## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey August 2022. Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 25.6 million, compared to 22.2 million in the same month of 2021

## During the first eight months of 2022, accumulated overnight stays reached 2019 levels

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 25.6 million in August, compared to 22.2 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 15.1%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 10.3% while those by non-residents increased by 81.5%.

The average stay stood at 5.0 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2022, overnight stays increased 68.7% compared with the same period of the previous year, to stand at 2019 pre-pandemic levels. In both the case of campsites and in rural tourism establishments and hostels, the accumulated overnight stays between January and August were above 2019 levels.

#### **Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 23.1% in August. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 16.9%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 94.5%.

The average stay increased 3.3% as compared with August 2021, standing at 6.0 overnight stays per traveller.

In August, 57.3% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 15.9% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 59.7%, with an increase of 14.0%.




## Annual variation rate for overnight stay Percentage



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 56.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with more than 2.0 million. The following market was that of France, with 1.1 million.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays, and an increase of 56.5% as compared with August 2021. La comunidad autónoma con mayor ocupación es Cantabria, con el 90,5% de los apartamentos ofertados.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.4 million overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 89.2% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in August were Bernidorm, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Arona.


#### **Campgrounds**

In August, overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 9.8% as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 6.6%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 62.2%.

During August, 59.4% of the pitches offered were occupied, 3.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 62.3%, with a 2.5% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 35.3% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. France was the main country of origin, with 32.4% of overnight stays by non-residents, 71.1% more than in April of 2021.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 5.3 million overnight stays, representing a increase of 16.2% in the annual rate. País Vasco reached the highest occupancy rate, with 79.3% of campsites offered.


By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 81.3% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with more overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Calonge.

#### Rural tourism accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 1.2% in August. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 10.4%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 50.5%.

In rural tourism accommodations, 44.3% of bed-places were occupied, 3.7% less than in August 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 55.2%, with an annual decrease of 1.2%.


#### Occupancy rate



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 339,854 overnight stays, 6.0% less than in August 2021. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 71.8% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 188,056 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 82.1% of the bed-places offered.


#### Distribution of overnight stays: residents



#### Hostels


In August, there were 983,442 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 49.6%. Resident overnight stays increased by 7.5% and non-resident overnight stays by 198.3%.

A total of 40.7% of the bed-places were occupied, 40.8% more than in August 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 46.9%, with a 37.5% increase.

## Occupancy rate Percentage




Galicia was the main destination, with 275,131 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 60.6% of the bed-places offered.

#### **Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 13.0% in August compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 3.0%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 5.4%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In August, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 26.8% in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 8.5%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 86.5%.


The average stay grew by 5.5%, to 4.0 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 64.3% corresponded to hotels, and 35.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main markets of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (16.3%) and Germany (14.9%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with over 15.8 million overnight stays (30.1% more than in August 2021). It was followed by Illes Balears, with over 12.9 million overnight stays (and an increase of 64.8%) and Andalucía, with over 10.4 million, (and an annual increase of 23.7%).

#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for August 2021 of the Occupancy Surveys in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

### Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Occupancy Survey (RTAOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Population scope:** tourist hostels registered as such in the corresponding registry of each Autonomous Community and the youth hostels belonging to the Spanish Network of Youth Hostels (REAJ)

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
