### Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey August 2021 Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 49.2% in August, as compared with the same month of 2020

During the first eight months of 2021, overnight stays increased 36.3%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.


Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist lodgings (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 22.3 million in August, 49.2% more than in the same month of 2020.

By traveler origin, overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain amounted to 16.1 million, 32.0% more than in August 2020. Those of non-residents reached 6.1 million, with an increase of 127.1%.


Compared to August 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 14.6%. Overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain exceed the levels from before the pandemic (15.2% more), while those of non-residents remain lower (49.5% less).

During the first seven months of 2021, overnight stays increased 36.3%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

#### Open establishments

In August, a total of 163,883 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 84.1% of the total directory of establishments in this month.


#### **Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 8.8 million in August, 65.7% more than in August 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 46.0% and non-resident overnight stays by 118.8%.

During the first eight months of 2021, the total number of overnight stays rose by 20.5% compared to the same period of 2020.

By communities, Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Andalucia were the main destinations for travellers in the month of August, with 2.2, 1.5 and 1.4 overnight stays, respectively.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 1.2 million overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 81.3% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in August were Bernidorm, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Tías.

#### Campgrounds

Overnight stays at campgrounds came to 10.3 million in August, 44.5% more than in July 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 28.2%, and those by non-residents by 143.5%.

During the first seven months of 2021, total overnight stays at campgrounds rose by 55.5% compared to the same period of 2020.

In August, 57.6% of available pitches were occupied, and the weekend occupancy rate reached 61.0%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 4.5 million overnight stays La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 78.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination in July, with 2.0 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 77.7% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Benidorm.

#### Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodations rose to more than 2.4 million in August, 15.6% more than in the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 7.2%, and those by non-residents by 106.8%.

During the first seven months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 26.2% compared to the same period of 2020.

In rural tourism accommodation, 46.1% of bed-places were occupied in August. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 56.0%.

By autonomous communities, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 362,311 overnight stays. On the other hand, Cantabria had the highest occupancy rate, with 66.3% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 158,396 overnight stays. In Costa de Gipuzkoa, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 84.2% of the bed-places offered.

#### **Hostels**

Overnight stays in hostels<sup>1</sup> stood at 668,502 in August, 95.1% more than for the same month of 2020. Resident overnight stays grew by 91.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 114.2%.

During the first eight months of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 58.4% compared to the same period of 2020.

In August, 29.4% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 34.6%.

By communities, Galicia was the main destination, with 154,053 overnight stays. In August, Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.0% of the bed-places offered.

#### **Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.6% in August compared to the same month of 2020, the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) by 3.9%, and the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 3.4%.

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In August, overnight stays at Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, campgrounds, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 56.8 million. This represented an increase of 78.2% compared to the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 47.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 177.8%.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in August, 60.7% corresponded to hotels, and 39.3% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were France (with 22.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Britain (15.5%), and Germany (15.4%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 12.1 million overnight stays These are followed by Andalucía (with more than 9.3 million) and Illes Balears (with more than 7.9 million).

#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for August 2020 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS). As well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

#### Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size**: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Population scope:** tourist hostels registered as such in the corresponding registry of each Autonomous Community and the youth hostels belonging to the Spanish Network of Youth Hostels (REAJ)

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
