Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 12.0% in January as compared with the same month in 2008



The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 2.6%

During the month of January, 11.2 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 12.0% decrease as compared with the same month in 2008. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded both for residents, whose interannual rate stood at -12.5%, and for non-residents, who presented an interannual variation of -11.6%.

Given that the interannual drop in the number of guests (-13.3%) was greater than that of overnight stays, **the average stay increased 1.5%**, as compared with 2008, standing at 3.0 nights per guest.

On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a decrease of 2.6%** in the month of January, with a rate 3.9 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of January, 34.8% of the available bedplaces were filled, 13.6% less than the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 37.5%**, with an interannual decrease of 10.9%.




Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 3.3 million overnight stays in January, accounting for 52.7% of the total for non-residents. Both markets experienced interannual decreases in overnight stays, of 13.3% for the German market and of 17.1% for the British market.

Overnight stays of guests from Italy, France and Belgium (the following countries of origin) showed interannual rates of -7.7%, -14.0% and -10.6%, respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %




Canarias is the preferred destination for non-resident guests in Spain


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, the Autonomous Community in which overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 52.7% of the national total, decreased 5.9% as compared with January 2008. The following main destinations chosen by non-resident guests were Andalucía and Cataluña, with interannual rates of -18.4% and -15.0%, respectively.

Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by resident guests, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -14.9%, -9.6% and -13.9%, respectively.

Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of January


During the month of January, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (60.5%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (39.1%) and Illes Balears (38.6%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located, as in previous months, on the islands and the coasts, plus some areas of the Pyrenees. The island of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (66.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (67.9%). The number of overnight stays in January on the island of Tenerife was almost 1.7 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Adeje. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (73.6%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate (77.2%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of -2.6% in January

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -2.6% in January, the same as the rate from the previous month, and 3.9 points below the rate registered one year ago.



Widespread decrease of prices in almost all of the Autonomous Communities

The four Autonomous Communities (Canarias, Comunidad de Madrid, Cataluña and Andalucía), which accounted for 72.2% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of January, recorded interannual decreases in their hotel prices.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (28.8%), showed an interannual rate of -1.4%, that is, 0.3 points higher than the rate estimated in December (-1.7%). In Comunidad de Madrid, hotel prices experienced a decrease of 4.5%, as compared with the -4.2% recorded the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of -5.4%, as compared with the -2.2% recorded the previous month. In Andalucía, the interannual rate was -2.3%, that is, 2.6 points more than that obtained in December (-4.9%).

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year in most of the categories

One-gold-star and one-silver-star hotel prices were the only ones that increased in January, as compared with the same month the previous year (0.2% and 1.7%, respectively)

The most important decreases were in five- and four-gold-star hotels, (with rates of -5.2% and -3.1%, respectively).

The rest of the categories also recorded negative, but more moderate, interannual rates: three- and two-silver-star (-2.4%), three-gold-star (-1.3%) and two-gold-star (-1.2%) hotels.

The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 1.5% in January

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room of -1.5% in January, 0.2 points less than the previous month and 3.5 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the heaviest weight in this indicator, Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid, presented interannual rates of 0.7%, -2.1%, -5.3% and -4.6%, respectively.

Income per occupied room decreased in all categories, except that of three-gold-star (0.4%) and one-silver-star (1.6%) hotels. The most moderate decreases were in one-gold-star (-0.2%) and three- and two-silver-star (-0.8%) establishments. Two-gold-star hotels were the following, with a drop of 2.0%, and four-gold-star (-2.5%) establishments were next. The most important decrease was reached in the five-gold-star category, with a decrease of 6.6% as compared with January 2008.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008

As of the year 2000, the INE has published the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurred in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, as of January 2008. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, as of January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
