

According to the Central Business Directory (DIRCE), as of January 1, 2022, there were 3,430,663 registered companies; 1.9% more than on the same date the previous year.


Of the total companies, 56.6% had no employees (1.94 million) and 26.4% had one or two employees (905,804). Among enterprises that are natural persons, 36.9% are women.

Nearly 6,000 Spanish subsidiaries are outside Spain

In 2020, 5,972 foreign subsidiaries of Spanish enterprises were recorded. These enterprises invoiced 187,963 million euros and employed 714,652 persons. The United States, Brazil and the United Kingdom were the countries where the subsidiaries generated the highest turnover.

The subsidiaries of foreign companies in Spain rose to 11,722, reaching a turnover of 502,904 million euros and employing 1,791,494 people. The countries whose subsidiaries generate the highest turnover were France, Germany and the United States.
