Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)
May 2009. Provisional data

**Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 8.9% in May,
as compared with the same month in 2008**

The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 5.3%

During the month of May, 22.8 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating an 8.9% increase as compared with the same month in 2008. A decrease in overnight stays was recorded for residents, whose interannual rate stood at -6.8%, while the rate for non-residents presented an interannual variation of -10.2%.

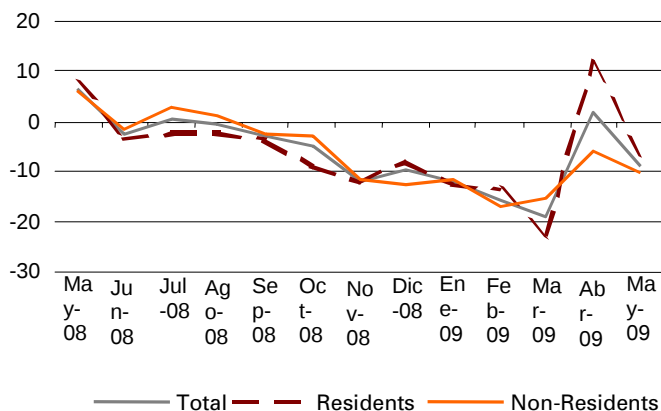
The average stay decreased 0.7% as compared with May 2008, standing at 3.1 nights per guest.

During the first five months of the year, overnight stays decreased 10.2% as compared with the same period the previous year.

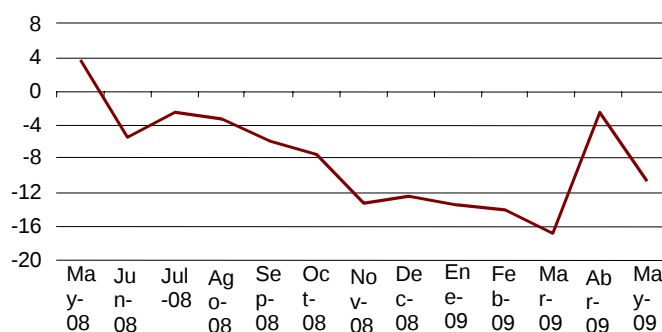
In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered a **decrease of 5.3%** in the month of May, with a rate 6.5 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of May, 47.4% of the available bedplaces were filled, 5.5 points less than the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 55.4%**, with an interannual decrease of 4.5 points.

Interannual rates of overnight stays in %

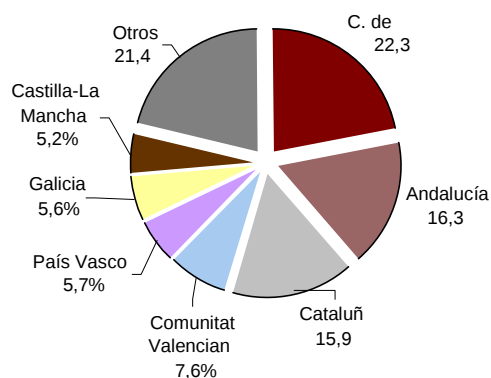


Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease

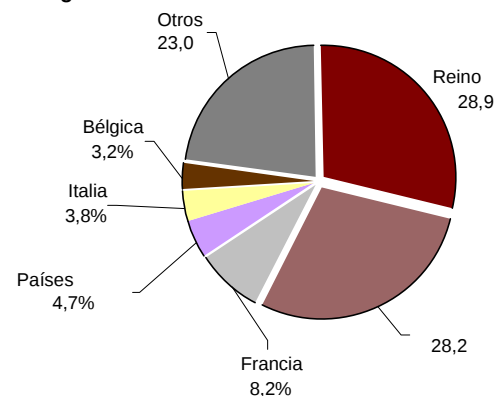
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 8.0 million overnight stays in May, accounting for 57.1% of the total for non-residents. The British market experienced a 9.8% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the German market experienced a 16.0% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, the Netherlands and Italy (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of -0.3%, -8.9% and -7.3%, respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %

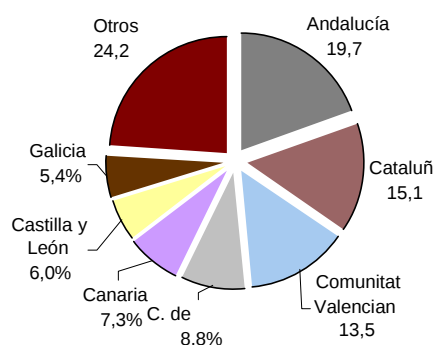


Illes Balears is the preferred destination for foreign guests

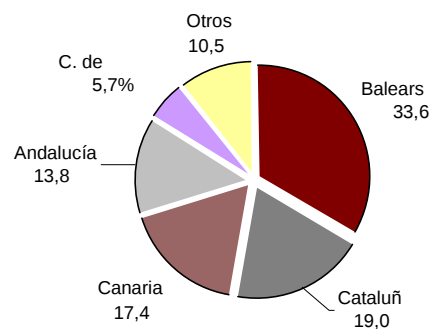
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 33.6% of the national total, decreased 7.3% as compared with May 2008. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of -7.3% and Canarias, with a rate of -13.5%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations chosen by Spaniards, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -11.2%, 10.9% and 1.4%, respectively.

