April 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 2.0% in April, as compared with the same month in 2008

The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 3.9%

During the month of April, 19.7 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 2.0% increase as compared with the same month in 2008. This increase was due in part to the Easter Week effect, a holiday which this year was celebrated in April, whereas in 2008 it took place in March. An increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents, whose interannual rate stood at 12.0%, while the rate for non-residents presented an interannual variation of -5.9%.

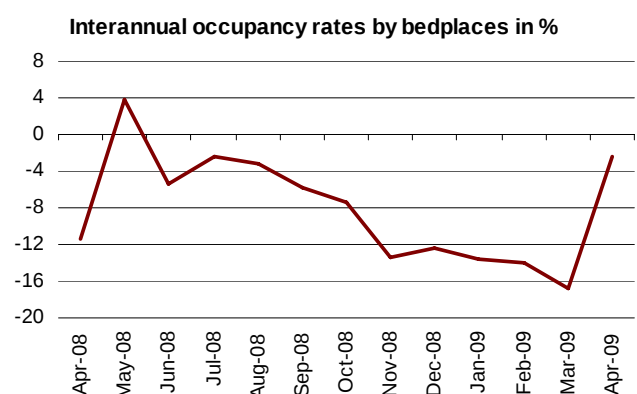
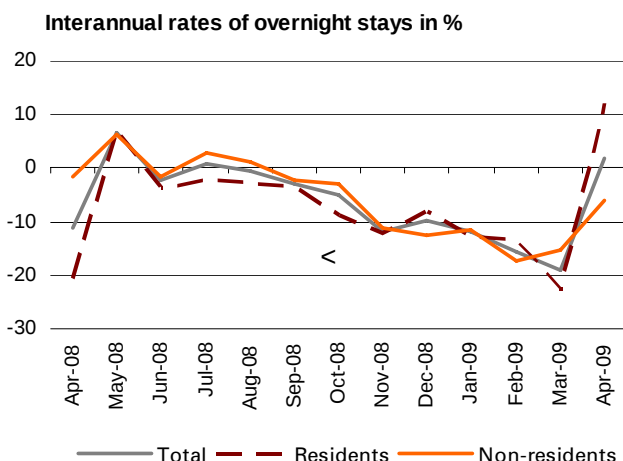
On analysis of the **March-April** aggregate period, an 8.4% decrease in overnight stays was recorded, as compared with the same period in 2008. Overnight stays by residents decreased 6.4%, whilst those by non-residents decreased 10.3%.

During the **first quarter of 2009**, overnight stays decreased 10.7% as compared with the same period the previous year. In the case of residents, the rate was -9.2%, and for residents, it was -12.1%.

In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered a decrease of 3.9% in the month of April, with a rate 3.4 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of April, 48.1% of the available bedplaces were filled, 1.2 points less than the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 53.5%**, with a decrease of 0.2 points.

During the March-April period, 45.3% of the available bedplaces were filled, 4.7 points less than in the same period of 2008. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 51.3%, that is, 3.8 points less than the rate reached the previous year.



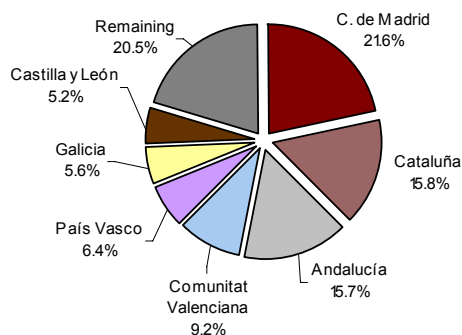
Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease

Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 5.3 million overnight stays in April, accounting for 52.0% of the total for non-residents. Both markets experienced decreases in overnight stays as compared with April 2008, of 7.9% and 9.7% respectively.

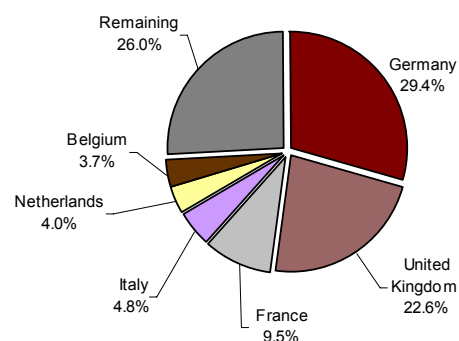
Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of -2.1%, -7.0% and -5.6%, respectively.

During the aggregate period of March and April 2009, these five countries also constituted the main countries of origin, and in the same order as in April, with interannual rates of -11.0%, -12.7%, -4.9%, -13.9% and -5.5%, respectively.

Canarias is the preferred destination for foreign guests

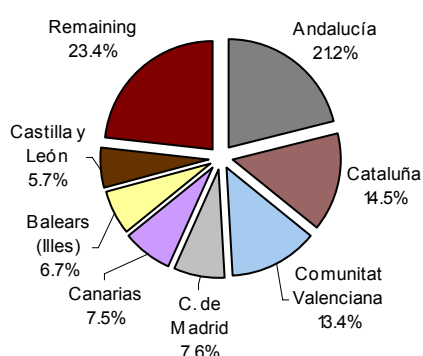
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, the Autonomous Community in which overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 28.7% of the national total, decreased 8.0% as compared with April 2008. The following destinations were Illes Balears (with a positive interannual rate of 9.4%) and Cataluña (with an increase of 2.9%).

