**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
October 2012. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 1.5% in October, as compared with the same month of 2011**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 6.3 million in October, 1.5% less than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.6%, whilst by non-residents increased 0.1%. The average stay increased 1.9%, standing at 5.6 overnights per traveller.

In the first ten months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.4% as compared with the same period the previous year.


**Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.8% in October. Overnight stays of residents decreased 7.8%, whilst of non-residents increased 0.6%.


The average stay increased 1.3%, standing at 7.0 overnights stays per traveller.

In October, 32.8% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.6% less than in October 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 35.9%, with an annual increase of 0.1%.

**Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %**




Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 2.0% less than in October last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 716,054 overnight stays, 3.8% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with a decrease of 5.6% and Illes Balears, with 2.3% more. Comunidad de Madrid presented the highest occupancy rate with 74.2% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with 770,973 overnight stays, and an occupancy of 68.0%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual decrease of 4.5%, in October. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 4.0%, whilst non-resident travellers increased 4.8%.

31.7% of the offered lots were occupied, 3.5% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.8%, with an interannual increase of 2.3%.

60.4% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 28.5% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 7.9% less than in October 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 398,586 overnight stays, 1.1% less. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 59.8% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 215,374 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 61.0% of the lots offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mont-Roig del Camp.

## Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual decrease of 0.6%, in October. Resident overnight stays dropped 3.7%, whereas those of non-residents growth 11.1%.

13.1% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 3.6% of annual decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.3%, with an increase of 9.7%.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 124,953 overnight stays, 4.9% less than in October 2011. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 45.1% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 59,161 overnight stays and reached an occupancy rate of 47.8% of the offered bedplaces.


### Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an annual drop of 0.3% in October, rate 1.5 points lower than registered the previous month. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (52.0%), registered an increase of 0.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered an increase of 1.1%, as compared with October 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (56.2%), increased 0.8%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual decrease of 0.7% in October. The *week end* rate, which accounted for 65.3% of the total weight, decreased 0.9%.

## **Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation**

In October, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an annual decrease of 3.2%.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 10.2%, whereas non-resident stays increased 0.3%.

The average stay increased 2.0%, standing at 3.6 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of October, 79% were accounted for at hotels, and 21% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (with 29.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (27.1%) and France (5.2%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.3 million overnight stays (2.0% less than in October 2011). It was followed by Illes Balears, with more than 5.4 million overnight stays (0.8% more) and Cataluña, with more than 4.4 million overnight stays (3.9% less).
