**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)**  
**November 2007. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 7.7% in November, as compared with the same month of 2006**

**The interannual rate of hotel prices increases 1.8%**

During the month of November, 15.4 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, indicating an increase of 7.7% with regard to the same month in 2006. Overnight stays of residents increased 8.7%, while those corresponding to non-residents increased 6.7%.

**The average stay decreased 0.6%** as compared with November 2006, standing at 2.8 nights per guest.


**Over the first 11 months of the year, 259.4 million overnight stays were registered, that is, 2.2% more than the same period in 2006**, with increases of 2.0% for residents and 2.3% for non-residents. The **average stay** stood at 3.2 nights per guest, for a total of 1.4% less than the same period in 2006.

On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered an increase of 1.8% in the month of November, a rate one tenth higher than that recorded the same month in 2006.


The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the tariff structure, reflected a 2.4% interannual growth in income per occupied room.

**During the month of November, 48.3% of the available bedplaces were filled**, which implies an increase of 4.5% with respect to the same month in 2006. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 56.2%**, with an interannual increase of 6.0%.

## The occupancy rates expected for January and February increase


The occupancy rates by room expected for the months of January and February registered interannual rates of 1.6% and 2.7%, respectively, as compared to the rates expected in November of last year for the same months.

## Overnight stays of British and German citizens increase


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom registered 4.2 million overnight stays in November, accounting for 54.1% of the total for non-residents. The German market experienced an interannual increase of 4.5% in its overnight stays, and the British market experienced an increase of 0.3%.

The overnight stays of French, Italian and Swedish guests (the following markets) presented interannual rates of 10.9%, 7.5% and 26.9%.

**Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %**




## Illes Balears is the preferred destination of foreign travellers


Most non-residents chose to come to Canarias. Within this Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals, which represented 44.7% of the national total, increased 7.8% in comparison with November 2006. It was followed by Andalucía and Cataluña, which presented a positive variation of 4.0% and 5.1%, respectively, as compared with November 2006..

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Comunidad de Madrid were the main destinations for Spaniards, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 9.8%, 5.2% and 2.8%, respectively.

## Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of November


Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces during the month of November (69.6%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (55.3%) and Illes Balears (53.9%).

The highest occupancy rate by bedplaces was observed on the island of Gran Canaria, where 75.7% of the available bedplaces were occupied during the month of November, percentage which increased to 76.5% at the weekends. The island of Tenerife was the area that registered the greatest number of overnight stays in November, with 1.8 million occupied bedplaces.

**The tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona, Benidorm and Adeje. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (81.1%) and Benidorm had the highest weekend occupancy rate (82.6%).

## Hotel prices increase 1.8% in November

The interannual increase of the HPI stood at 1.8% in November, which was 0.1 points above the rate from the previous month and above the rate recorded one year ago. The difference between the interannual rates of *Tour Operator and Travel Agency Tariff* (1.4%) and *Normal Tariff* (1.9%) decreased with respect to the previous month.



## Hotel prices increase in all Autonomous Communities

The Communities with the greatest Hotel Price Index weightings in November were Canarias, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunidad de Madrid, representing 69.8% of the total weight of the indicator. Canarias, which carried the largest load in the weight structure this month (23.7%), showed an interannual rate of 0.8%, that is, 0.2 points higher than the rate registered one month prior, in October.

Cataluña yielded a rate of 0.9%, that is, 0.2 points lower than the rate registered in October 2007. Andalucía experienced a price increase of 1.5%, 0.4 points higher than the previous month. Comunidad de Madrid reached a rate of 3.2%, 0.2 points higher than the rate registered the previous month.

## One -gold-star and three- and two-silver-star hotels raise their prices the most

The prices of five-gold-star hotels decreased 0.8% in November, as compared with the same month of last year, while four-gold-star hotels increased 1.8%.

Three-gold-star hotels registered an interannual rate of 2.3%.


Hotels with one gold star increased the most (an interannual rate of 4.7%), followed by hotels with three and two silver stars (3.8%).

## The HII experiences an increase of 2.4% in the interannual rate in November

The Hotel Income Index (HII) showed an interannual increase of 2.4% in November, 0.4 points higher than the rate registered in October and 0.5 points higher than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid) that accounted for 63.7% of the total weight of the income index per occupied room in the month of November, registered positive interannual rates (1.9%, 0.9%, 3.3% and 4%, respectively).

Income **per occupied room** increased in all categories. The most moderate growth was recorded in five-gold-star and four-gold-star establishments, with rates of 0.2% and 2.0%, respectively. The highest interannual increase was found in the one-gold-star category (5.8%).