For the whole of March and April, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest number of overnight stays of non-residents, ahead of Cataluña and Illes Balears. The interannual rates of overnight stays for these Communities were -8.1%, -8.0% and -3.4%.

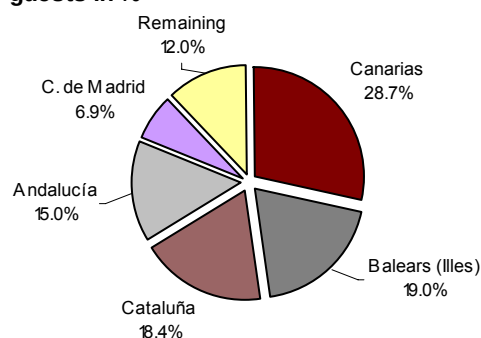
Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations chosen by Spaniards, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 20.0%, 22.5% and 22.4%, respectively.

In the aggregate period of March and April, these Communities maintained the same order of preference for resident guests, and the interannual variation rates of the respective overnight stays were -4.8%, -5.5% and 0.6%.

Illes Balears reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of April

During the month of April, Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (60.2%), ahead of Canarias (59.9%) and Cataluña (51.1%).

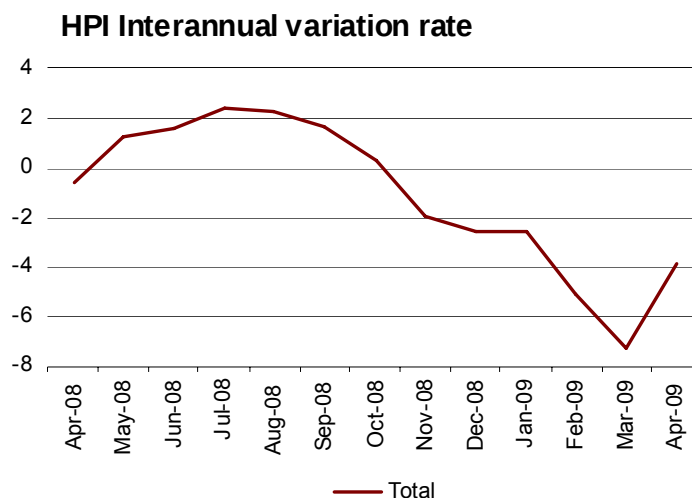
On analysing **March and April together**, Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (60.4%), followed by Illes Balears (58.3%) and Comunitat Valenciana (48.2%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The coast of Barcelona reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (65.8%), as well as the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (73.1%). The island of Mallorca registered the highest number of overnight stays in April, with almost 2.4 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and Benidorm. In addition, Benidorm had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (71.1%) and Granada recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (81.4%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of –3.9% in April

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –3.9% in April, a rate 3.4 points higher than that from the previous month and 3.4 points lower than that registered in the same month of 2008.



Hotel prices decrease in most of the Autonomous Communities

The four Autonomous Communities (Andalucía, Canarias, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid), which accounted for 66.0% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of April, performed differently than in April 2008.

Andalucía, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (18.0%), showed an interannual rate of –3.3%, that is, 6.9 points higher than the rate estimated in March. Hotel prices experienced an increase of 3.0% in Canarias, as compared with the drop of 1.9% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of –8.8%, that is, 3.0 points higher than in the previous month. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual rate was –10.3%, that is, 0.3 points lower than that obtained in March.

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year in the higher categories

Hotel prices presented negative interannual rates in April in the categories of five-gold-star (-8.3%), four-gold-star (-3.8%), three-gold-star (-3.5%) and two-gold-star (-3.9%) hotels.

In one-gold-star hotels, prices remained unchanged as compared with the same month of 2008.

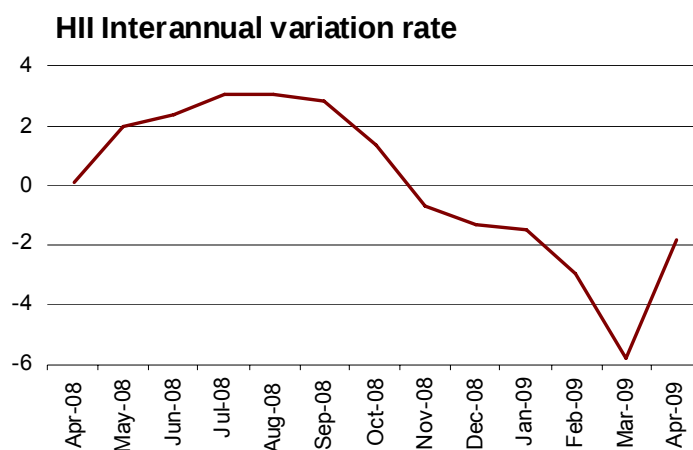
The only categories that presented positive rates were three- and two-silver star establishments (0.9%), and one-silver-star establishments (0.8%).

The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 1.9% in April

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room, of -1.9% in April, 3.9 points higher than the previous month, and 2.0 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator, Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Illes Balears, presented interannual rates of 3.4%, -0.9%, -5.5% and -2.9%, respectively.

Income per occupied room decreased as compared with April 2008 in the categories of three-gold-star (-1.7%), four-gold-star (-2.2%), two-gold-star (-2.6%) and five-gold-star (-8.3%) hotels. Conversely, income increased 1.2% in the one-gold-star category, 1.5% in the three- and two-silver-star categories, and 2.2% in the one-silver-star category.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index

Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
