Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey Year 2008. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreases 2.3% in the year 2008 as compared with 2007

The overnight stays recorded in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached the figure of 107.4 million in 2008, that is, 2.3% less than in 2007. The decrease in overnight stays took place for both residents (with an interannual rate of -3.5%) and non-residents (-1.7%).

The average stay grew 0.3%, standing at 6.2 nights per traveller.

Travellers and overnight stays in collective non-hotel tourist accommodation during the year were:

In turn, during the month of **December**, 5.2 million overnight stays were registered, 7.7% less than in the same month of 2007.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 3.2% in 2008

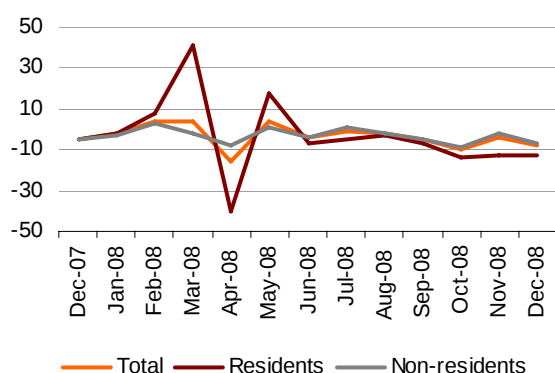
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 68.4 million in 2008, 3.2% less than in 2007. This decrease was produced among both residents (with an interannual rate of -5.0%) and non-residents (-2.7%).

Of the total overnight stays during the year, **48.7% were accounted for in the months between June and September**. 77.0% of overnight stays were made by non-resident travellers, who represented 68.7% of the total travellers.

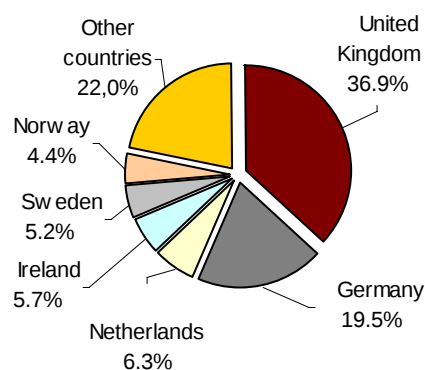
During the year 2008, positive interannual variations were registered in overnight stays in February, March and May. The rates were negative for the remaining months.

Holiday dwellings offered an average of 440,482 bedplaces throughout the year, 0.1% less than in 2007. The occupancy rate by bedplaces reached an average of 41.9%, that is, 3.6% lower than the previous year. On the other hand, an average of 57.6% of the available holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.9% less.

The British market consolidated its position as the main country of origin in holiday dwellings. Travellers from the United Kingdom made more than 19.4 million overnight stays, 5.8% less than in 2007. The following country of origin was Germany, with 10.3 million overnight stays and an interannual rate of -6.9%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 35.4 million overnight stays, 4.4% less than in 2007. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 10.4 million overnight stays, 4.2% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. On the other hand, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.

Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate, where on average, 65.1% of the available holiday dwellings were occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (64.5%) and Illes Balears (64.0%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 13.0 million overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest average occupancy rate (68.7%). The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 8.1% in the month of December

During the past month of December, more than 3.8 million overnight stays were registered, 8.1% less than the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an interannual drop of 13.2%, and those of non-residents decreased 7.2%. The average stay increased 2.8% as compared with December 2007.

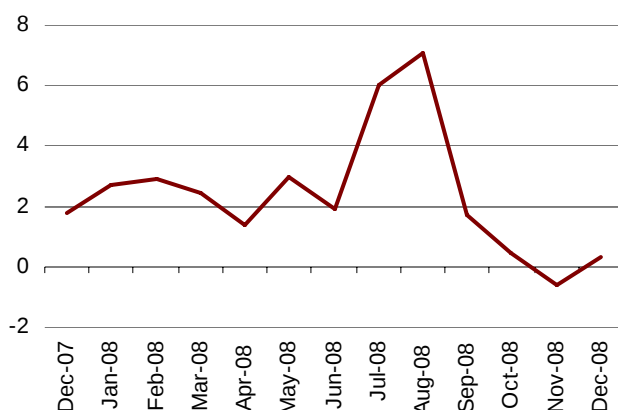
Holiday dwelling prices increase by an average of 3.3%¹

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an average increase of 3.3% during the year 2008. The tour-operator and travel agency rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for all of the months (except August), presented an average increase of 3.7%. By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weight exceeded 58% every month, increased their prices by an average of 2.9%.

In 2008, the interannual rate of the Holiday Dwelling Price Index remained between -0.6% (the only negative rate of the year, registered in the month of November) and 7.1%, which was the rate observed in August, the highest together with that recorded in July (6.0%).

