) and La Rioja (37.9%).

By **tourist areas**, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination of choice, with almost 46,000 overnight stays and a occupancy level of 28.4% in April. Costa Guipúzcoana achieved the greatest level of occupancy on a weekend bed place basis (68%).

Annex

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish group tourist accommodation (hotels, apartments, camp sites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 1.6% interannual increase** in April. Resident and non-resident overnight stays grew 3.1% and 0.2%, respectively.

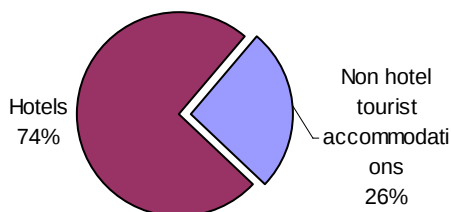
Considering that the interannual growth rate of overnight stays exceeds that of travellers (0.5%), the **average stay increases by 1%**, standing at 3.3 overnight stays by traveller.

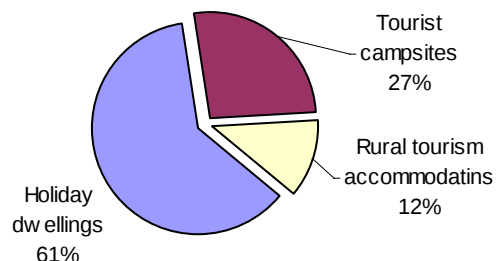

74% of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in April were accounted for at hotels, while 26% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in the set of regulated tourist accommodation as a whole were Germany (accounting for 29.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), United Kingdom (26.5%) and France with (7.5%).

Canarias was the **preferred destination** considering overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with over 6.8 million of overnight stays, 2% less than in April 2006. Andalucía is the second destination of choice, with over 4.8 million of overnight stays (1.3% more).

The preferred destinations by non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. On another hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with more overnight stays by residents.
