Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy surveys
June 2007. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 0.6% in June, as compared to the same month in 2006

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 9.7 million in June, 0.6% more than in the same month of the previous year. While the interannual rate of overnight stays corresponding to residents increased 6.2%, that corresponding to non-residents decreased 2.3%.

The average stay decreased 3.4%, and stood at 5.4 nights per traveller.

During **the first six months of the year 41.5 million overnight stays were registered**, for an increase of 1.7% over the same period of the previous year. Increases were registered in both resident and non-resident overnight stays (4.9% and 0.5%, respectively).


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 0.9% in June

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 6.4 million in June, representing a 0.9% decrease as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased 7.8% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 3.4%.


During **the first six months of the year**, the interannual rate of overnight stays rose 0.9%, with increases of 5% for residents and no variation for non-residents.

The number of available holiday dwellings increased 0.9%, reaching almost 530,000 bedplaces. 40% of the total number of bedplaces available were occupied in June, 1.7% less in the interannual rate. 54% of the total number of available holiday dwellings were occupied, representing a 0.5% increase as compared to June 2006.

Non-resident overnight stays amounted to 75.4% of the total in holiday dwellings. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin** (representing 43.9% of the total) with over 2.1 million overnight stays in June, 9% less than in June of the previous year.

The next country of origin was Germany, which exceeded one million overnight stays, 1.4% less than in June 2006.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, 6.1% less than in June 2006. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 1.8 million overnight stays (2.4% more).

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice, whereas, Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

The **highest occupancy level** in holiday dwellings was registered in **Comunidad de Madrid**, with 80.1% of the available apartments occupied, followed by Illes Balears (69.6%) and Navarra (61.5%).


By **tourist areas**, the Island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.1 million overnight stays in June and a 69.1% occupancy level.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Calvià and Tias were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.


Prices for holiday dwellings increase 3.9% in June

The Holiday Dwellings Price Index registered a 3.9% increase in June, a rate 2.4 points higher than that for the previous month. The interannual *tour-operator fee* rate, which had the greatest weight in this month's weight structure (58.2%), increased 4.8%.

By modalities, 2/4 bed place apartments, whose weight was 66.7%, increased their prices by 3.3%, as compared to June 2006.



Overnight stays in tourist campsites increase 2.1%



Overnight stays in tourist campsites exceeded 2.7 million in June, representing a 2.1% interannual rate increase. Overnight stays by residents increased 2.3% and by non-resident travellers, 2.0%.

Tourist campsites offered over 693,600 bedplaces, 0.6% less than in the same month of 2006. 32.3% of the available lots were occupied, for a 0.8% drop in the interannual rate and the weekend occupancy level by lots reached 35.6% (same occupancy as in June 2006).

Non-residents were accountable for 44.7% of overnight stays in tourist campsites. **The Netherlands was the main country of origin**, accounting for 22% of overnight stays by non-residents (6.3% more than in 2006). The next country of origin was Germany.


Cataluña was the preferred camping destination, with over 1.5 million overnight stays, 2.2% more than in June 2006. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with over 366,000 overnight stays, 6.6% more than in the previous year.

Among non-residents, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with more overnight stays by resident travellers.

In June, the highest campsite occupancy level was registered in **La Rioja** (with 58.8% of the available lots), followed by Comunidad de Madrid (46.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana (46%).

On a **tourist area** basis, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with almost 763,000 overnight stays, while Costa del Garraf registered the highest occupancy level in June (60%). Salou, Sant Pere Pescador, and Castelló d'Empúries were the **tourist destinations** with the most overnight stays.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.6%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index interannual growth rate stood at 3.6% in June. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (69.9%), increased 4.6%.

Regarding categories, second class, with a 52.8% weight in June, increased 4.8%.



Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation increase 15.4% in June, as compared to the same month of the previous year


Overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation exceeded 525,700 in June, an 11.5% increase with regard to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 15.4% while non-resident stays decreased 0.7%.

Rural tourist accommodation offered more than 106,000 bedplaces in June, 7.6% more than in the same month of 2006. 16.4% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 3.5% increase. The weekend occupancy level stood at 29.2%, 1.8% more than in June of the previous year.

Castilla y León was the **preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with almost 92,000 overnight stays, 14.1% more than in June 2006. Cataluña was the second destination of choice with over 65,000 overnight stays (10.4% more).

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, while the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

The highest occupancy level in rural tourist accommodation in June was registered in Illes Balears (with 58.1% of the available bedplaces), followed by País Vasco (47.4%) and Cataluña (43.5%).

By **tourist areas**, the Island of Mallorca was the main destination of choice, with more than 48,000 overnight stays and an occupancy level of 54.3% in June.

Annex

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 1.8% interannual increase in June. Resident overnight stays increased 5.4% and non-resident overnight stays decreased 0.3%.


Considering that the interannual growth rate of travellers was greater than that of overnight stays (5.2%), the **average stay decreased 3.2%**, standing at 3.7 nights per traveller.



75% of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in June were accounted for at hotels, while 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** considering overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (accounting for 33.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (27.5%) and Netherlands (with 4.8%).

Illes Balears was the **preferred destination** considering overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with over 9.6 million overnight stays, 1.5 less than in June 2006, followed by Cataluña, with over 7.1 million overnight stays (0.1% more) and Canarias with almost 6 million overnight stays (0.1% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
