Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys

August 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 6.5%* in August, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached 21.0 million in August, 6.5% less than in the same month the previous year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -3.8%), and non-residents (-9.5%). The average stay decreased 3.1% as compared with August 2008, and stood at 6.4 nights per traveller. In the period comprised of July and August, overnight stays decreased 7.5% as compared with the same period of 2008. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 2.5%, while those by non-residents decreased 12.0%.

During the first eight months of the year, overnight stays decreased 9.5% with respect to the same period the previous year.




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 10.4% in August in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 9.9 million in August, indicating a decrease of 10.4% as compared with the same month the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -4.8%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -13.6%.

* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section denominated "linking coefficients".

In July and August taken together, overnight stays decreased 11.6%, as compared with the same two months of 2008.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 0.3%, reaching 560,798 bedplaces. **This month, 56.4%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 9.1% less than in August 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 57.1%**, with an interannual decrease of 7.6%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 68.4% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 7.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 60.5% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than two million overnight stays, 21.5% less than in August of last year. The following market was France, with 954,402 overnight stays and an interannual rate of 9.2%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.9 million overnight stays, 20.2% less than in August 2008. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 2.1 million overnight stays, 10.7% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 77.8% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad Foral de Navarra (77.0%) and Cataluña (72.5%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 1,225,888 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 81.5% of the available holiday dwellings.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.


Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 0.8% in August

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.8% decrease in August, a rate 1.6 points higher than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.0%), decreased 0.1% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 58.9%, decreased their prices 1.6% as compared with August 2008.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 3.1%



Tourist campsites reached 9.4 million overnight stays in July, indicating an interannual decrease of 3.1%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 4.1% in the interannual rate, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 1.1%. During the July-August period, overnight stays decreased 3.5%.

Tourist campsites offered 749,106 bedplaces, 1.5% less than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 53.1% were occupied, for a 2.8% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 56.7%, that is, 0.4% less than in August 2008.

35.8% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **France was the main country of origin**, with 32.9% of overnight stays by non-residents (5.6% less than in August 2008). The following country of origin was the Netherlands.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 4.5 million overnight stays, 2.4% less in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 989,818 overnight stays, and a decrease of 7.7%.

Among resident travellers, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. The destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana, and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in August, with 74.6% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by País Vasco (70.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (62.1%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 2,377,555 overnight stays. Costa del Maresme reached the highest occupancy, with 72.5% of the available lots occupied. The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Salou and Blanes.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 4.3% in the interannual rate





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 4.3% in August. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (87.5%), presented an increase of 4.4%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 48.2% this month, registered an interannual increase of 3.7%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 0.8%* in August as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 1,703,480 in August, representing an interannual decrease of 0.3%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 0.8%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 6.8%. During the July-August period, overnight stays decreased 0.8%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 132,578 bedplaces, 9.4% more than in August 2008. 40.7% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing an 8.7% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 44.8%, that is, 5.6% less in the interannual rate.



Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 267,058 overnight stays, 7.1% more than in August 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 239,799 overnight stays, 4.3% more.


Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias and Cataluña.

Cantabria reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 64.2% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Baleares (61.2%) and País Vasco (60.8%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 99,792 overnight stays in August. Costa Guipuzcoana reached the highest occupancy (82.3%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 0.1%

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.1% in August.

The normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (69.9%), rose 0.6%. By rental modality, complete use, with a weighting of 66.4%, recorded an interannual increase of 0.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 5.5%* interannual decrease in August. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -0.3%), and non-residents (-10.2%). During the July-August period, overnight stays decreased 6.0%.

In August, the average stay decreased 1.1% and stood at 4.5 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of August, 63% corresponded to hotels, and 37% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.7%) and France (14.0%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 13.3 million overnight stays (0.7% less than in August 2008). Next were Illes Balears, with 10.9 million overnight stays (9.1% less) and Andalucía, with 7.8 million overnight stays (5.0% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
