

## Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys

June 2009. Provisional data

### Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 12.0%\* in June, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 8.3 million in June, 12.0% less than in the same month the previous year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -1.1 %), and non-residents (-18.3%). **The average stay decreased 7.2%** as compared with June 2008, and stood at 5.2 nights per traveller.

During the first semester of the year, overnight stays decreased 11.4% with respect to the same period the previous year.




### Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 18.1% in June in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 5.1 million in June, indicating a decrease of 18.1% as compared with the same month the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -7.1%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -21.7%.

\* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section denominated linking coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 1.4%, standing at 513,947 bedplaces. **This month, 33.1%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 16.3% less than in June 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 35.7%**, with an interannual decrease of 14.6%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 45.9% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 13.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 72.3% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 24.9% less than in June of last year. The following market was Germany, with 733,020 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -13.2%.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 27.2% less than in June 2008. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 1.4 million overnight stays, 15.2% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña.

**Illes Balears** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 62.6% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (58.4%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (50.8%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 924,093 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 70.5% of the available holiday dwellings.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Alcúdia were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.


### **Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 2.5% in June**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 2.5% decrease in June, a rate 0.9 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (62.4%), decreased 2.8% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 66.9%, decreased their prices 3.2% as compared with June 2008.

## Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 0.8%



Tourist campsites reached 2.7 million overnight stays in June, indicating an interannual increase of 0.8%. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew 5.8% in the interannual rate, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 5.6%.

Tourist campsites offered 691,626 bedplaces, 1% less than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 31.9% were occupied, for a 1.3% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 35.7%, that is, 3.7% less than in June 2008.

40.7% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The Netherlands was the main country of origin**, with 24.6% of overnight stays by non-residents (4.0% less than in June 2008). The following country of origin was the United Kingdom.


**Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping**, with more than 1.4 million overnight stays, 3.2% less in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 348,566 overnight stays, and a decrease of 1.8%.

The destinations preferred by both residents and non-residents were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

**La Rioja** reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in June, with 63.5% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (49.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (45.4%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 681,084 overnight stays. Costa del Maresme reached the highest occupancy, with 53.9% of the available lots occupied. The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Salou, Blanes and Torroella de Montgrí.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 2.9% in the interannual rate





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 2.9% in June. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (69.9%), presented an increase of 3.0%.

Regarding category, luxury and first class, with a weighting of 49.4% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.6%.

## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 3.5%\* in June as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 536,914 in June, representing an interannual decrease of 4.1%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 3.5%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 6.3%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 130,469 bedplaces, 10.1% more than in June 2008. 13.7% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 12.8% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.4%, that is, 10.8% less in the interannual rate.




**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 98,487 overnight stays, 2.4% more than in June 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 72,893 overnight stays, 13.4% less.

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination.** In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 49.8% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (22.5%) and Cataluña (18.8%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 51,840 overnight stays in June and an occupancy rate of 51.2%.

## Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 1.4%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 1.4% in June.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (53.2%), fell 0.3%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 56.6%, recorded an interannual increase of 1.9%.

## Annex

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

**Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 7.8%\* interannual decrease in June.** The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at –4.2%), and non-residents (–10.0%).


The average stay decreased 0.8% and stood at 3.7 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of June, 76% corresponded to hotels, and 24% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (27.1%) and France (5.6%).

**Illes Balears** was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 8.5 million overnight stays (6.8% less than in June 2008). Next were Cataluña, with 6.6 million overnight stays (6.1% less) and Canarias, with 4.9 million overnight stays (19.1% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