Illes Balears reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of May

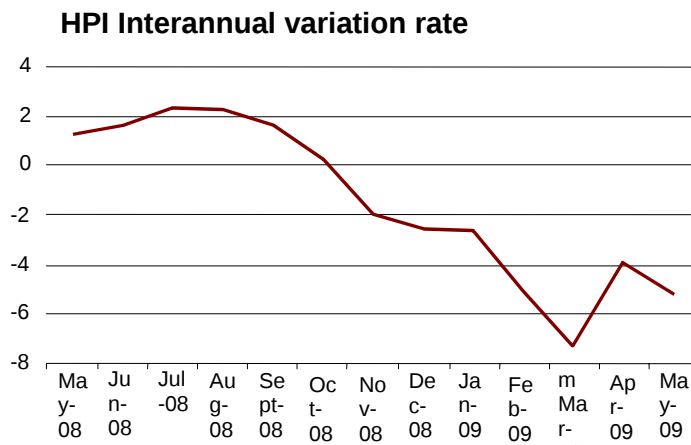
During the month of May, Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (56.4%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (51.9%) and Canarias (51.4%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The coast of Barcelona reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (65.4%), whereas the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was shown by the Guipuzcoa coast (77.1%). The island of Mallorca registered 4.2 million overnight stays.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and Calviá. Muro had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (70.8%) and Córdoba recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (85.1%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of –5.3% in May

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –5.3% in May, 6.5 points lower than that registered in the same month of 2008.



Decrease in prices in all Autonomous Communities

Cataluña, Andalucía, Illes Balears, Canarias y Comunidad de Madrid, which were the most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI (they carried 76.6% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of May), registering negative interannual rates.

Cataluña, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (17.9%), showed an interannual rate of –9.1%, that is, 0.3 points lower than the rate estimated in April. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 3.7% in Andalucía, as compared with the -3.3% registered the previous month. Illes Balears showed an interannual rate of –2.4%, as compared with -2.1 points the previous month. In Canarias, the interannual rate was –0.5%, that is, 2.5 points lower than that obtained in April.

The interannual variation rate in Comunidad de Madrid was -12.2% , 1.9 points lower than the previous month.

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year almost all categories

The price of one-silver-star hotels was the only one to increase in May (0.1% as compared with the same month the previous year).

The most significant decreases were registered in five- and four-gold-star hotels (with 10.5% and 5.4%), respectively.

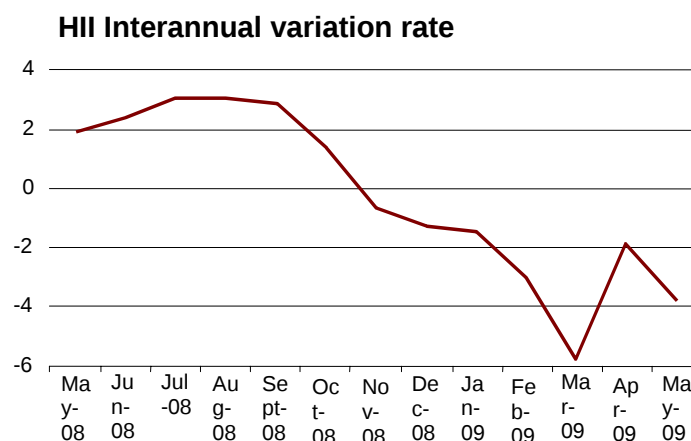
Other categories also showed negative interannual rates: three gold stars (-4.5%), two gold stars (-4.2%), three and two silver stars (-1.1%) and one gold star (-0.8%).

The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 3.8% in April

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room, of -3.8% in May, 1.9 points lower than the previous month, and 5.7 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator: Illes Balears, Andalucía, Cataluña and Canarias presented interannual rates of -2.2% , -3.2% , -5.9% and -0.9% , respectively.

Income per occupied room decreased in all categories, except in three and two silver stars (0.7%) and in one gold star (0.2%). The most moderate decreases were in one-silver-star establishments (-0.1%). Three-gold-star hotels registered a rate of -3.0% , two-gold-star ones registered -3.6% , and four-gold-star ones registered -4.8% . The most significant decrease was found in the five gold star category, with an 11.0% decrease as compared with May 2008.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
