Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys April 2009. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 14.0% in April, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 6.4 million in April, 14.0% more than in the same month the previous year. This increase was due, in part, to the effect of Easter week, which took place in April this year, whereas it took place in March in 2008. Overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain increased 65.5%, while stays by non-residents decreased 8.7%.

Upon analysing the months of **March and April** together, a decrease of 8.7% was observed in overnight stays, as compared with the same period in 2008. Overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain decreased 1.1%, and those of non-residents decreased 12.4%.

During the **first four months of 2009**, overnight stays decreased 10.2% with respect to the same period the previous year.

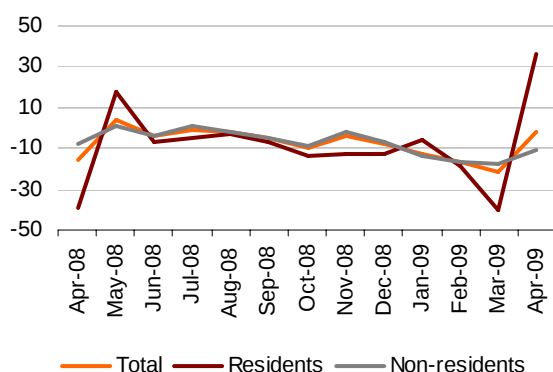

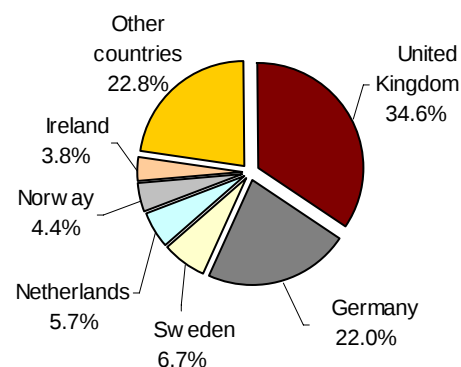
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 1.9% in April in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.8 million in April, indicating a decrease of 1.9% as compared with the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by non-resident travellers decreased 10.6%, while those made by travellers resident in Spain increased 36.4%. On analysis of the **March-April aggregate period**, a decrease of 12.8% was observed in overnight stays, as compared with the same two months of 2008.

Available holiday dwellings increased 1.2%, reaching 411,037 bedplaces. **This month, 30.8% of the total available bedplaces were occupied**, 3.0% less than in April 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 34.3%**, with an interannual increase of 3.2%. **In the March-April period**, 32.4% of the available bedplaces were filled, 11.7% less than during the same period in 2008.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 74.1% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 977,020 overnight stays, 24.8% less than in April 2008. The following market was Germany, with 620,836 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -2.9%.

In the aggregate period of March and April 2009, these two countries also constituted the main countries of origin, and in the same order, with interannual rates of -23.9% and -11.0%, respectively.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination for non-residents. Overnight stays of foreign nationals in this Community, which represented 70.1% of the national total, decreased 11.7% as compared with April 2008. It was followed by Andalucía (with an interannual rate of -12.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana, with a decrease of 12.4%. **During the whole of March and April**, Canarias was also the Autonomous Community with the highest number of non-resident overnight stays, ahead of Andalucía.

Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía were the main destinations of Spaniards, with interannual overnight stay rates of 15.4%, 74.7% and 58.8%, respectively. **Over March and April together**, these Communities maintained the same order of preference for resident travellers.

Comunidad Foral de Navarra presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 62.1% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (57.1%) and Canarias (52.9%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 873,182 overnight stays. The island of Tenerife reached the highest occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (56.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (62.0%).

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

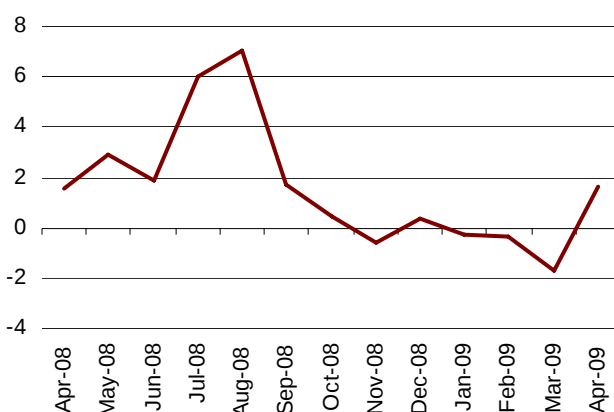
Prices for holiday dwellings increase 1.6% in April

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 1.6% increase in April, a rate 3.4 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (64.7%), increased 3.3% in the interannual rate.

