## Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys

September 2009. Provisional data

### Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 9.6%\* in September, as compared with the same month in 2008

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached 8.8 million in September, 9.6% less than in the same month the previous year. This decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -3.6%), and non-residents (-13.1%). **The average stay decreased 6.8%** as compared with September 2008, and stood at 5.8 nights per traveller.

During the first nine months of the year, overnight stays decreased 9.5% with respect to the same period the previous year.




### Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 14.8% in September in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 5.6 million in September, indicating a decrease of 14.8% as compared with the same month the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -11.5%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -16.0%.

\* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section denominated "linking coefficients".

Available holiday dwellings increased 4.6%, reaching 554,740 bedplaces. **This month, 34.0%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 18.2% less than in September 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 36.6%**, with an interannual decrease of 15.6%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 48.3% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 17.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 71.9% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays, 18.7% less than in September of last year. The following market was Germany, with 812,157 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -17.2%.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than two million overnight stays, 19.4% less than in September 2008. The second destination was Illes Balears, with over 1.4 million overnight stays, 11.8% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

**Comunidad Foral de Navarra** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 62.5% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Illes Balears (61.8%) and Andalucía (53.1%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 889,001 overnight stays. Costa del Sol reached the highest occupancy rate, the 67.0% of the available holiday dwellings.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

### **Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 3.2% in September**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 3.2% decrease in September, a rate 2.4 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (59.9%), decreased 4.4% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 68.2%, decreased their prices 3.7% as compared with September 2008.

## Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 2.5%



Tourist campsites exceeded 2.4 million overnight stays in September, indicating an interannual increase of 2.5%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 4.2% in the interannual rate and non-resident overnight stays, 0.2%.

Tourist campsites offered 650,215 bedplaces, 2.5% less than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 30.8% were occupied, for a 3.0% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 33.7%, that is, 1.6% less than in September 2008.

43.2% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 25.8% of overnight stays by non-residents (8.3% less than in September 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.


**Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping**, with more than 1.2 million overnight stays, 1.2% more in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 382,321 overnight stays, and an increase of 3.8%.

Among resident travellers, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. The destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana, and Andalucía.

**La Rioja** reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in September, with 62.8% the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (45.8%) and Comunidad de Madrid (44.7%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 559,099 overnight stays. Costa del Maresme reached the highest occupancy of the available lots (54.3%). The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Blanes.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.4% in the interannual rate





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 3.4% in September. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (67.7%), presented an increase of 4.1%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 50.5% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.2%.

## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 3.4%\* in September as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 630,545 in September, representing an interannual decrease of 0.8%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 3.4%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 14.7%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 131,389 bedplaces, 9.6% more than in September 2008. 15.9% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 9.5% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 28.0%, that is, 7.9% less in the interannual rate.




**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 104,350 overnight stays, 1.7% more than in September 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 76,271 overnight stays, 0.1% more.

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination.** In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 50.5% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (26.4%) and Cantabria (26.2%).

By tourist area, the Island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 54,751 overnight stays in September and an occupancy rate of 51.0%).

## Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 0.2%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.2% in September.

The normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (55.1%), rose 1.0%. By rental modality, complete use, with a weighting of 51.1%, recorded an interannual increase of 0.3%.

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


**Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 7.4%\* interannual decrease in September. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -3.3%), and non-residents (-9.9%).

In September, the average stay decreased 1.6% and stood at 3.9 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of September, 76% corresponded to hotels, and 24% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (26.5%) and France (6.1%).

**Illes Balears** was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 8.2 million overnight stays (8.7% less than in September 2008). Next were Cataluña, with 6.8 million overnight stays (3.0% less) and Canarias, with 5.7 million overnight stays (14.9% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
