**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)**  
**August 2009. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 5.0%\* in August, as compared with the same month in 2008**

**The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 4.6%**

During the month of August, 36.2 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 5.0% decrease as compared with the same month in 2008. A 2.2% increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented a decrease of 10.6%.



**The average stay decreased 0.1% as compared with August 2008, standing at 3.8 nights per guest.**

**During the period comprising July and August,** overnight stays decreased 5.2% with regard to the same period in 2008. Resident overnight stays increased 1.1%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 9.8%

During the first eight months of the year, overnight stays decreased 7.8% as compared with the same period the previous year.

In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a decrease of 4.6%** in the month of August, with a rate 6.8 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

**During the month of August, 67.7% of the available bedplaces were filled**, indicating a decrease of 5.9% as compared with the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 70.1%,** with an interannual decrease of 2.7%.




\* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with that published the previous year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published each month on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

## Overnight stays of British and German citizens decrease


Guests from the United Kingdom and Germany made 9.5 million overnight stays in August, accounting for 49.9% of the total for non-residents. The British market experienced a 10.4% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the German market experienced a 14.2% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 1.0%, -15.2% and 12.5%, respectively.

**Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %**




## Illes Balears is the preferred destination for non-resident guests


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 39.0% of the national total, decreased 10.0% as compared with August 2008. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of -5.8%, and Canarias, with a rate of -17.7%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 2.4%, 10.9% and 7.7%, respectively.

## Illes Balears reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of August


During the month of August, Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (82.0%), ahead of Cataluña (74.6%) and Canarias (73.8%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. Costa de la Luz, in Huelva, reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (87.3%), whereas the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was recorded on the Guipuzcoa coast (89.5%). The island of Mallorca registered the highest number of overnight stays in August, with 6.4 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Calviá, Barcelona and Benidorm. In turn, Santa Margalida had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (95.4%), whereas Santa Susana recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (93.1%).

## Hotel prices register an interannual rate of -4.6% in August

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -4.6% in August, 6.8 points lower than that registered the same month the previous year



## Uneven performance of prices in the Autonomous Communities

Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía, Canarias and Comunitat Valenciana were the most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI in August, with a combined weight of 80.4% of the index. All of them registered negative interannual rates.

Illes Balears, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (23.9%), showed an interannual rate of -3.3%, that is, 1.0 points lower than the rate estimated in July (-2.3%). Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 4.7% in Cataluña, as compared with the -8.8% registered the previous month. Andalucía showed an interannual rate of -2.9%, as compared with -5.9% the previous month. In Canarias, the interannual rate was -2.9%, that is, 0.8 points lower than that obtained in July. The interannual variation rate in Comunitat Valenciana was -5.9%, 0.3 points lower than the previous month.

## Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year in all of the categories

The most important decreases were recorded in five-gold-star hotels, with a rate of -9.1%, and in one-silver-star hotels, with a rate of -7.4%. They were followed by four- and three-gold-star hotels, both with -4.6%.

The remaining categories also showed negative interannual rates: one-gold-star (-2.1%), two-gold-star (-1.6%) and three- and two-silver-star (-0.7%) establishments.

## The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 4.2% in August

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure by type of client and distribution channel, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room, of -4.2% in August, 0.4 points higher than the previous month, and 6.9 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator: Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias, presented interannual rates of -2.7%, -4.4%, -4.1% and -3.9%, respectively.

**Income per occupied room** decreased in all categories, except two-gold-star (0.4%) hotels. The most moderate decreases were recorded in three- and two-silver-star (-0.1%) and one-gold-star (-2.9%) establishments. Three-gold-star hotels registered a rate of -4.4%, four-gold-star hotels registered -5.3%, and one-silver-star hotels registered -6.2%. The most significant decrease was found in the five-gold-star category, with a 7.6% decrease as compared with August 2008.



## **Methodological note 2009**

### **Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008**

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
