March 2009. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 18.9% in March,
as compared with the same month in 2008**

The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 7.3%

During the month of March, 15.6 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating an 18.9% decrease as compared with the same month in 2008. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded both for residents, whose interannual rate stood at -22.7%, and for non-residents, who presented an interannual variation of -15.1%.

The average stay increased 0.6% as compared with March 2008, standing at 2.9 nights per guest.

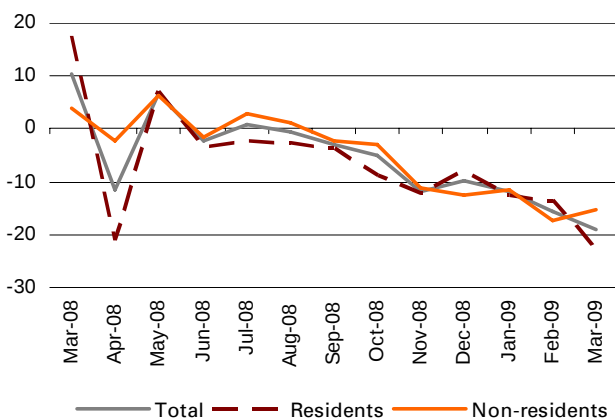
Given that Easter week was celebrated in April this year, and in 2008 it took place in March, it is convenient to wait to have the results available for the month of April, so as to analyse the two months together.

During the first quarter of 2009, overnight stays decreased 16.0% as compared with the same period the previous year.

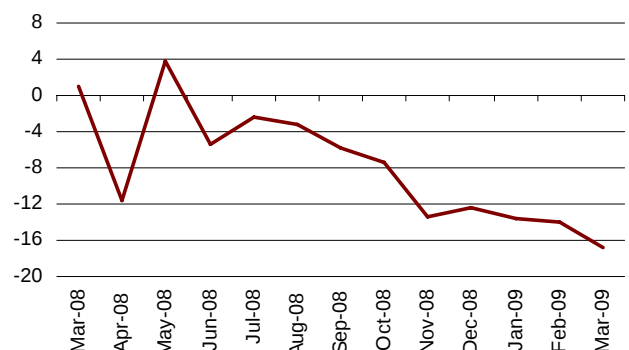
In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered a decrease of 7.3% in the month of March, with a rate 9.5 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of March, 42.2% of the available bedplaces were filled, 16.8% less than the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 48.7%, with an interannual decrease of 13.7%.

Interannual occupancy rates by bedplaces in %

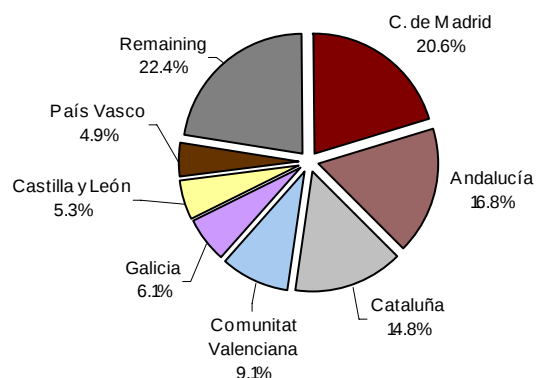


Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease

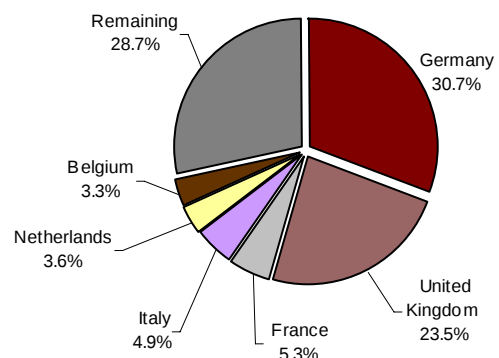
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 4.4 million overnight stays in March, accounting for 54.2% of the total for non-residents. Both markets experienced interannual decreases in overnight stays, of 14.4% for the German market and of 16.1% for the British market.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of –10.6%, -21.2% and –5.3%, respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %

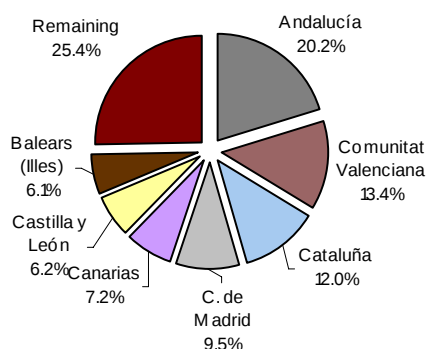


Canarias is the preferred destination for non-resident guests in Spain

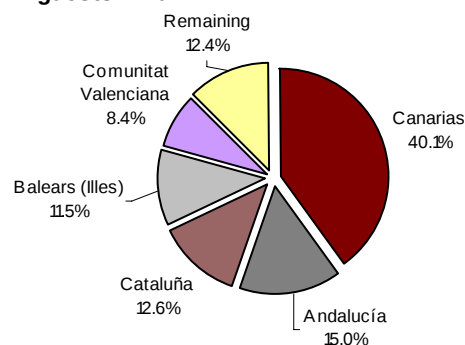
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, the Autonomous Community in which overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 40.1% of the national total, decreased 8.1% as compared with March 2008. The following destinations were Andalucía and Cataluña, with interannual rates of –21.1% and –22.9%, respectively.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of –25.6%, -18.1% and –30.1%, respectively.

Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of March

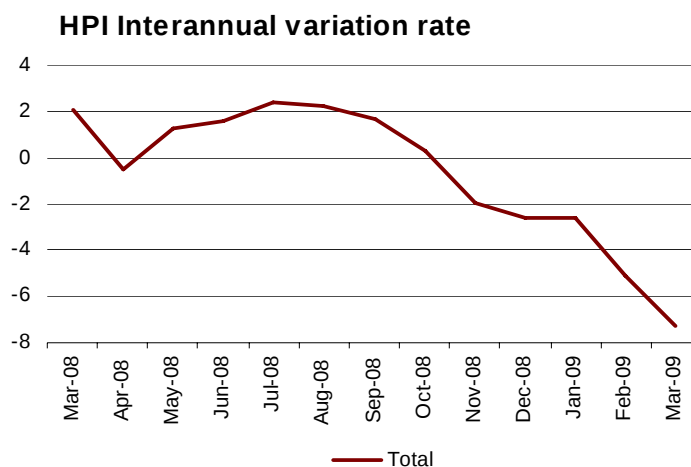
During the month of March, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (60.9%), ahead of Illes Balears (54.9%) and Comunitat Valenciana (45.3%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The island of Gran Canaria reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (67.0%), as well as the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (70.0%). The island of Tenerife registered the highest number of overnight stays in March, with more than 1.6 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (72.2%) and Granada recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (75.9%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of –7.3% in March

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –7.3% in March, a rate 2.2 points lower than that from the previous month and 9.5 points below the interannual rate registered one year ago.



Decrease in prices in all the Autonomous Communities

The four Autonomous Communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid), which accounted for 66.2% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of March, recorded interannual decreases in their hotel prices.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (21.3%), showed an interannual rate of –1.9%, that is, 1.1 points higher than the rate estimated in February. Andalucía showed an interannual rate of –10.2%, as compared with the –3.5% recorded the previous month. In turn, Cataluña showed an interannual rate of –11.8%, that is, 1.8 points lower than in the previous month. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual rate was –10.0%, that is, 1.6 points less than that obtained in February.

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year in almost all the categories

Hotel prices decreased in March, as compared with the same month the previous year, in all categories, except that of one-silver-star establishments, which increased 0.8%.

The most important decreases were in five- and four-gold-star hotels, with rates of -13.6% and -7.3%, respectively.

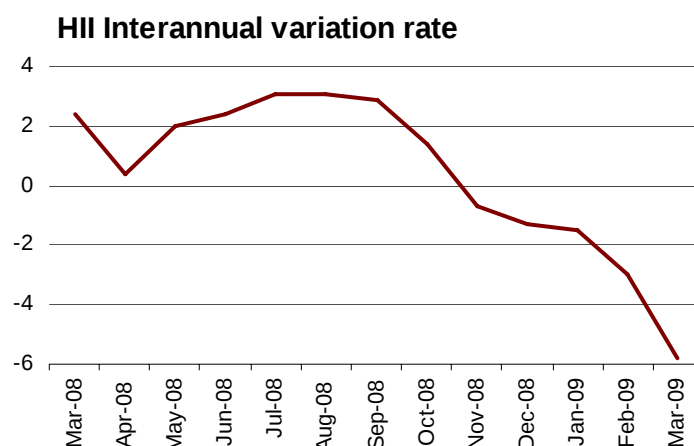
The rest of the categories recorded more moderate negative interannual rates: three-gold-star (-6.4%), one-gold-star (-4.9%), two-gold-star (-4.2%) and three- and two-silver-star (-3.0%).

The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 5.8% in March

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room of -5.8% in March, 2.8 points less than the previous month and 8.3 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator, Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana, presented interannual rates of 0.0%, -9.0%, -10.3% and -9.5%, respectively.

Income per occupied room decreased in all categories, except that of one-silver-star (0.6%) hotels. The most moderate decreases were in three- and two-silver-star (-2.2%) and one-gold-star (-4.0%) establishments. They were followed by three-gold-star hotels, with a drop of 4.8%, two-gold-star hotels (-5.6%), and four-gold-star (-6.9%) establishments. The most important decrease was reached in the five-gold-star category, with a drop of 14.4% as compared with March 2008.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
