Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
May 2021 Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation exceeded 3.7 million in May, compared to 301,000 in the same month of 2020

During the first five months of 2021, overnight stays decreased by 22.2% as compared to the same period of the previous year.

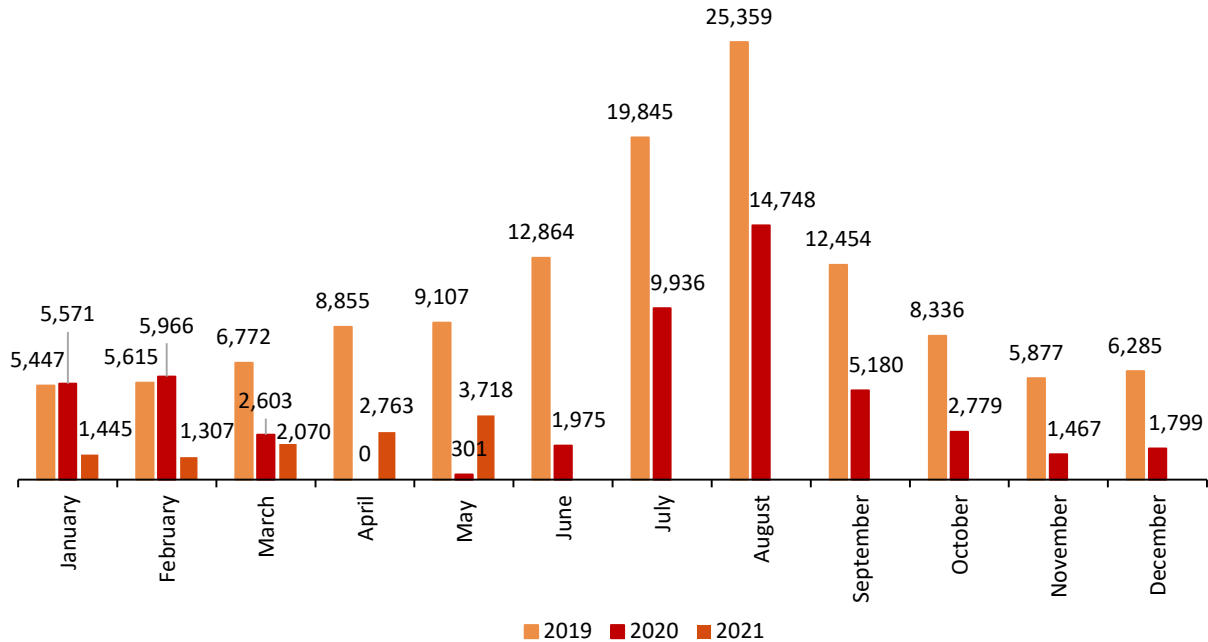
During the month of May, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments (apartments, campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceed 3.7 million. This figure is 12 times that of 2020, when there were 301,000.

Compared to May 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 59.8%.

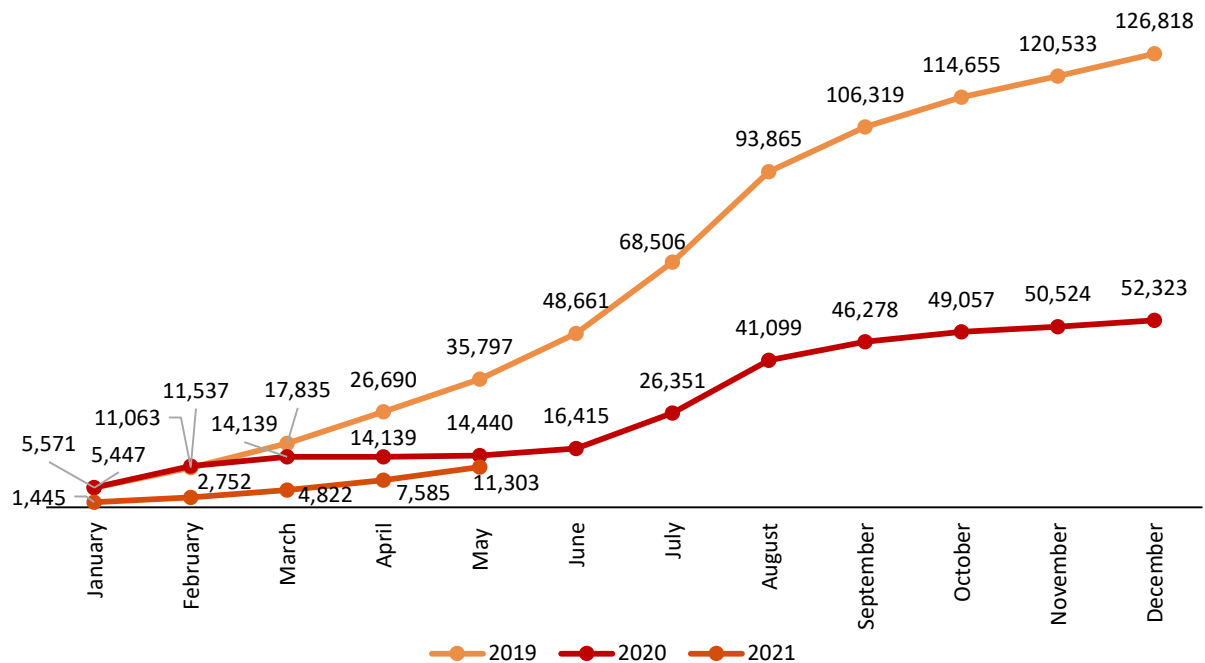
By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents of Spain, which represent 71.9% of the total, rose to 2.6 million. For their part, those of non-residents reached 1.0 million, representing 28.1% of the total.

