

**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)**  
June 2011. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 10.9%\* in June, as compared with the same month in 2010**

**Hotels earn 41.3 euros per available room and invoice an average of 66.4 euros per occupied room**



During the month of June, 30.6 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 10.9% increase, as compared with the same month in 2010. Overnight stays by residents decreased 0.7%, while non-resident stays increased 18.1%.

The average stay increased 2.3%, as compared with June 2010, standing at 3.5 nights per guest.

During the first half of the year, overnight stays increased 6.9%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

In turn, **the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 0.1% decrease**, this rate being 0.7 points higher than that registered in June 2010. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, invoicing per occupied room reached an average value of 66.4 euros (0.4 euros more than one year ago), and income per available room stood at 41.3 euros (3.0 euros more than in June 2010).

58.9% of the available bedplaces were filled in June, indicating an 8.5% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 65.6%, with an increase of 6.7%.




\* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, Comunidad Foral de Navarra and Extremadura, the data published for those Communities and the national total cannot be directly compared. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

## Overnight stays of guests resident abroad


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made more than 10.9 million overnight stays in June. The German market experienced an interannual increase of 20.0%, while the British market grew 8.3%.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy, and Russia (the following countries of origin) presented interannual rates of 26.3%, 24.0% and 72.8% respectively.

### Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %




## Main destinations


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals grew 19.1%. It was followed by Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 23.3%, and Canarias, with an increase of 16.4%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 0.9%, -1.1% and 2.9%, respectively.

## **Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site**


Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces during the month of June (82.0%). It was followed by Canarias (64.3%) and Cataluña (63.0%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. Mallorca recorded the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (83.9%), while Costa Guipuzcoana recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (85.0%). Mallorca registered more than 6.2 million overnight stays in June.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Barcelona, Madrid and Calviá. Santanyí reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (94.4%), while Santa Margalida reached the highest weekend occupancy rate (91.8%).

## **Evolution of the Hotel Price Index**

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -0.1% in June, this rate being 0.3 points higher than that obtained last month, and 0.7 points higher than that registered one year ago.



## **HPI by Autonomous Community**

The four Autonomous Communities (Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias) that carried 68.6% of the total weight of the HPI in the month of June, showed uneven behaviour as compared with May 2011.

Illes Balears, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, presented an interannual rate of 0.9%, that is, 1.8 points higher than that estimated in May. Hotel prices recorded a variation of 2.0% in Cataluña, as compared with the 1.6% recorded the previous month. Andalucía showed an interannual rate of -2.8%, as compared with the -0.1% observed last month. In Canarias, the variation was 1.9%, indicating 0.4 points more than in May.

## HPI by category

Hotel prices decreased in June in three-gold-star hotels (1.5%), in three- and two-silver-star hotels (1.3%), in two-gold-star (0.3%), and in four-gold-star hotels (0.2%).

In contrast, prices increased in five-gold-star hotels (3.8%), one-gold-star hotels (3.1%) and one-silver-star hotels (1.1%).


## Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average invoicing by hotels per occupied room (ADR) in June was 66.4 euros, indicating an increase of 0.4 euros as compared with the same month in 2010.


In turn, income per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy registered in the hotel establishments, reached 41.3 euros, with an increase of 3.0 euros as compared with June 2010.

By category, the average invoicing was 148.2 euros for five-star hotels, 75.0 euros for four-star hotels and 53.9 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories was 91.5, 53.1 and 37.4 euros, respectively.
