Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys August 2019 Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 1.8% in August, as compared with the same month of 2018

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 25.2 million in August, 1.8% more than in the same month of 2018. Resident overnight stays increased 4.1% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 0.6%.

The average stay stood at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 8 months of 2019, overnight stays increased 0.2%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 0.3% in August. Overnight stays by residents increased 3.6%, while those by non-residents decreased by 1.6%.

It should be pointed out that the annual variation rates of overnight stays in holiday dwellings showed negative growth over the last few months (with the exception of April and August 2019, when Easter and Summer took place), mainly due to the fact that there are holiday dwelling establishments that are being reclassified, becoming considered as private housing for holiday use and therefore leaving the scope of observation of the Holiday Dwellings Occupancy Survey (HDOS).


The average stay decreased by 6.1% as compared with August 2018, standing at 6.3 overnight stays per traveller. In August, 58.8% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 2.9% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 58.8%, with an increase of 1.2%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 60.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 2.4 million overnight stays, 3.9% less than in August 2018. The following country of origin was France, with over 1.2 million overnight stays, 10.5% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 2.8 million overnight stays and a decrease of 7.5% compared with August 2018. Cantabria reached the highest occupancy rate, with 89.2% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays. The island of Mallorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 89.7% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in August were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Benidorm and Arona.


Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 3.1% in August as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 4.5%, and those of non-residents by 0.9%.

During the month of August, 58.0% of the offered pitches were occupied, 3.2% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 58.9%, with an annual decrease of 0.1%.

37.3% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were made by non-residents. France was the main country of origin, with 36.7% of overnight stays by non-residents, 7.9% more than in August 2018.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 5.2 million overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 2.0%. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 81.1% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 2.4 million overnight stays. On the other hand, Costa Gipuzkoa reached the highest occupancy rate, with 82.9% of pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Sant Pere Pescador.


Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 2.6% in August. Overnight stays by residents increased 4.5%, while those by non-residents decreased by 2.4%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 42.7% of the bed-places were occupied in August, 0.5% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 45.3%, with a decrease of 5.5%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 338,939 overnight stays, 3.9% more than August 2018. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.9% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 171,726 overnight stays. The island of Menorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 78.1% of the bed-places offered.

Distribution of overnight stays: residents



Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 7.5% in August. Resident overnight stays grew by 1.5%, and those of non-residents by 23.4%.


Annual variation rate for overnight stays Percentage



44.9% of available bed-places were occupied, 6.1% more than in August 2018. The weekend occupancy rate reached 41.5%, with a 6.1% decrease.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 125,206 overnight stays, 8.5% more than in August 2018. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 74.8% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 2.5% in August as compared to the same month in 2018.

For its part, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 2.4% and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) increased by 2.5%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In August, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 1.6% in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased 3.9%, while those by non-residents decreased by 0.1%.


The average stay decreased 2.2% in August, and stood at 4.1 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays made in collective tourist accommodation, 65% corresponded to hotels and 35% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (15.9%) and Germany (14.3%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with over 16.1 million overnight stays (3.2% more than in August 2018). It was followed by Illes Balears, with more than 13.0 million (a decrease of 0.6%) and Andalucía, with over 10.7 million, (an annual increase of 6.4%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to August in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

The data have also been revised for the August-December 2018 period of the Occupancy Surveys of: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that holiday dwelling establishments apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday dwelling establishments and/or companies operating holiday dwellings.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such a way that among all the establishments they cover the complete month.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and size of establishment, and for Canarias and Illes Balears stratified at island-size level.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

For more information on these statistical operations, you can consult the <u>methodology and the standardised methodological report</u> for each of them in INEbase.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand. The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that campsites apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that all the establishments cover the whole month.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Occupancy Survey (RTAOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
