**Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey  
November 2009. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation register an interannual increase of 8.3%\* in November as compared with the same month in 2008**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.5 million in November, 8.3% less than in the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 0.1%, while those made by travellers not resident in Spain decreased 10.7%. The average stay fell 2.6% as compared with November 2008, standing at 6.3 nights per traveller.



During the first five months of the year, overnight stays increased 11% with respect to the same period in the previous year.

**Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 10.7% in November in the interannual rate**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.3 million in November, representing a 10.7% decrease as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -4.4%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -11.6%.



\* Due to the update made in the directory of rural tourism accommodation in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated, link coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings increased 6.5%, reaching 367,767 bedplaces. **This month, 30.5%** of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 15.9% less than in November 2008. **the weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 32.0%**, with an interannual decrease of 14.1%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 49.7% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 13.3%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 85.7% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin** with 882,756 overnight stays, 12.3% fewer than in November of the previous year. The following market was Germany, with 584,880 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -13.4%.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 10.6% less than in November 2008. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 235,774 million overnight stays, 10.4% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

**Illes Balears** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 64.3% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (63.1%) and Comunidad de Madrid (55.1%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than one million overnight stays. The island of Tenerife presented the highest occupancy rate, with 67.5% of available holiday dwellings occupied.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

### **Prices for holiday dwellings increase 0.6% in November**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.6% decrease in November, a rate 2.6 points higher than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (65.7%), decreased 0.5% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 76.8%, decreased their prices 0.7% as compared with November 2008.

## Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 0.1%



Tourist campsites reached 750,232 overnight stays in November, representing an interannual decrease of 0.1%. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 8.3% in the interannual rate, and those of non-resident travellers decreased 3.7%.

Tourist campsites offered 297,396 bedplaces, 3.4% more than in the same month of 2008. 32.2% of the available lots were occupied, for an 8.5% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy level by lots reached 34.1%, that is, 8.7% lower than in November 2008.

67.4% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom is the main country of origin** with 39.9% of overnight stays by non-residents (4.7% more than in November 2008). The following country of origin was Germany.

By tourist area, Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 319,497 overnight stays, for a 0.7% decrease in the interannual rate. Andalucía was the second choice of destination, with over 152,703 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 14.1%.


The preferred destinations for resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana, whereas for non-residents these were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

**La Rioja** reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in November, with 63.3% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (47.1%) and Comunidad de Murcia (44.9%).

By **tourist areas**, Costa Blanca is the preferred destination for camping, with 212,060 overnight stays and an occupancy of 58.4%.

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.3% in the interannual rate




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 3.3% in November. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (43.2%), presented an increase of 2.0%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 52.2% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.5%.


## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 1.3%\* in November, as compared to the same month of the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 180,057 in November, indicating an interannual decrease of 1.8%. Resident overnight stays increased 1.3% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 22.2%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 126,587 bedplaces, 7.9% more than in November 2008. 10.3% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 9.0% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.3%, that is, 6.8% less in the interannual rate.



**Distribución en alojamientos de turismo rural de las pernoctaciones de los viajeros españoles en %**




**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 100,922 overnight stays, 16.1% more than in November 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with 49,966 overnight stays, 11.3% less.

**Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination.** In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Canarias reached the highest degree of occupation of rural tourism accommodation, with 19.1% of offered bedplaces. It was followed by La Rioja (18.6%) and País Vasco (16.8%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 23,395 overnight stays in November. Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupation (27.4%).

## Rural tourism accommodation prices decrease 0.4%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 0.4% in November.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (71.9%), fell 0.8%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 71.9%, recorded an interannual increase of 0.6%.

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


**Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 4.9%\* interannual decrease in November.** Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 1.2% and non-resident overnight stays dropped 7.4%.

**the average stay decreased 1.6% in November, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.** Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in November, 75% were accounted for at hotels and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (23.8%) and the Netherlands (4.5%).

**Canarias** was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.4 million overnight stays (8.3% less than in November 2008). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.4 million of overnight stays (5.3% less) and Comunitat Valenciana with more than 3.2 million overnight stays (3.2% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña. On the other hand, Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