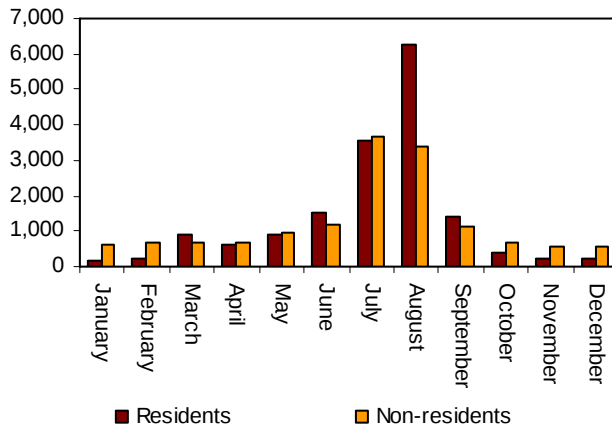
Holiday dwelling prices increased 0.3% in December, 0.9 points above the rate from the previous month.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 0.7% in 2008

Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded the figure of 31.1 million in 2008, for an interannual decrease of 0.7%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 2.4%, while those by non-resident travellers increased 1.3%. **71.0% of overnight stays were between June and September.**

Tourist campsites offered an average of 484.878 lots, 1.0% more than in 2007. An average of 38.0% of the available lots were occupied, 0.5% more. The average weekend occupancy rate by lots reached 39.9%, that is, 1.7% lower than in 2007.

Dutch, British, French and German citizens accounted for 23.5%, 21.3%, 17.6% and 16.4% of the total overnight stays by non-residents on tourist campsites in 2008, respectively. **The Dutch market, which once again was the main country of origin,** registered an increase of 6.9% in overnight stays, as compared with 2007.

Cataluña was the preferred destination in tourist campsites, with 13.9 million overnight stays, 1.5% less than in 2007. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 5.5 million overnight stays, 3.6% more.

Among non-residents, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. In turn, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

La Rioja reached the highest average occupancy rate for tourist campsites (with 63.6% of the available lots). It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (54.5%) and Comunidad de Madrid (48.0%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 6.8 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest average occupancy rate (63.0%). The **tourist sites** with the greatest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Torroella de Montgrí.

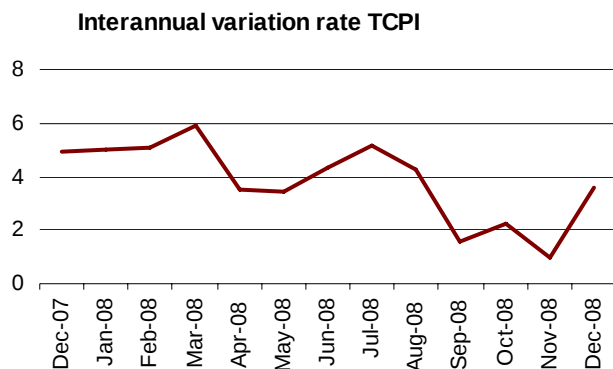
Overnight stays decrease 3.7% in the month of December

During the month of December, 782,447 overnight stays were registered, 3.7% less than for the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped 11.1% in the interannual rate, and those by non-residents decreased 0.1%. The average stay increased 5.1%, standing at 6.9 nights per traveller.

Tourist campsite prices rise by an average of 3.9% ¹ in 2008

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an average growth of 3.9% in 2008. The *normal* rate, with a weighting greater than 53% every month of the year, presented an average increase of 4.2%.

By category, the *second* one, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure every month of the year (except July), increased an average of 4.8%.



The interannual rate for the Tourist Campsite Price Index remained between 1.0% and 5.9% throughout the year. The greatest increase was recorded in March.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index presented a rise of 3.6% in December, 2.6 points above the rate from the previous month.

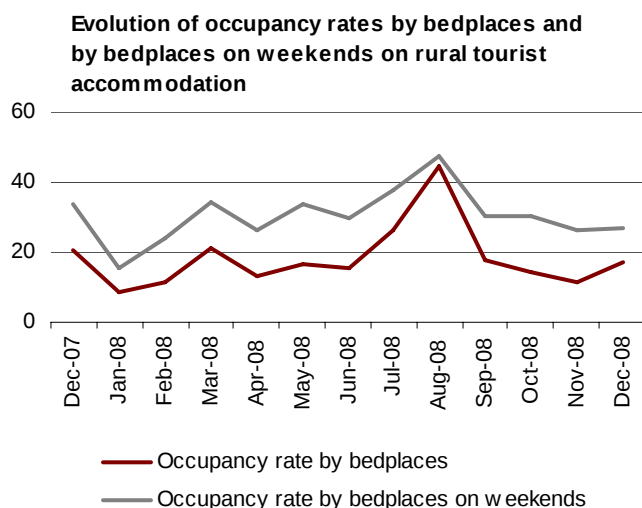
Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation decrease 3.6% in the year 2008

Overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation exceeded 7.8 million in 2008, indicating a 2.3% decrease as compared with the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped 3.6%, whereas those by non-residents rose 4.1%.

