ICT Sector Indicators

Provisional results. Year 2007

Companies in the ICT Sector experience an increase of 6.6% in turnover in 2007

Internal expenditure on R&D by companies in the ICT Sector grows 12.7% as compared with 2006

Turnover for companies in the Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) sector exceeded 103,702 million euros in the year 2007, with an increase of 6.6% as compared with 2006.

The ICT services sector registered turnover greater than 90,185 million euros, with an interannual increase of 6.1%. Within this sector, of note were IT activity companies, whose invoicing increased 14.3% to reach 24,163 million euros.

In turn, the manufacturing sector registered an interannual increase of 10.2% in turnover, invoicing more than 13,517 million euros.

Employment in the ICT sector increases 5.0%

Companies in the ICT sector employed 415,489 persons in 2007, indicating an increase of 5.0% as compared with the previous year.

In the services sector, employed personnel reached 364,200 persons, 5.1% more than in 2006. Within this sector, IT activity companies exhibited the greatest increase in employment, with 8.0%. On the other hand, in the Telecommunications branch, the number of employed persons decreased 2.0%.

Employed personnel in the manufacturing sector was 51,289 persons, 4.6% more than the previous year.

The number of companies in the ICT sector located within Spain increased 3.3% in the year 2007, and reached the figure of 41,721.

Within the Services sector, the IT activities branch registered the greatest increase in the number of companies as compared with the year 2006, with an increase of 4.3%. In the Telecommunications branch, the number of companies decreased 19.7%.

Internal expenditure on R&D in the sector increases 12.7%

Companies in the ICT sector invested more than 1,252 million euros in R&D during the year 2007, that is, 12.7% more than the previous year.

The number of employed persons on a full-time equivalent (FTE) dedicated to R&D tasks in the ICT sector was 16,935.3. Women accounted for 21.4% of them. Within this same branch, the number of researchers dedicated to R&D was 8,567.5, one in five of whom were women.

45.0% of companies in the ICT sector carry out innovative activities

45.0% of companies in the ICT sector carried out innovative activities during the year 2007, indicating an increase of 4.0% in expenditure on said activities, as compared with the previous year. By sector, 56.1% of manufacturing companies and 42.8% of companies in the services sector carried out innovative activities.

The production value of ICT sector goods increases 3.3%

According to the Industrial Products Survey, the production value of ICT goods increased 3.3% in 2007, to reach 6,325.2 million euros.

Electronic components presented a 26.0% increase as compared with the year 2006. Conversely, interannual decreases were registered in *Computer equipment* (17.6%) and *Telecommunications equipment* (17.4%).

Methodological Annex

The ICT Sector is comprised of the manufacturing and services industries whose main activity is linked to the development, production, marketing and intensive use of Information and Communication Technologies. The ICT Sector is characterised by high rates of innovation, technological progress and productivity.

In statistical terms, the definition of the ICT Sector is developed through an exhaustive listing of the branches of activity corresponding to ICT companies (focus by sector) and ICT products (focus by product).

In order to determine the list of activities and products in the ICT sector, we have begun with the methodological work carried out by the OECD on the subject.
