
Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased by 58.4% in September, as compared to the same month of 2019

In the accumulate for the first nine months of the year, overnight stays decreased by 56.6% in these establishments


Main results

- The number of non-hotel tourist lodgings open in September (tourist apartments, campsites, rural tourism accommodations and tourist hostels) increased compared to August, from 127,553 to 126,212. They represented 27.6% less than in September 2019.
- More than 1.3 million travellers stayed at one of these establishments. They made 5.1 million overnight stays, 58.4% less in the annual rate.
- Travellers who are residents of Spain represent 88.5% of the total in this type of accommodation (more than 1.1 million, compared to 152 thousand non-residents), and this is also reflected in overnight stays (4.1 million, compared to 1.0 million).
- Campsites, especially those in the Mediterranean area, are the most visited establishments, with more than 611 thousand travelers. Benidorm and Creixell reported the highest campsite occupation rates, at 73.0% and 60.7%, respectively.
- Almost 2 million overnight stays were made in tourist apartments, 72.5% less than in September 2019. Three out of four were residents. The areas with the highest occupancy rates were the islands of Menorca and Ibiza-Formentera, which both exceeded 30%. On weekends, the busiest apartments were those on the Costa de Almería (43.5%).
- Rural tourism accommodates more than 257 thousand people, 93% of whom are residents in Spain. The highest weekend occupancy was recorded on the Costa de Barcelona (50.8%) and on the Costa de Gipuzkoa (47.7%).
- There were 46.1 million overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations during the first nine months of 2020, 56.6% less than the same period for 2019. Of these, 28.9 million were made by residents (-35.3%) and 17.1 million by non-residents (-72.1%).




Accumulated overnight stays in non-hotel accommodation. Comparative 2019-2020


Monthly and accumulated overnights of residents in Spain. Comparative 2019-2020

Open establishments

In September, a total of 126,212 hotels were open in Spain, 27.6% less than in the same month of 2019. This represented 67.6% of the total directory of establishments for that month.


Overnight stays

Overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 5.1 million in September, with a decrease of 58.4% compared to the 12.4 million for the same month of 2019.

By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents of Spain decreased by 13.7% in the annual rate, exceeding 4.1 million. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents fell by 86.6%, to 1.0 million.

Percentage




During the first nine months of 2020, overnight stays decreased by 56.6% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 72.5% in September in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays decreased by 27.3% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 90.1%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stays



Andalucía, Canarias and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of travellers in September, with annual rates in the number of overnight stays of -63.8%, -83.3% and -66.4% respectively.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for tourist apartments, with 159,220 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 12.7% for the apartments available.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in September were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Madrid and Adeje.


Tourist Campsites

Campsites were the most visited non-hotel tourist establishments in September, with over 611 thousand travellers. Cataluña -which hosted 285 thousand travellers- represented 46.6% of the total.

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered a decrease of 36.7% in September as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 2.1%, while those by non-residents decreased by 76.9%.

In September, 30.2% of the offered parcels were occupied, 20.9% more than in the same month of 2019. The weekend occupancy rate reached 34.1%, with a 16.2% annual decrease.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 1.1 million overnight stays, representing an annual decrease of 42.6%. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 59.4% of the pitches offered.


By tourist areas, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination, with 392.529 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 33.9% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Tarragona, and Mont-Roig Del Camp.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 37.6% in September. Resident overnight stays decreased by 8.9% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 86.2%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 14.1% of the bed-places were occupied, 29.7% less than September 2019. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.5%, with a decrease of 25.6%.


By Autonomous Community, Principado de Asturias was the preferred destination, with 94,489 overnight stays, 1.6% less than in September 2019. Cantabria reached the highest occupancy rate, with 22.1% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Verde was the preferred destination, with 38,472 overnight stays. The island of Menorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 36.6% of the bed-places offered.

Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 78.6% in September. Resident overnight stays decreased by 70.4% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 89.5%.

In hostels, 9.5% of the available bed-places were occupied, 64.9% less than in September 2019. The weekend occupancy rate reached 14.7%, with a 54.3% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 14,798 overnight stays, 81.4% less than in September 2019. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 33.9% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) decreased by 11.1% in September compared to the same month of 2019 and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) decreased by 2.8%.

On the other hand, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 4.5%.


Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) decreased by 73.4% in the annual rate.

In the first nine months of the year, overnight stays in all tourist accommodations decreased by 67.0%.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for September 2019 of the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Occupancy Survey (RTAOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