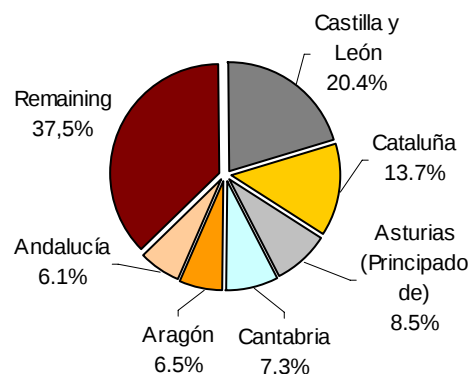
Of the total overnight stays during the year, **49.5% were accounted for in the months between June and September**. 82.6% of overnight stays were by resident travellers, who represented 90.1% of the total travellers.

Rural tourist accommodation offered an average of 114,818 bedplaces throughout the year, 9.9% more than in 2007.

The occupancy rate by bedplaces reached an average of 18.4%, that is, 11.3% less than 2007. The average weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.5%, that is, 9.4% less than that registered the previous year. The highest occupancy rates were reached during the months of March, July and August.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourist accommodation, with 1.4 million overnight stays, 4.0% less than in 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with more than one million overnight stays (5.7% more).

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

The **highest average occupancy rate in rural tourist accommodation** was registered in **Illes Balears** (with 47.4% of the available bedplaces). It was followed by País Vasco (27.7%) and Canarias (25.1%).

By **tourist area**, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination with 484,113 overnight stays. The island of Mallorca reached the highest average occupancy rate (50.9%).

Overnight stays decrease 10.6% in the month of December

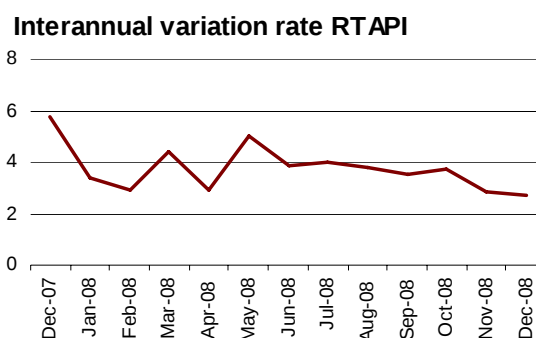
During the month of December, 609,538 overnight stays were registered, 10.6% less than for the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 11.9%, whilst those by non-residents increased 5.9%.

Rural tourist accommodation prices rise an average of 3.8% ¹

The Rural Tourist Accommodation Price Index registered an average growth of 3.8% during the year 2008. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weighting in the weight structure for every month of the year (except February and October), presented an average increase of 3.5%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting over 55% every month, increased an average of 3.7% in price.

The interannual rates of the Rural Tourist Accommodation Price Index ranged between the 2.7% reached in the month of December and the 5.0% registered in May.

Rural tourist accommodation prices increased 2.7% in December, one tenth of a percentage point lower than the rate from the previous month.



¹The average interannual variation rates of the year for the HDPI, TCPI and RTAPI have been calculated as the average of the variation rates of the HDPI, TCPI AND RTAPI, weighted by the occupied holiday dwellings, occupied lots and occupied rooms-accommodation, respectively, for each month.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

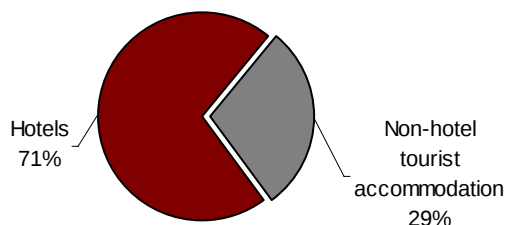
Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites and rural tourist accommodation) **registered an interannual decrease of 1.5% in 2008**. This decrease took place among both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -3.2%) and non-residents (-0.4%). **The average stay increased 0.4%** to 3.8 nights per traveller.

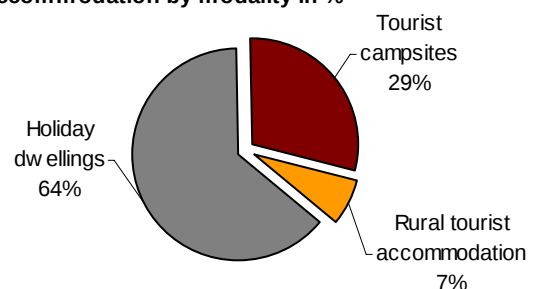

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the year 2008, 71% corresponded to hotels and 29% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 27.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 25.9%) and France (with 6.5%).

Canarias was the **preferred destination** regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 86.3 million overnight stays, 0.7% less than in 2007. It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 62.9 million overnight stays (0.7% less) and Illes Balears, with more than 60.5 million overnight stays (2.6% less).

Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the destinations preferred by non-residents. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
