

Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys

May 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 14.6% in May, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 6.2 million in May, 14.6% less than in the same month of the previous year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -7.0%), and non-residents (-18.4%).

The average stay decreased 11.2% as compared with May 2008, and stood at 4.8 nights per traveller.

During the first five months of the year, overnight stays decreased 11.2% with respect to the same period in the previous year.




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 20.2% in May in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.8 million in May, indicating a decrease of 20.2% as compared with the same month the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -16.1%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -21.3%.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 3.7%, standing at 465,909 bedplaces. **This month, 26.9%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 17.0% less than in May 2008. **Level of occupancy by bedplaces at weekends was 29.9%**, with an interannual decrease of 14.9%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 39.4% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 12.2%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.5% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays, 23.0% less than in May of last year. The following market was Germany, with 589,646 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -20.2%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 26.5% less than in May 2008. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 912,108 million overnight stays, 17.5% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

País Vasco presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 60.5% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (58.6%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (50.5%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 660,136 overnight stays. Costa del Sol reached the highest occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (57.2%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate for holiday dwellings (60.5%).


San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

Prices for holiday dwellings increase 3.5% in May


The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 3.5% decrease in May, a rate 5.1 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (56.3%), decreased 3.3% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 65.8%, decreased their prices 3.8% as compared with May 2008.



Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 1.3%



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.8 million overnight stays in May, indicating an interannual decrease of 1.3%. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew 5.8% in the interannual rate, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 8.3%.

Tourist campsites offered 595,920 bedplaces, 0.3% less than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 30.2% were occupied, for a 1.3% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 34.1%, that is, 0.2% less than in May 2008.

46.7% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 28.2% of overnight stays by non-residents (12.6% less than in May 2008). The following country of origin was the Netherlands.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 913,531 overnight stays, 0.9% less in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 315,146 overnight stays, and a decrease of 6.4%.

The destinations preferred by both residents and non-residents were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in May, with 61.8% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (47.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (44.0%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 389,112 overnight stays. Costa del Maresme reached the highest occupancy, with 53.3% of the available lots covered. The tourist destinations with most overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Blanes.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 2.6% in the interannual rate




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 2.6% in May. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (59.6%), presented an increase of 2.2%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 49.6% this month, registered an interannual increase of 3.5%.


Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 12.0% in May as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 543,040 in May, representing an interannual decrease of 10.7%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 12.0%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 5.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 128,735 bedplaces, 9.7% more than in May 2008. 13.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing an 18.4% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 29.2%, that is, 13.2% less in the interannual rate.



Distribution on rural tourist accommodation of overnight stays of Spanish travellers in %




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 111,945 overnight stays, 2.9% less than in May 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 66,474 overnight stays, 10.0% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 44.7% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (22.2%) and La Rioja (18.4%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 48,726 overnight stays in May and an occupancy rate of 47.1%.

Rural tourism accommodation prices decrease 1.1%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 1.1% in May.

The weekend rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (64.5%), fell 1.3%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 60.5%, recorded an interannual decrease of 0.5%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 10.2% interannual decrease in May. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -6.8%), and non-residents (-12.1%).


The average stay decreased 2.8% and stood at 3.3 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of May, 78% corresponded to hotels, and 22% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (26.3%) and France (7.8%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.1 million overnight stays (8.7% less than in May 2008). Next were Cataluña, with 5.3 million overnight stays (2.4% less) and Canarias, with 4.6 million overnight stays (20.0% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with most overnight stays per resident.
