

**Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey**  
**July 2007. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease  
3.4% in July, as compared to the same month in 2006**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 17.9 million in July, 3.4% less than in the same month of the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was more pronounced among non-residents (5.7% in interannual rate) than among residents (0.1%).

The average stay decreased 1.2%, and stood at 6.3 nights per guest.

**During the first seven months of the year, over 59.4 million overnight stays were recorded**, for an increase of 0.1% over the same period of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 2.9%, while those of non-residents decreased 1.2%.

**Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 4.4% in July**


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 9.5 million in July, representing a 4.4% decrease as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased 3.7% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 7.6%.

**During the first seven months of the year** overnight stays decreased by 0.5%. Resident overnight stays increased 4.6% and non-resident overnight stays decreased by 1.7%.


Available holiday dwellings decreased 1.5%, standing at 553,000 bedplaces. In July 54.9% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 2.3% fewer than in the same month last year. On the other hand, 66.7% of the total number of holiday dwellings offered were occupied, for

a decrease of 1.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays amounted to 69.5% of the total in holiday dwellings. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin** with over 2.5 million overnight stays, 14.5% fewer than in July of the previous year.

The next country of origin was Germany, which stood at 1.3 million overnight stays, 4.9% fewer than in July 2006.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than 3.2 million overnight stays, 10.5% fewer than in July 2006. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 2.3 million overnight stays, 2.9% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice, whereas, Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Andalucía were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident guests.

**Illes Balears** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 83.1% of available holiday dwellings occupied. They were followed by Comunidad de Madrid (66.8%) and Andalucía (64.3%).


By **tourist areas**, the Island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.4 million overnight stays in July and an 82.1% occupancy rate.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Calvià were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

### **Prices for holiday dwellings increase 4.4% in July**


The Holiday Dwellings Price Index registered a 4.4% increase in July, a rate 0.5 points higher than that for the previous month. The interannual *tour-operator* rate, which had the greatest weight in this month's weight structure (52.8%), increased 4.6%.

By modalities, 2/4 bedplace apartments, whose weight was 59.8%, increased their prices by 4.1%, as compared to July 2006.



## Overnight stays in tourist campsites increase 3.2%

Overnight stays in tourist campsites exceeded 7.3 million in July, representing a 3.2% interannual rate decrease. Overnight stays by residents decreased 3.9% and by non-resident guests, 2.5%.

Tourist campsites offered over 743,900 lots, 0.6% fewer than in the same month of 2006. 46.6% of the available lots were occupied, 0.7% fewer in the interannual rate and the weekend occupancy rate by lots reached 52.9%, 0.5% higher than in July 2006.

46.4% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were made by non-residents. **The Netherlands was the main country of origin**, accounting for 35% of overnight stays by non-residents (1.7% more than in 2006). The next country of origin was France.

**Cataluña** was the preferred camping destination, with over 3.9 million overnight stays, 2.5% less than in the July 2006. Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination, with approximately 733,000 overnight stays, 0.3% higher than the previous year.


Among non-residents, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident guests.

In July, the highest campsite occupancy rate was registered in **La Rioja** (with 59.2% of the available lots), followed by Comunidad de Madrid (57.5%) and Comunitat Valenciana (57.3%).

On a **tourist area basis**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with almost 2.2 million overnight stays, while Costa del Maresme registered the highest occupancy rate in July (69.7%). Torroella de Montgrí, Castelló d'Empúries and Blanes were the **tourist destinations** with the most overnight stays.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 4.5%

The Tourist Campsite Price Index interannual growth rate increased 4.5% in July. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (86.5%), increased 4.7%.


Regarding categories, second class, with a 48.5% weight in July, increased 6.1%.

**Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation increase 6.6% in July, as compared to the same month of the previous year**


Overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation exceeded 992,500 in July, a 6.2% increase with regard to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 6.6% while non-resident stays decreased 4.8%

Rural tourist accommodation offered more than 107,450 bedplaces in June, 7.1% more than in the same month of 2006. 29.5% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 0.9% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 40.3%, 2.6% more than in July of the previous year.

**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourist accommodation**, with almost 147,500 overnight stays, 4.4% more than in July 2006. Principado de Asturias was the second destination of choice with over 133,000 overnight stays (12.6% more).

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination**, while the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident guests were Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias and Cataluña.

The highest occupancy rate in rural tourist accommodation in July was registered in Illes Balears (with 63.1% of the available bedplaces), followed by Principado de Asturias (46.9%) and País Vasco (46.1%).

By **tourist areas**, Costa Verde was the main destination of choice, with approximately 67,000 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 64.5% in July.

## Annex

### Evolution of guest and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

**Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 0.5% interannual drop in July. Resident overnight stays increased 0.8%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 1.4%.


The average stay decreased 0.7%, standing at 4.4 nights per guest.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in July, 66% were accounted for at hotels and 34% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 24.1%) and Netherlands (with 8.8%).

**Illes Balears** was the **preferred destination** considering overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with 11.8 million overnight stays, 1.5 more than in July 2006. Next were Cataluña, with 11.4 million overnight stays (3.1% less) and Canarias, with almost eight million overnight stays (3.1% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
