# Overnight stays in hotel lodgings exceed 4.0 million in April 2021

# During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays decreased by 70.6% as compared to the same period of the previous year.

# Hotels invoiced an average of 70.1 euros per occupied room

In April 2020, hotels remained closed to all tourist activities. As such, no travellers arrived during that month, and there were no overnight stays. Since no income was received from tourist activities, both the average daily rate (ADR) and the income per available room (RevPAR) were zero.

It is thus impossible to calculate variation rates for April 2021 in relation to the same month of the previous year for data related to the hotel occupancy survey and for the hotel sector profitability indicators.

For hotel prices, rates are published compared to April 2020, since prices remained invariant in that month.

## **Overnight stays**

Overnight stays in hotel lodgings exceed 4.0 million in April 2021.


On the basis of origin, overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain, which represent 68.9% of the total, rose to 2.7 million. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents reached 1.2 million.

During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays decreased by 70.6% as compared to the same period of the previous year.


On the other hand, the average stay stood at 2.1 nights per traveller.



#### Destinations

The Canarias, Cataluña and the Comunidad de Madrid were the main destinations for the overall number of travellers in Spain in April, with, respectively, 15.2%, 14.8% and 13.9% of total overnight stays.

#### Distribution of overnight stays

The main destinations for travellers residing in Spain are Cataluña, the Comunidad de Madrid and Andalucia, which account for 14.7%, 14.6% and 14.2% of overnight stays, respectively.


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, with 30.8% of total overnight stays. It was followed by Cataluña and Illes Balears.

#### Hotel occupancy


In April, 20.9% of available bed-places were occupied, while the degree of weekend bed-place occupancy stood at 25.4%.

Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate by bed-places in April (31.2%). It was followed by Canarias, with 26.2%.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca reached both the highest level of occupancy by bedplaces (33.2%), and the greatest weekend occupancy rate (40.9%). Tenerife had the highest number of overnight stays, with 238,047.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Lleida had the highest occupancy rate by bed-places (37.7%), while San Pedro del Pinatar reached the highest weekend occupancy rate (69.6%).

#### Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

Press Release

Travellers from the Germany and France accounted for 22.3% and 13.4%, respectively, of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments in April. This was followed by overnight stays by travellers from Italy, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.





#### **Hotel Prices**

The annual rate of the Hotel Prices Index (HPI) stood at -20.5% in April, which is 20.5 points below that registered in the same month of 2020 and 12.4 of a point more than that registered last month.

By categories, the largest price decrease was recorded in establishments with three gold stars (-25.7%). And the lowest, in those with five gold stars (-9.6%).

#### **Hotel Sector Profitability**


The average daily invoicing rate for each occupied room (ADR - Average Daily Rate) was 70.1 euros in April. On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 19.1 euros.

By category, the average rate was 182.4 euros for five-star hotels, 74.2 euros for four-star hotels and 54.9 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories were 52.7, 22.3 and 15.5 euros, respectively.

The tourist spot<sup>1</sup> with the highest ADR is Naut Aran, with an average daily billing per occupied room of 308.1 euros. The tourist spot with the highest RevPAR was Marbella, with an income per available room of 85.3 euros.



#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to April 2020 in the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS), the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IPHS).

# Methodological note

The main objective of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of the hotel sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand, thus meeting the needs of national institutions and the requirements of international organisations for knowledge regarding the sector.

The Hotel Price Index (HPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of prices applied to clients by hotel entrepreneurs.

The main objective of the Indicators of Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IRSH) is to facilitate decision-making in the hotel sector. These are the *Average Daily Rate* (ADR), which collects the average daily income per occupied room; and the *Revenue per Available Room* (RevPAR), which collects the average daily revenue per available room.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: all hotel establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample design:** stratified sampling by province and establishment category, with 4 and 5 gold star categories being exhaustive.

Sample size: approximately 9,250 establishments in winter and 11,200 in summer.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the hotel establishment.
