Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)
September 2009. Provisional data

Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 6.6%* in September, as compared with the same month in 2008

The internal rate of hotel prices decreases 6.8%

During the month of September, 27.5 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 6.6% decrease as compared with the same month in 2008. A 3.2% decrease in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented a decrease of 8.8%.

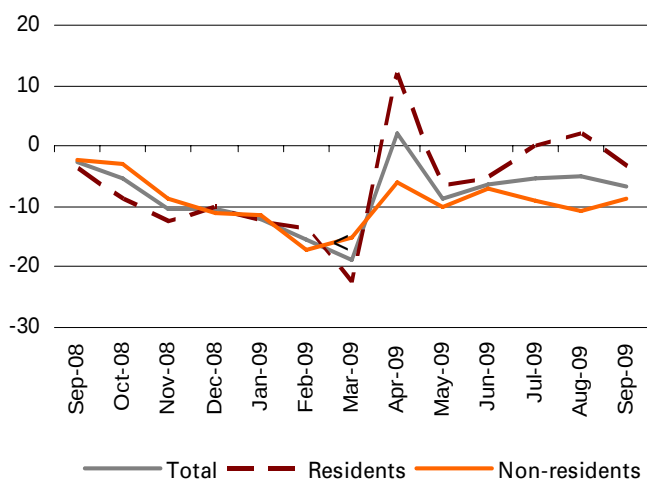
The average stay decreased 0.3% as compared with September 2008, standing at 3.5 nights per guest.

During the first nine months of the year, overnight stays decreased 7.6% as compared with the same period the previous year.

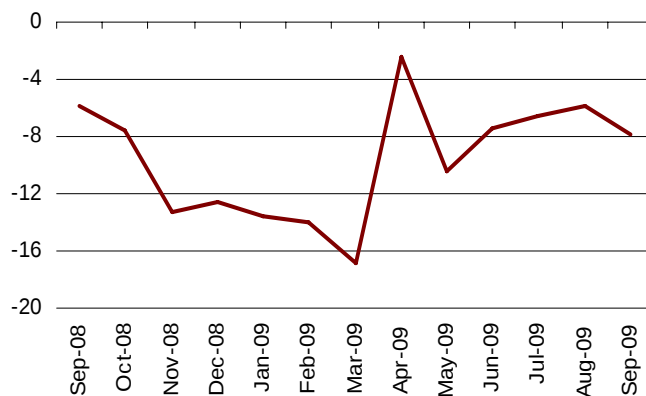
On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered a decrease of 6.8% in the month of September, with a rate 8.4 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

During the month of September, 55.6% of the available bedplaces were filled, indicating a decrease of 7.8% as compared with the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 61.8%**, with an internal decrease of 4.7%.

Interannual occupancy rates by bedplaces in %



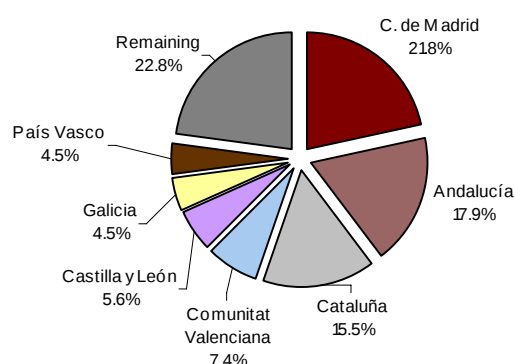
* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated, link coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

Overnight stays of British and German citizens decrease

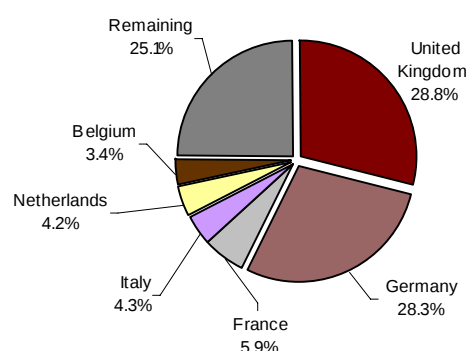
Guests from the United Kingdom and Germany made 9.5 million overnight stays in September, accounting for 57.1% of the total for non-residents. The British market experienced an 8.9% internal decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the German market experienced an 11.7% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered internal rates of -4.3%, -19.7% and -0.4%, respectively.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %

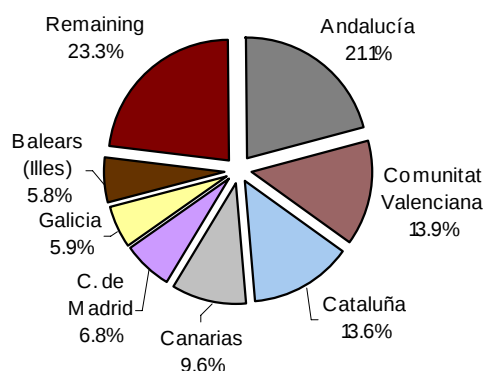


Illes Balears is the preferred destination

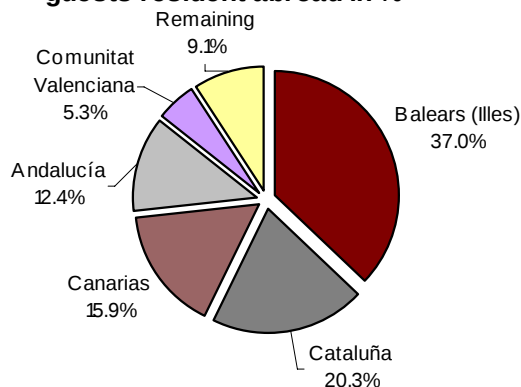
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 37.0% of the national total, decreased 8.1% as compared with September 2008. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an internal rate of -5.9%, and Canarias, with a rate of -12.5%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with internal rates for overnight stays of -5.9%, 0.6% and 7.3%, respectively.

