Less farms, larger sizes


According to the 2020 Agrarian Census, the number of farms is 914,871, which is 7.6% lower than in 2009. The average UAA per farm increased by 7.4%, reaching 26.37 ha, the highest value in the historical series.

Compared to the previous Census, the highest increase in average farm size took place in the País Vasco (38.4%) and the Principado de Asturias (31.1%), while the strongest drops were recorded in La Rioja (-12.4%) and Andalucía (-2.2%).

Leader in fish production


A fourth of the 2020 aquaculture production in the EU came from Spain (25.4%), according to Eurostat data. In addition, Spain was the country with the most tons of live weight fishing catches in 2021.
