Hotel Tourism Short Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)
March 2007. Provisional data

Overnight stays in hotel establishments increased 6.9% in March, as compared with the same month in 2006.

Hotel prices increased 1.7% in the interannual rate

During the month of March 17.5 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, representing a 6.9% increase with regards to the same month in the same month of 2006. The increase in overnight stays occurs both in residents, whose interannual rate is 5.8%, and in non-residents (with an interannual variation of 7.9%).

Since the interannual increase in **number of guests (7.5%)** exceeds that of overnight stays, the **average stay is reduced in 0.6%** with respect to March 2006, at 2.8 overnight stays per guest.

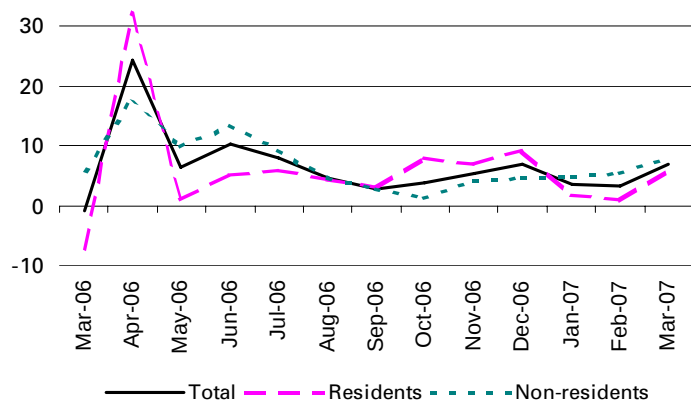
43.6 million overnight stays were registered during the first quarter of the year, 4.7% more than in the same period of the previous year. This increase is noticed in residents (3.1%) and non residents (6.2%). The **average stay** reached 2.9 overnight stays per traveller, 0.87% less than in the same quarter of 2006.

On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 1.7%** in crease in the month of March, with a 1.2 base points growth compared to the same month in 2006.

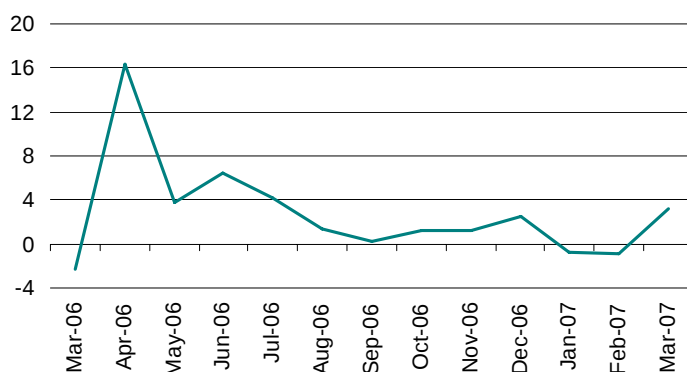
The Hotel Income Index (HII), which compared to the HPI also considers the variation in the tariff structure, reflects an interannual growth of income per occupied room of 2.8%.

During the month of March 50.4% of bedplaces offered were covered, representing a 3.1% increase with respect to the same month from the previous year. **Level of occupancy by bedplaces at weekends is 55.2%**, with an interannual increase of 0.8%.

The levels of occupancy expected for May and June increase

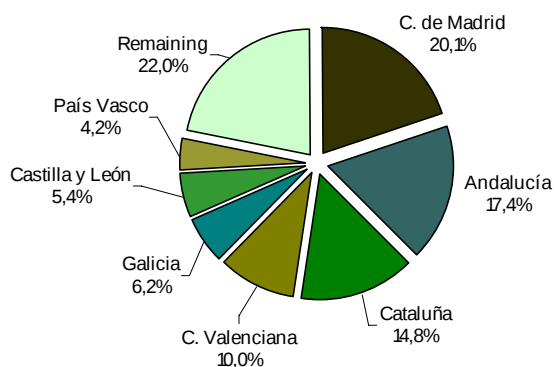
The levels of occupancy expected by room for the months of May and June register year-on-year rates of 4.2% and 6% respectively with respect to expected levels in March of the previous year for the same months.