During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays increased by 22.2% as compared to the same period of the previous year.

Open establishments

In May, a total of 107,390 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 59.5% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

Holiday Dwellings

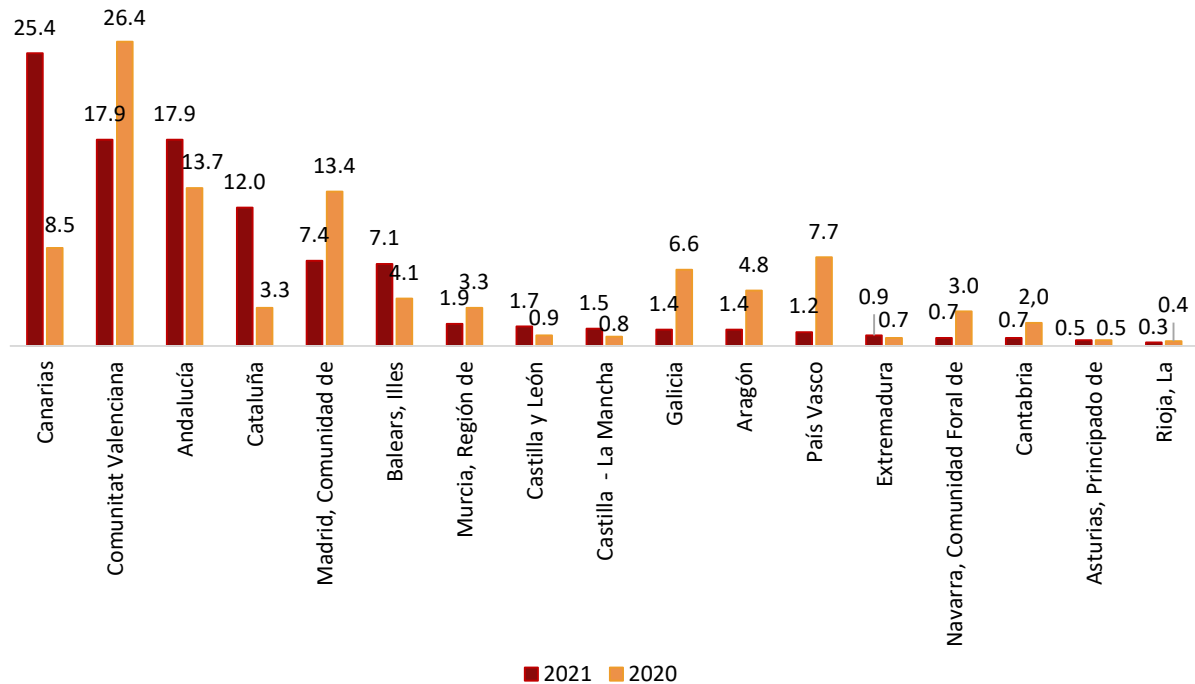
Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 1.4 million in April. Of the total overnight stays, 62.3% corresponded to residents, and 37.7% to non-residents.

During the first five months of 2021, the total number of overnight stays fell by 51.1% compared to the same period of 2020.

By communities, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucia were the main destinations for travellers in the month of May, with 356,645, 251,361 and 251,215 overnight stays, respectively.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 156,703 overnight stays. Costa de Barcelona was the area with the highest occupancy rate, with 78.2% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in May were San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Benidorm.

Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays at campsites amounted to 1.7 million in May. Of the total overnight stays, 78.1% corresponded to residents, and 21.9% to non-residents.

During the first five months of 2021, the total of overnight stays in this type of accommodation rose by 50.1% compared to the same period of 2020.

In May, 30.2% of available pitches were occupied, and the weekend occupancy rate reached 34.7%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 754,095 overnight stays. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 61.4% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination for camping in May. Costa Blanca was the area with the highest occupancy rate, with 56.0% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Tarragona, and Mont-Roig Del Camp.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation came to 460,632 in May. Of the total overnight stays, 76.3% corresponded to residents, and 23.7% to non-residents.

During the first five months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 20.2% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In rural tourism accommodation, 10.6% of bedplaces were occupied in May. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 21.6%.

By autonomous community, Illes Balears is the preferred destination, with 85,817 overnight stays. It also registered the highest occupancy rate, with 39.7% of available bed-places.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 71,072 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera registered the highest occupancy rate, with 43.2% of bed-places offered.

Hostels

In May, overnight stays in hostels¹ stood at 92,333. A total of 76.1% corresponded to residents and 23.9% to non-residents.

During the first three four of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 46.4% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In May, 7.5% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 9.7%.

By communities, Pirineus was the main destination, with 28,334 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate in May, with 22.6% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

In May 2021, the Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) stood at 168.8, the Tourist Apartment Price Index (TCPI) at 150.6, and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) at 141.6².

¹ Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of May 2020, and [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

² In May 2020, no non-hotel price indexes (TAPI, TCPI and RTAPI) were published due to the low number of open non-hotel establishments. The annual variation rates for May 2021 were thus not disclosed.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In May, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels³, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 10.9 million. Resident overnight stays accounted for 66.8% and non-resident overnight stays for 33.2%.

During the first five months of 2021, overnight stays in the totality of Spanish collective tourist accommodations decreased by 45.6% compared to the same period of the previous year.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in May, 66.0% corresponded to hotels, and 34.0% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were Germany (with 26.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (17.6%), and the United Kingdom (6.9%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 2.0 million overnight stays. These are followed by Andalucía (with more than 1.8 million) and Comunitat Valenciana (with more than 1.3 million).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for May 2020 of the Occupancy Survey in: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS). As well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
