June 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 6.4%* in June, as compared with the same month in 2008

The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 6.5%

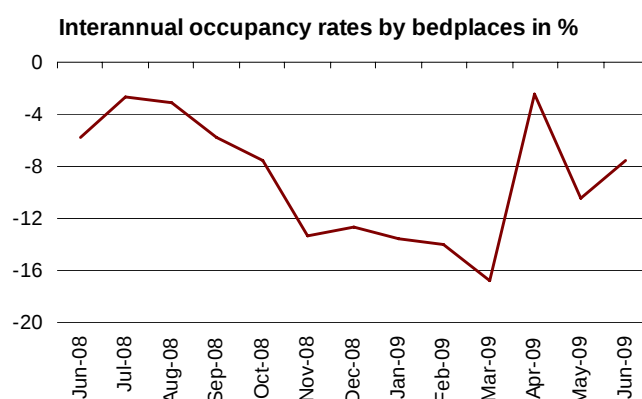
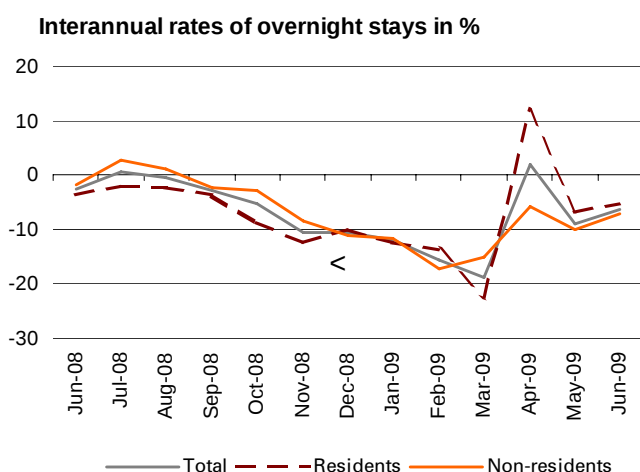
During the month of June, 26.1 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 6.4% increase as compared with the same month in 2008. A decrease in overnight stays was recorded for residents, whose interannual rate stood at -5.2%, while the rate for non-residents presented an interannual variation of -7.1%.

The average stay increased 0.9% as compared with June 2008, standing at 3.4 nights per guest.

During the first semester of the year, overnight stays decreased 9.3% as compared with the same period the previous year.

In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a decrease of 6.5%** in the month of June, with a rate 8.2 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of June, 53.1% of the available bedplaces were filled, indicating a decrease of 7.5% as compared with the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 59.6%**, with an interannual decrease of 6.4%.



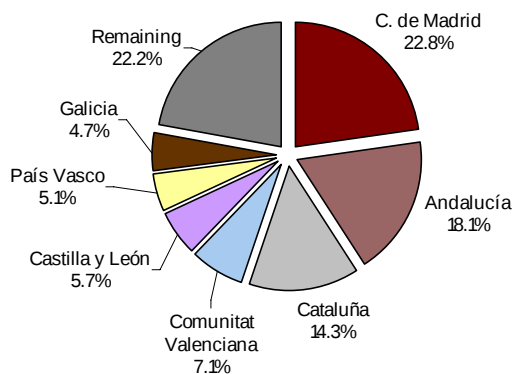
* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with that published the previous year. In order to avoid this break in the series, link coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published each month on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease

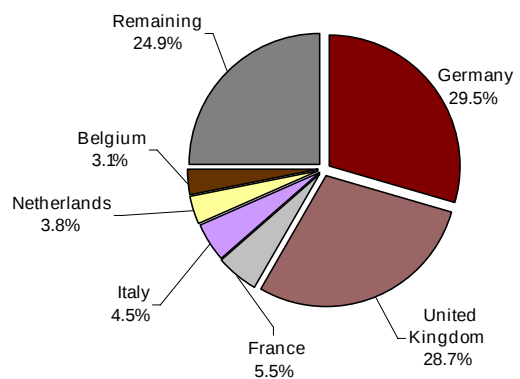
Guests from United Kingdom and Germany the made 9.4 million overnight stays in June, accounting for 58.2% of the total for non-residents. The German market experienced a 4.5% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced an 11.0% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of -4.2% , -17.8% and -15.7% , respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %

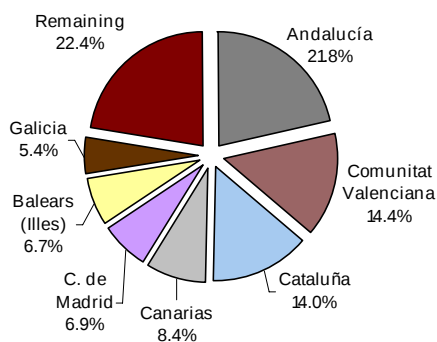


Illes Balears is the preferred destination for foreign guests

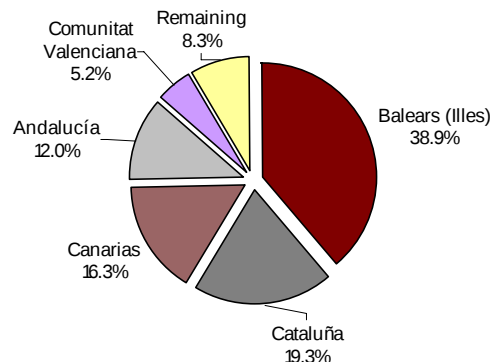
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 38.9% of the national total, decreased 2.9% as compared with June 2008. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of -9.1% and Canarias, with a rate of -13.6% .