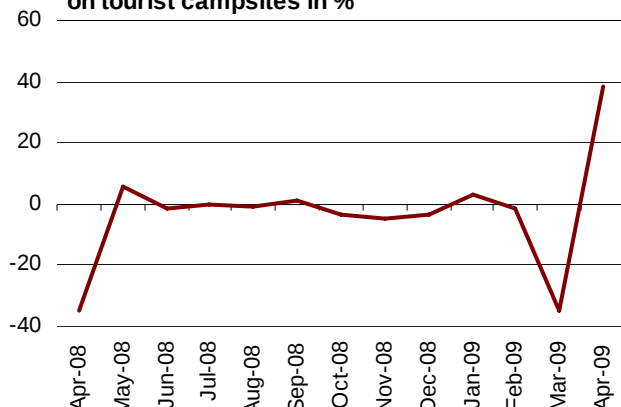
By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 71.7%, increased their prices 1.8% as compared with April 2008.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 38.3%

Interannual rates of overnight stays on tourist campsites in %



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.8 million overnight stays in April, indicating an interannual increase of 38.3%. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew 79.2%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 2.2%. During the March-April period, overnight stays decreased 1.9%.

Tourist campsites offered 547,900 bedplaces, 2.9% more than in the same month of 2008. 30.6% of the available lots were occupied, for a 3.5% increase. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 32.7%, that is, 4.4% more than in April 2008.

Over March and April as a whole, 32.1% of the available lots were occupied, 2.3% less than during the same period in 2008.

35.6% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, accounting for 31.5% of these overnight stays (9.1% less than in April 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 657,009 overnight stays, 28.9% more in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 408,780 overnight stays, and an increase of 22.9%. **During the March-April period**, these two Communities maintained the same order of preference.

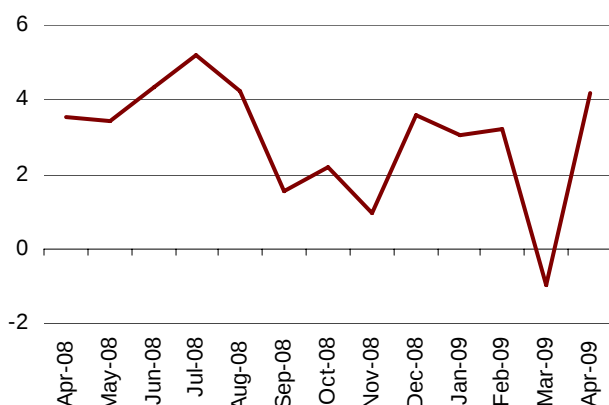
Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía. For resident travellers, the destinations with the most overnight stays were, in order, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in April, with 59.7% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (49.1%) and Comunidad de Madrid (48.5%). **During the March-April period**, these three Communities also reached the highest occupancy rates, with 61.8%, 52.3% and 49.5%, respectively.

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 247,779 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy, with 54.5% of the available lots covered. The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Vilanova i La Geltrú and Blanes.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 4.2% in the interannual rate

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 4.2% in April. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (55.5%), presented an increase of 6.4%.

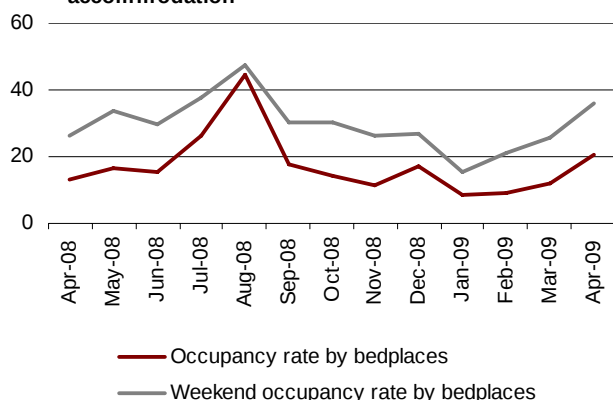
Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 51.4% this month, registered an interannual increase of 3.8%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 100.4% in April as compared with the same month the previous year

