## Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys October 2009. Provisional data

### **Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 8.6%\* in October, as compared with the same month in 2008**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.9 million in October, 8.6% less than in the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents increased 13.2%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 15.8%. **The average stay decreased 12.3%** as compared with October 2008, and stood at 5.4 nights per traveller.

During the first ten months of the year, overnight stays decreased 9.4% with respect to the same period the previous year.




### **Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 16.3% in October in the interannual rate**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 4 million in October, indicating a decrease of 16.3% as compared with the same month the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -3.7%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -18.6%.

\* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section denominated "linking coefficients".

Available holiday dwellings decreased 3.3%, reaching 442,738 bedplaces. **This month, 29.7%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 13.4% less than in October 2008. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 31.7%**, with an interannual decrease of 12.0%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 43.5% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 11.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 81.9% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays, 20.9% less than in October of last year. The following market was Germany, with 750,011 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -19.2%.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, 14.3% less than in October 2008. The second destination was Illes Balears, with 572,384 overnight stays, 30.7% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

**Comunidad de Madrid** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 67.4% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by País Vasco (53.5%) and Canarias (53.0%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 820,713 overnight stays. Costa del Sol reached the highest occupancy rate, with 59.0% of the available holiday dwellings.


San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

### **Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 3.1% in October**


The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 3.1% decrease in October, a rate 0.1 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.5%), decreased 4.1% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 67.4%, decreased their prices 3.1% as compared with October 2008.



## Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 13.5%



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.2 million overnight stays in October, indicating an interannual increase of 13.5%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 33.2% in the interannual rate and non-resident overnight stays, 0.9%.

Tourist campsites offered 371,300 bedplaces, 2.3% more than in the same month of 2008. Of the available lots, 32.7% were occupied, for a 1.2% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 33.5%, that is, 4.6% less than in October 2008.

54.3% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 33.8% of overnight stays by non-residents (3.4% less than in October 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.

**Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping**, with 370,276 million overnight stays, 1.4% more in the interannual rate. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 344,893 overnight stays, and an increase of 20.7%.


Among resident travellers, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. The destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía.

**La Rioja** reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in October, with 61.8% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (48.7%) and Comunidad de Madrid (44.5%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 222,841 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 56.6%.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 2.2% in the interannual rate





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 2.2% in October. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (55.1%), presented an increase of 2.6%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 53.4% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.6%.

## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 24.0%\* in October as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 631,338 in October, representing an interannual increase of 18.1%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 24.0%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 8.4%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 130,205 bedplaces, 9.7% more than in October 2008. 15.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 7.6% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.7%, that is, 1.6% more in the interannual rate.




**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 143,200 overnight stays, 29.0% more than in October 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 71,442 overnight stays, 10.9% more.

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination**. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 31.0% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by La Rioja (24.8%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (21.2%).

By tourist area, the Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 36,713 overnight stays in October. The Island of Mallorca presented the highest occupancy rate (33.7%).

## Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 0.7%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.7% in October.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (62.3%), fell 0.7%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 62.8%, recorded an interannual increase of 0.5%.

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


**Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 3.3%\* interannual decrease in October. Overnight stays of residents increased 5.7%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 8.1%.

In October, the average stay decreased 3.9% and stood at 3.4 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of October, 79% corresponded to hotels, and 21% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (29.1%) and the Netherlands (5.0%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6 million overnight stays (10.9% less than in October 2008). Next were Illes Balears, with 4.6 million overnight stays (7.3% less) and Andalucía, with 4.1 million overnight stays (4.3% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