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by Spaniards, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -0.1% , 1.2% and 6.3% , respectively.

Illes Balears reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of June

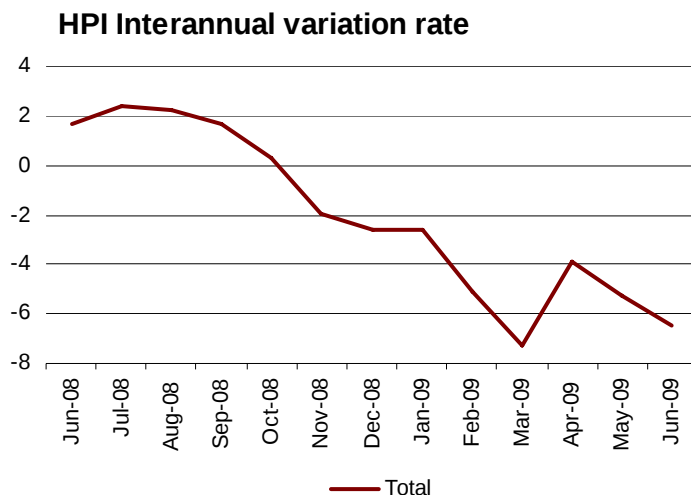
During the month of June, Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (71.7%), ahead of Comunitat Valenciana (56.2%) and Canarias (56.1%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The island of Mallorca reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (75.8%), and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (77.8%). This is also the area with the highest number of overnight stays (5.4 million).

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Calviá and Barcelona. Muro had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (83.4%) and Torremolinos recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (88.3%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of –6.5% in June

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –6.5% in June, 8.2 points lower than that registered in the same month of 2008.



Decrease in prices in all Autonomous Communities

Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía, Canarias y Comunidad de Madrid, which were the most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI (they carried 77.8% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of June), registering negative interannual rates.

Illes Balears, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (22.0%), showed an interannual rate of –5.0%, that is, 2.6 points lower than the rate estimated in May. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 9.3% in Cataluña, as compared with the –9.1% registered the previous month. Andalucía showed an interannual rate of –4.5%, as compared with –3.7 points the previous month. In Canarias, the interannual rate was –1.1%, that is, 0.6 points lower than that obtained in May. The interannual variation rate in Comunidad de Madrid was –13.2%, 1.0 point lower than the previous month.

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year almost all categories

The price of one-gold-star hotels was the only one to increase in June (0.2% as compared with the same month the previous year).

The most significant decreases were registered in five-gold-star hotels with a rate of -12.4%. It was followed by four- and three-gold-star hotels, -6.8% and 6.2%, respectively.

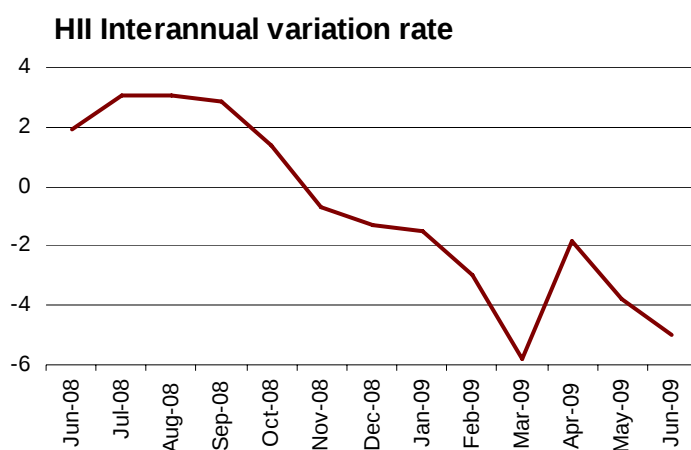
Other categories also showed negative interannual rates: two gold stars (-2.3%), one silver star (-2.3%), three and two silver stars (-0.2%).

The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 5.8% in June

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room, of -5.0% in June, 1.2 points lower than the previous month, and 6.9 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator: Illes Balears, Catalunya, Andalucía and Canarias presented interannual rates of -4.3%, -6.5%, -4.1% and -2.0%, respectively.

Income per occupied room decreased in all categories, except in three and two silver stars (2.1%) and in one gold star (0.7%). The most moderate decreases were in two-gold-star establishments (-1.7%). One silver star hotels registered a rate of -3.3%, three-gold-star ones registered -5.5%, and four-gold-star ones registered -5.8%. The most significant decrease was found in the five gold star category, with a 12.9% decrease as compared with June 2008.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