New increase of overnight stays of German and British citizens

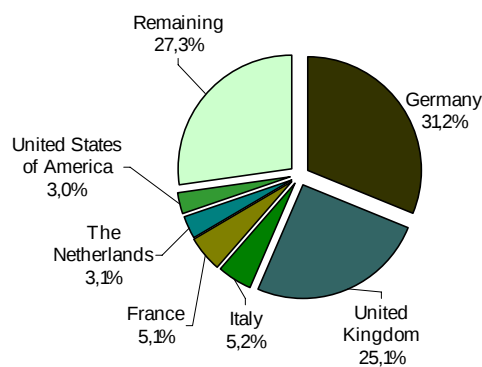
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom account for 5.3 million overnight stays in March, 56.3% of the total for non-residents. The German market experiences a 6.5% interannual growth of overnight stays, whereas the British market registers a increase 1.7%.

Overnight stays of guests from Italy, France, and Netherlands (the following markets) presented interannual rates of 13.8%, 13.5% and -1% respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %

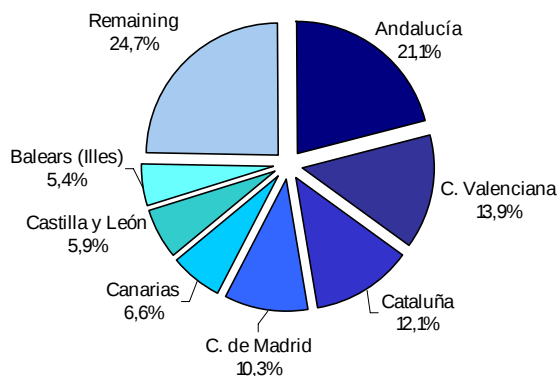


Canarias is the favourite destination of foreign guests

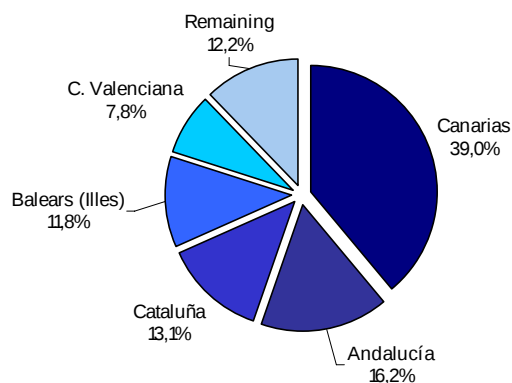
Most non-residents choose to come to Canarias. In this community, overnight stays of foreigners, representing 39% of the national total, increased 7.3% with respect to March 2006. It is followed by Andalucía, with an interannual rate of 5.7% and Cataluña, with a rate of 10.2%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña are the main destinations for Spaniards, with year-on-year rates of overnight stays of 5.9%, 14% and 8.6%, respectively.

Canarias reaches the highest degree of occupancy in the month of March

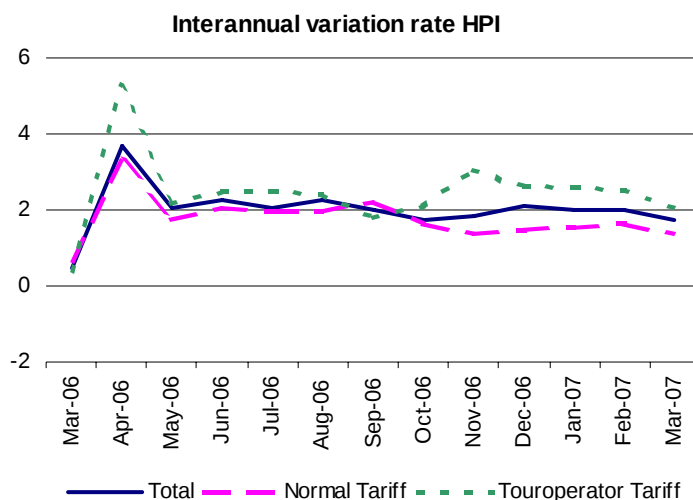
Canarias is the Autonomous Community with the highest level of occupation by bedplaces in the month of March (68.9%). It is followed by Illes Balears (61.3%) and Comunitat Valenciana (55.8%).

