

Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS)
November 2021. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in hotel establishments reached 14.8 million,
compared to 2.8 in the same month of 2020**

**Hotels invoice an average of 88.3 euros per occupied room,
representing an annual increase of 38.0%**

During the month of November, overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 14.8 million. This represents an increase of 417.0% compared to the same month in 2020, when there were only 2.8 million.

Based on place of origin, overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain exceeded 6.0 million, representing 40.7% of the total. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents stood at over 8.8 million.


If data is compared with November 2019, overnight stays in hotel establishments showed a decrease of 19.0%. By origin, overnight stays by travellers who are residents in Spain decreased 16.0%, and those by non-residents decreased 20.9%.

On the other hand, the average stay increased 14.1% compared to November 2020, standing at 2.8 overnight stays per traveller.

In the first 11 months of 2021, overnight hotel stays rose by 78.7% as compared with the same period of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 71.3% and those of foreigners by 87.7%.


Overnight stays. Comparison 2019-2020-2021

Open establishments

In November, a total of 11,798 hotels were open in Spain, 43.4% more than in the same month of 2020. This represented 72.7% of the total directory of establishments in this month.



Destinations

Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña were the main destinations for total travellers in Spain in November, with 33.6%, 14.7% and 12.3% of total overnight stays, respectively.

The main destinations for travellers residing in Spain were Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña.


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, with 51.1% of total overnight stays. It was followed by Cataluña and Andalucía.

Hotel occupancy

In November, 45.3% of the available bedplaces were occupied, indicating an annual increase of 188.1%. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces increased 247.5%, and stood at 54.8%.

Occupancy rate


Percentage



Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces in November (67.6%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid, with 49.6%.

By tourist areas, the island of La Gomera reached both the highest level of occupancy by bed-places (76.9%), and the greatest weekend occupancy rate (80.1%). The island of Tenerife registered the highest number of overnight stays in November, with 1,810,974 million.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Adeje showed the highest occupancy rate by bed-places (73.5%) and Las Palmas de Gran Canaria the highest weekend occupancy rate (74.7%).


Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

Travellers from the Germany and the United Kingdom accounted for 20.7% and 19.9%, respectively, of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments in November.

Overnight stays by travellers from the France, the Netherlands, and the Belgium (the following source markets) accounted for 9.0%, 4.9% and 4.6% of the total, respectively.

Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Prices Index (HPI) stood at 24.0% in November, which is 41.2 points above that registered in the same month of 2020 and 3.7 of a point more than that registered last month.

Hotel Sector Profitability

The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 88.3 euros in November, representing an increase of 38.0% as compared with the same month of 2020.


On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is determined by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 48.3 Euros, increasing by 251.2%.

By category, the average rate was 192.5 euros for five-star hotels, 93.1 euros for four-star hotels and 66.6 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories were 119.6, 57.4 and 37.1 euros, respectively.


The tourist site¹ with the highest ADR and RevPAR was Adeje, with an average daily turnover per occupied room of 150.6 euros and income per available room of 125.0 euros.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to the month of November 2020 of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and of the Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IPHS).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of the hotel sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand, thus meeting the needs of national institutions and the requirements of international organisations for knowledge regarding the sector.

The Hotel Price Index (HPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of prices applied to clients by hotel entrepreneurs.

The main objective of the Indicators of Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IRSH) is to facilitate decision-making in the hotel sector. These are the *Average Daily Rate* (ADR), which collects the average daily income per occupied room; and the *Revenue per Available Room* (RevPAR), which collects the average daily revenue per available room.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: all hotel establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample design: stratified sampling by province and establishment category, with 4 and 5 gold star categories being exhaustive.

Sample size: approximately 9,250 establishments in winter and 11,200 in summer.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the hotel establishment.
