Questionnaire

Constitution, characteristics and purpose

The Survey on Equipment and Use of Information and Communication Technologies in Homes (ICT_H 2024) is a statistical investigation carried out by the National Institute of Statistic (INE), following the recommendation of the Statistic Office of the European Union (EUROSTAT).

This research is aimed at households in order to obtain comparative data on the availability of equipment to communicate and obtain or send information, as well as on the use that household members make of said technologies.

Legislation

Statistic Secret

Personal data obtained by statistical services, both directly from informants and through administrative sources, will be protected and will be protected by statistical secrecy (art. 13.1 of the Law of Public Statistical Function of May 9, 1989, (LFEP)). All statistical personnel will have the obligation to preserve statistical secrecy (art. 17.1 of LFEP).

Obligation to provide data

Laws 4/1990 and 13/1996 establish an obligation to provide the data requested for the preparation of this Statistics.

Statistical services may request data from all natural and legal persons, national and foreign persons, residents in Spain (art. 10.1 of LFEP).

All natural and legal persons that provide data must answer truthfully, accurately, completely and within the deadlines to the questions ordered in due form by the statistical services (art. 10.2 of LFEP). To ensure compliance with these regulations, the LFEP (art. 48) grants the INE sanctioning capacity

Very serious infringements will be sanctioned with fines of **3.005,07 a 30.050,61 euros**. Serious infringements will be sanctioned with fines of **300,52 a 3.005,06 euros**. Minor infringements will be sanctioned with fines of **60,10 a 300,51 euros** (art. 51.1, 51.2 y 51.3 of LFEP).

I.- HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION

Application. In dwellings of the first interview or dwellings of successive interviews in which there is NO information available on any member of the household, H1a will be formulated. For dwellings in successive interviews in which there IS information on persons in the previous interview, H1b will be formulated.

H1a. Tell me the first and last names of all persons currently living in this household. Do not forget to include children or persons temporarily absent.

H1b. Are the people living in this dwelling...?

Interviewer, read only the names.

Application. During questions H1, H2 and H3:

Each person's data will be recorded in three text boxes, one for the first name and the others for the two last names.

- The application presents activated buttons:
 - "Add persons" by means of the text boxes.
 - o "Delete person" by means of a cross.
 - o "Continue" to confirm all persons and move on to the next screen.

H2. Tell me if there are any other person who currently have NO PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE and are now in this dwelling, even temporarily.

Interviewer: if there is any person, it should be added below.

H3. Indicate informant person.

Interviewer: select the household questionnaire respondent from the table below. If the informant is not a member of the household, select the option "other person".

Application: In this and subsequent questions, all persons included in the previous question (the table of household members up to this point) will be presented. In this question H3, a new response option "Other person" is included. Only one response will be allowed.

Application: Next, question H9 relating to the Type of household (TIP_H) is incorporated. The situation will be treated according to the number of existing household members (i.e., those for whom NO has been answered in questions H4 and H5).

H10. SELECTION OF THE PERSON TO BE SURVEYED

Application: Once H10 is marked, the Household Questionnaire is completed and Block I ends. At this point, the application proceeds to sort the surveyable persons by age and selects one of them (the person to be surveyed) according to the programmed Kish Table, displaying the identity of the person on the screen.

Interviewer, read to the informant 'The person randomly selected to answer the individual questionnaire is:'

As may be:

A) If the person selected matches the person you are interviewing, go ahead.

B) If it is not the person you are interviewing, inform him/her of this. Ask who of the two of you knows best the blocks on equipment and Internet in the household and on children's use of computers and Internet. If it is the respondent, complete these blocks with him/her. If he/she is the selected person and is not present, ask for the right time to ask him/her the questions, and before ending the interview, do not forget to ask for a contact telephone number.