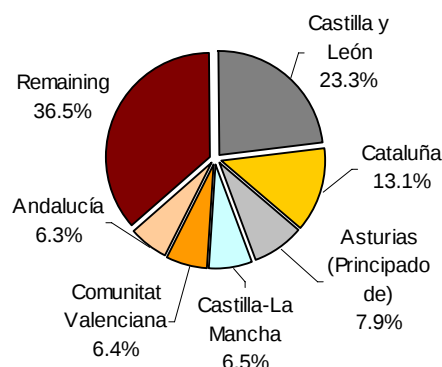
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 804,248 in April, indicating an interannual Increase of 80.2%. Overnight stays by residents increased 100.4%, and non-resident stays increased 9.4%. **During the March-April period**, overnight stays increased 4.9% in the interannual rate.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 127,755 bedplaces, 10.9% more than in April 2008. Of these bedplaces, 20.8% were occupied, representing a 61.8% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 35.8%, that is, 37.4% more in the interannual rate. **In the March-April period**, 16.4% of the bedplaces were occupied. 3.6% less than in 2008.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 167,786 overnight stays, 89.5% more than in April 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, which exceeded 93,400 overnight stays, 73.0% more. **During the March-April period**, the interannual rates of overnight stays in these two Communities were 13.2% and -2.0%, respectively.

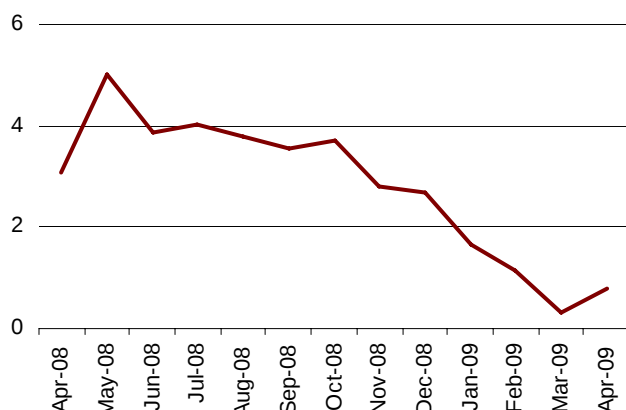
Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 40.0% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by La Rioja (31.1%) and País Vasco (28.3%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 41,741 overnight stays in April. The island of Mallorca reached the highest occupancy (42.3%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 0.8%

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 0.8% in April.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.9%), rose 0.9%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 62.4%, recorded an interannual increase of 1.6%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered an interannual increase of 4.7% in April**. Overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain increased 21.1%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 6.6%. **During the aggregate March-April period**, the number of overnight stays decreased 8.5% as compared with the same period in 2008. Overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain decreased 5.4%, and those of non-resident travellers decreased 10.9%.

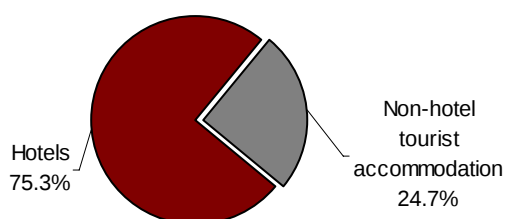
The average stay grew 2.1% as compared with April 2008, and stood at 3.3 nights per traveller.

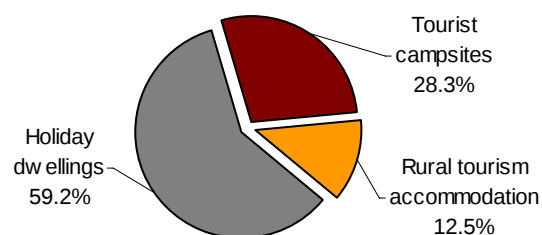

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of April, 75% corresponded to hotels, and 25% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 27.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (24.0%) and France (8.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 5.9 million overnight stays, 7.6% less than in April 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 4.3 million overnight stays (15.8% more) and Andalucía, with 4.3 million overnight stays (3.6% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Cataluña and Illes Balears. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
