

Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS)

November 2023. Provisional data

Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 7.9% in November compared to the same month in 2022

Hotels invoice an average of 104.9 euros per occupied room, 9.9% more than the same month of the previous year

During the month of November, overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 19.0 million. This represents an increase of 7.9% compared to the same month in 2022, when there were 17.7 million. Moreover, they are more than those of the same month in 2019.


Based on place of origin, overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain exceeded 6.9 million, which represents 36.3% of the total. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents stood at over 12.1 million.

On the other hand, the average stay decreased 0.4% compared to November 2022, standing at 2.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of 2023, overnight stays increased by 8.4% compared to the same period of the previous year. Moreover, they surpass those of the first 11 months of 2019.

Percentage




Destination

In November, Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña were the main destinations for travellers who are residents in Spain, with 18.5%, 14.7% and 11.5% of total overnight stays, respectively.

Distribution of overnight stays: residents



The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, with 45.1% of the total number of overnight stays. Following that, the main destinations were Cataluña Andalucía, with 15.6% and 13.7% of the total, respectively.

Percentage




Hotel occupancy

In November, 52.5% of the available bed places were occupied, with an annual increase of 5.1%. The weekend occupancy rate by bed places increased by 3.8% to 61.0%.

Occupancy rate


Percentage



Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate by bed places during November (75.2%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid, with 59.2%.

By tourist areas, Sur de Tenerife registered the highest occupancy rate by bed places (78.7%). La Isla de Tenerife registered the highest weekend occupancy rate (80.3%) and the largest number of overnight stays in November, with 2,226,163.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Adeje had the highest occupancy rate by bed places (81.1%), while Puerto de la Cruz had the greatest weekend occupancy rate (83.5%).


Overnight stays according to the country of origin of travellers

Travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany accounted for 22.7% and 16.8%, respectively, of total overnight stays by non-residents in hotel establishments in November.

Overnight stays by travellers from France, the United States and Italy (the following source markets) accounted for 6.1%, 5.2% and 4.5% of the total, respectively.




Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Prices Index (HPI) stood at 8.6% in November, which was 0.3 points below that recorded in the same month in 2022 and 0.9 points less than that recorded last month.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest increase of hotel prices compared to November 2022 was in Comunitat Valenciana (11.4%). And the smallest was recorded in Extremadura, with a rate of 1.0%.

By categories, the greatest price increase occurred in the three-star gold establishments (11.8%).

Hotel Sector Profitability

The average daily hotel turnover per occupied room (ADR) was 104.9 euros in November, an increase of 9.9% compared to the same month in 2022.


On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is determined by the occupancy rate registered in hotel establishments, reached 67.1 euros, increasing by 15.1%.

By category, the average rate was 228.6 euros for five-star hotels, 109.6 euros for four-star hotels and 82.6 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories was 151.5, 80.2 and 54.2 euros, respectively.


The tourist spot with the highest ADR is Marbella, with an average daily rate per occupied room of 173.9 euros. Adeje has the highest RevPar, with a revenue per available room of 152.8 euros.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to the month of November 2022 of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and of the Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IPHS).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of the hotel sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand, thus meeting the needs of national institutions and the requirements of international organisations for knowledge regarding the sector.

The Hotel Price Index (HPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of prices applied to clients by hotel entrepreneurs.

The main objective of the Indicators of Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IRSH) is to facilitate decision-making in the hotel sector. These are the *Average Daily Rate* (ADR), which collects the average daily income per occupied room; and the *Revenue per Available Room* (RevPAR), which collects the average daily revenue per available room.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: all hotel establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: one month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample design: stratified sampling by province and establishment category, with 4 and 5-gold star categories being exhaustive.

Sample size: approximately 9,250 establishments in winter and 11,200 in summer.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the hotel establishment.