The **holiday areas** with the greatest levels of occupancy and overnight stays appear, as in previous months, in islands and coasts, and some area of the Pyrenees. Isla de La Gomera registered, for second consecutive month, the greatest occupancy ratio by bedplaces (76.6%). The greatest occupancy level by bedspaces on weekend (73%) was registered at Gran Canaria island, while the area registering the greatest number of overnight stays in March was the Tenerife island with 1.9 occupied bedspaces.

The **tourist sites** with the greatest number of overnight stays are Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Lloret de Mar reaches the greatest level of occupancy by bedplaces (78.9%) and Benidorm registers the greatest weekend occupancy (83.3%).

Slight slow-down of hotel prices in March

The interannual increase of the HPI is 1.7% in March, 0,3 base points below last month's rate, and 1.2 points higher than the rate recorded one year ago. The difference between interannual rates of "Tour Operator and Travel Agency" (2.1%) and "Normal" (1.4%) prices decreases with respect to the previous month.



Hotel prices increased in all autonomous communities

The four communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid) which involve 69% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of March record positive interannual rates. Canarias, weighting the most in the weighting structure this month (22%), registers an interannual rate of 0.5%, 0.8 base points lower than the previous month's rate, thus maintaining the downwards trend started in December 2006.

Madrid and Andalucía yielded 4.1% and 1% rates, 0.2 and 0.5 base points higher, respectively, than those registered in February 2007. Cataluña registered a 0.3% rate, 2.1 points lower than the one registered the previous month.

Hotel prices increased in all categories, with the exception of those for five gold stars.

Five gold star hotel prices are the only ones decreasing in March, by 1% as compared with the same month of the previous year.

The most moderate growths are registered in four and two gold stars (with 1.2% and 2.5% rates, respectively).

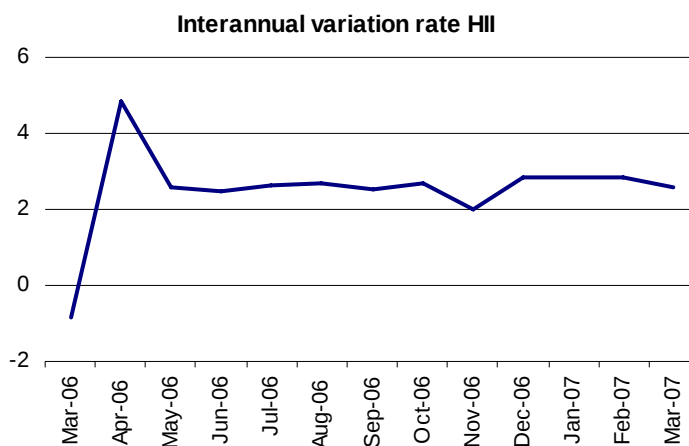
One silver star hotels are the ones increasing the most (7.4% in interannual rate), followed by one gold star hotels (by 5.5%).

The interannual rate of the HII increases 2.6% in March

HII experiences an interannual growth of 2.6% in March, 0.2 points lower than the rate of the previous month and 3.4 points higher than that recorded one year ago.

The five communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Comunidad de Madrid) representing 73% of the total weight of the income per occupied room index in the month of March record positive interannual rates (1.1%, 1.6%, 1.7%, 5.4% and 4.8%, respectively).

Income **per occupied room** increased in all categories. The most moderate growth rates were recorded in establishments with five and two gold stars, with 0.3% and 1.5% rates, respectively. The greatest interannual growth appeared in the category listing hotels with one silver star 6%.