Illes Balears reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of September

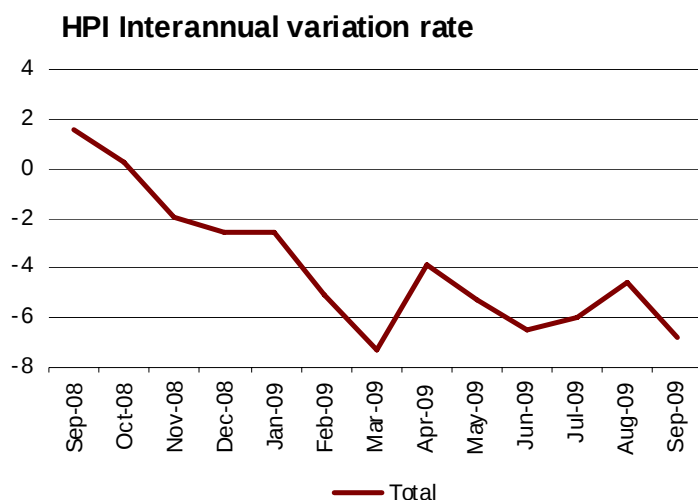
During the month of September, Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (69.3%), ahead of Canarias (60.7%) and Cataluña (58.5%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The Island of Mallorca reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (71.7%) and is also the tourist area that registered the highest number of overnight stays in September, with more than 5.1 million. The highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was recorded on the Guipuzcoa coast (79.5%).

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and Calvin. In turn, Satiny had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (93.9%), and the highest weekend occupancy rate (89.8%).

Hotel prices register an internal rate of –6.8%

The internal decrease of the HPI stood at –6.8% in September, 8.4 points lower than that registered the same month the previous year.



Decrease in prices in the Autonomous Communities

Illes Balears, Andalucía, Cataluña and Canarias were the most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI in September, with a combined weight of 68.2% of the index. All of them registered negative internal rates in September.

Illes Balears, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (21.7%), showed an internal rate of –5.7%, that is, 2.4 points lower than the rate estimated in August. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 5.5% in Andalucía, as compared with the –2.9% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an internal rate of –6.1%, as compared with –4.7% the previous month. In Canarias, the internal rate was –5.8%, that is, 2.9 points lower than that obtained in the previous month. The internal variation rate in Comunitat Valenciana was –5.9%, 2.9 points lower than the previous month.

Hotel prices decrease as compared with the previous year in all of the categories

The most important decreases in September were recorded in five-gold-star hotels (-13.0%), and in four-gold-star hotels (-7.3%). They were followed by three-gold-star hotels (-5.7%), and one-silver-star hotels (-5.4%).

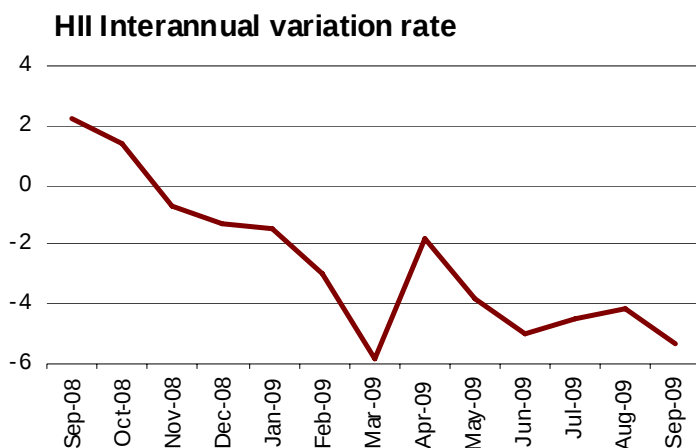
The remaining categories also showed negative internal rates: two-gold-star (-3.6%), three- and two-silver-star (-1.7%) and one-gold-star (-0.7%) establishments.

The internal rate of the HII decreases 5.4% in September

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure, reflected an internal rate of income received per occupied room, of -5.4% in September, 1.2 points less than the previous month, and 8.2 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator: Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias, presented negative internal rates (of -4.7%, -4.5%, -5.2% and -5.2%, respectively).

Income per occupied room decreased in all categories. The most moderate decreases were recorded in one-gold-star (-0.6%) and two-gold-star (-1.6%) establishments. Three- and two-silver-star hotels registered a rate of -2.3%, three-gold-star and one-silver-star hotels registered a -4.3% variation rate, and four-gold-star hotels registered -7.2%. The most significant decrease was found in the five-gold-star category, with 11.9% decrease as compared with September 2008.



Methodological note 2009

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index

Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**

Available on the INE website, http://www.ine.es/en/welcome_en.htm, are the HPI and HII series in base 2008, since January 2001 and January 2003, respectively, as well as the old series in base 2001 until December 2008.
